## F.2.1.2 (Procedure) Early Admission of High School Students

High school students may be admitted for credit work at the College District according to the following guidelines:

- 1. The student must be recommended by the high school principal/designee or counselor. This recommendation shall be the primary consideration for admission.
- 2. The course load shall be determined by the high school counselor and the college counselor.
- 3. The student must have completed the sophomore year equivalent of the required units for graduation.
- 4. The student must have acceptable placement scores as determined by the colleges of the College District.
