## New Program Approval Process Overview

Dr. Christa Emig, Director of Curriculum Coordination & Transfer Articulation, Alamo Colleges District, provided the PVC an overview of the New Program Approval Process. The New Program process requires an item to go to the PVC three times: for Initial Approval, for Program Development Approval, and then Final Approval. As part of this process improvement, the submitter/college will now identify the requested approval (Initial Approval, Program Development Approval, Final Approval) in the PVC Agenda Item Submission template. The PVC agreed to make necessary adjustments to the PVC agenda development and minutes processes in order to support the New Program Approval Process. Michelle Perales will add an identifier question for New Program Approvals to the PVC Agenda Item Submission template and notation in the minutes to help facilitate this process.

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
