1927: born in Marion, Alabama; her paternal great-grandmother Delia Scott, a former slave, is the midwife.

1960: speaks with John F. Kennedy during the <u>1960 presidential election</u>; has been credited by historians for mobilizing African-American voters.

1968: takes on a leadership role, becomes more active in the <u>Women's Movement</u>, founds the <u>King Center</u>, advocates for his birthday to be a national holiday.

1969: receives the Universal Love Award in Verona, Italy, the first non-Italian to win the award.

1969: lead speaker at the Moratorium to End the War in Vietnam demonstration in Washington D.C.

1983: President Reagan signs legislation to establish <u>Martin Luther King Jr. Day</u> as a national holiday; increases advocacy for LGBT rights and opposition to apartheid.

2005: first African American to lie in state in the Georgia State Capitol; four of five living presidents attend her funeral.

2009: inducted into the <u>Alabama Women's Hall of Fame</u>; also inducted into the <u>National Women's Hall of Fame</u>.
