Dear Dr. *Adena* Loston:

Thank you for your letter of July 27, 2010, notifying the Commission on Colleges that St. Philip's College will implement two new programs. In Fall 2010, San Antonio College will offer a limited number of courses at St. Philip's College in the Associate of Applied Science in Electronics Technology degree.

Beginning Spring 2011, the Electronics Technology program along with the Occupational Safety and Health Technology program will be offered at St. Philip's College. The Electronics Technology program will require 13 new courses and 2 new faculty members. The resources will be transferred from San Antonio College. A significant number of new courses will have to be developed.

The Associate of Applied Science in Occupational Safety and Health Technology will require 12 new courses and 2 new faculty members. There are no similar programs at St. Philip's College.

These programs appear to be a significant expansion at the current degree level, and as such require submission of a prospectus for approval at least 3 months in advance of implementation.
