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#### **Reporting**

The College District shall report to the local health authority, or if required by law to the Texas Department of State Health Services regional director, a suspected case of a reportable disease as required by state law and the Texas Department of State Health Services.

#### **Exclusion**

The College District reserves the right to exclude a person with a communicable disease from College District facilities, programs, and functions, if the College District makes a medically-based determination that the restriction is necessary for the welfare of the person who has the communicable disease and/or the welfare of the other members of the College District community.
