In fall 2020, St. Philip's College was informed that no students enrolled in the dual credit courses offered at Gloria Deo Academy; (Off-campus Instructional Site prospectus dated May 17, 2019; SACSCOC approval dated August 2, 2019). Although the high school actively encourages dual credit participation, this lack of student interest precipitates this notification.

## **Teach-out Plan**

Gloria Deo Academy – Associate of Arts

A teach-out plan is a written plan developed by an institution that provides for the equitable treatment of students if an institution, or an institutional location that provides fifty percent or more of at least one program, ceases to operate before all students have completed their program of study, and may include, if required by the institution's accrediting agency, a teach-out agreement between institutions. Teach-out plans must be approved by SACSCOC in advance of implementation.

To be approved, a teach-out plan must include the following information:

Date of closure (date when new students will no longer be admitted)
Fall 2020 there were no students in the campus's Associate of Arts program. Spring 2019 Gloria
Deo had their last set of students go through this program. The high school is still recruiting students, but has not had any enrollment in the dual credit program.

2. An explanation of how affected parties (students, faculty, staff) will be informed of the impending closure.

Parents/students are informed of the dual credit program by the school administration. They have the choice of entering the program, or just taking regular high school courses.

3. An explanation of how all affected students will be helped to complete their programs of study with minimal disruption.

The students can continue taking dual credit courses if they are interested in doing so. St. Philip's College will notify SACSCOC should the site be reopened.

4. An indication as to whether the teach-out plan will incur additional charges/expenses to the students and, if so, how the students will be notified. No cost to Dual Credit students.

5. Copies of signed teach-out agreements with other institutions, if any. There is not a signed teach-out agreement for the courses with Gloria Deo Academy. Not applicable.

How faculty and staff will be redeployed or helped to find new employment.
All instructors are St. Philip's College instructors, and are continuing to teach with the college.
The school staff at Gloria Deo Academy are still employed at the school.

7. If closing an institution, arrangement for the storing of student records, disposition of final financial resources and other assets.

Not applicable. St. Philip's College and Gloria Deo Academy are operational institutions as of May 28, 2021.
