The institution had offered courses in the Associate of Arts (A.A.) degree program at the site. Following fall 2017, Samuel Clemens High School entered a dual-credit partnership with another institution to offer A.A. courses, effective spring 2018. The institution is reminded when it closes a program or instructional site, it has an affirmative obligation to seek closure approval from SACSCOC at the time the closure decision is made. The closure date is the date students are no longer admitted. Courses for the Level 1 Certificate program in Catering Management continue to be offered through the ongoing partnership between the institution and Samuel Clemens High School.

Parents/students were informed by the ISD (independent school district) when the switch to the other school was finalized. Students have other opportunities for dual-credit courses in the active Catering Management program with St. Philip's College. There is no cost to dual-credit students.

All instructors were adjunct instructors for St. Philip's College and had the opportunity to apply as an adjunct with the college if they wished to do so. The school staff at the site are still employed at the school.
