










### Fall 2019 Headcount by Institute












### **Productive Grade Rates**









# Percentage of Students Rating their Entire Educational Experience as "Good or Excellent"












#### Fall-to-Fall FTIC Persistence Rates










### Fall FT 2016 FTIC 3-Year Tracking












### FT FTIC Comparative Persistence Rates











#### **3-Year FTIC Graduation Rates**




















#### **4-Year FTIC Graduation Rates**










#### **4-Year FT FTIC Graduation Rates**












# Semester Credit Hours to Associate Degree (Initial Associate Degree Only)




















# 6-Year FTIC Transfer Rates (NSC Data)



# Students Employed and/or Enrolled Within 6 Months of Graduation












#### **Degrees & Certificates Awarded by Ethnicity**










#### Degrees & Certificates Awarded by Gender
