Labor Market Employment, Projections & Wages in Texas and Alamo WDA*




Figure 62-1: Alamo WDA county map Data Source: https://texaslmi.com/

Displayed in *Figure 62-1* (right), Bexar and its 11 surrounding counties comprise the Alamo Workforce Development Area (WDA).

Figure 62-2 (below) identifies the predominant occupational families in the Alamo WDA. As depicted, Service occupations accounted for a high of 20.8% area employment, followed by Office and Administrative Support (15%) and Management, Business, and Finance (11.3%) employment.




Figure 62-2: Annual Alamo WDA Occupational Families Employment for 2018

Figure 62-3 (above) details Texas and Alamo WDA wage, current employment, and employment projections based on Standard Occupational Classification (SOC) titles that appear among the top 25 projections for Alamo; *SOC titles are limited to those related to SPC programs.* As indicated, the largest gaps between current and projected 2028 employment occur in Heavy and Tractor-Trailer Truck Drivers (+4494), Nursing Assistants (+3656), Bookkeeping, Accounting, and Auditing Clerks (+2804), followed by Preschool Teachers, Except Special Education (+1699) and Teaching Assistants, Except Postsecondary (+1577).
