Thank you for your letter of October 15, 2010, transmitting a prospectus for the Associate of Applied Science degree program in Occupational Safety and Health Technology to be offered, effective January 2011.

The program is being transferred from San Antonio College. Students enrolled in this program will be able to earn the A.A.S. in Occupational Safety and Health Technology—Safety and Health Management, Industrial Hygiene Management, or Safety Engineering. In addition, the College will offer a Level I Certificate in Occupational Safety and Health Technician, and a Marketable Skills Certificate in Occupational Safety and Health Technology—Hazmat Response Planning. The program will be offered at both the main campus and the Southwest Campus.

The program has been approved by the College curriculum committee and the curriculum committee for the District. It will be administered by the Chair of the Allied Construction Technology Department. Program objectives and curriculum for the degree, certificate, and marketable skills award were provided. Learning resources, physical resources, and financial resources are in place to support the program. Evaluation and assessment processes were described. The faculty roster documented appropriate qualifications for faculty members teaching in the program.
