




## How to record, find and review recordings in Zoom.

Cloud recording is automatically enabled for all paid subscribers. When you record a meeting and choose **Record to the Cloud**, the video, audio, and chat text are recorded in the Zoom cloud. The recording files can be downloaded to a computer or streamed from a browser.

2. Navigate to the ""**Recording**" tab" option and verify that the "**Cloud Recording**" setting is enabled., If the setting is disabled, click the toggle to enable it.



# **Finding and Viewing Recording**

You can record your Zoom meeting or webinar locally to your computer or to the Zoom cloud if you are a licensed user. Files stored on the cloud can be accessed on your desktop or from the web. Locally recorded meetings and webinars can only be accessed on the computer that recorded the meeting.


