SACSCOC requested additional information via email and phone. The institution's responses have been added to the record and are reflected in the narrative below.

St. Philip's College closed the Cyber P-TECH USA at Sam Houston High School satellite campus (W.W. White Road) off-campus instructional site (OCIS). Individuals at the site's administrative offices notified affected students, faculty, and staff members of the site closure. Students were able to continue in the program at the Cyber P-TECH USA at Sam Houston High School site, which will remain open. The institution affirmed that there was no disruption to students and that they did not incur additional costs or expenses due to the change. There were no teach-out agreements with other institutions. Faculty and staff members supporting the site continue to be employed by the school and teach in the Cyber P-TECH USA program.

The Board of Trustees of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges approves the closure of the Cyber P-TECH USA at Sam Houston High School satellite campus (W.W. White Road) off-campus instructional site (OCIS).
