Figure 44-1 (above) displays SPC's fall 2019 top 8 Bexar County feeder zip codes* along with both campus zip codes in correlation with the percentage of households lacking broadband connection. As shown, only one feeder zip code boasts greater than 90% of households have broadband (78109 with 0-6.3% No Broadband), while 2 of these zip codes record no broadband in 33.65-60% of households, including 78211, in which the Southwest Campus is located.

*Only Bexar county feeder zip codes are included, as the Digital Inclusion Survey and Assessment Report featured only San Antonio and Bexar County data. SPC's top 10 feeder zip codes also included 78155 (Guadalupe County) and 78130 (Comal County).




Figure 44-2 Broadband access by San Antonio City Council District Data Source: Digital Inclusion Survey and Assessment

As seen in *Figure 44-2* (below), San Antonio Council Districts 6-10 (representing the northern half of the city) report broadband connection in greater than 80% of households, whereas Districts 1-5 remain below 80%. District 5 demonstrates the lowest percentage of households with broadband at only 62%.





Figure 44-3 Broadband access by Bexar County precinct Data Source: Digital Inclusion Survey and Assessment

The disparity in broadband connection also may be viewed in *Figure 44-3* (right), which focuses on Bexar County Precincts. As shown, Precinct 3 (northern Bexar County) has the highest percentage of household broadband connection at 94%, while the other 3 precincts remain under 80% connected.
