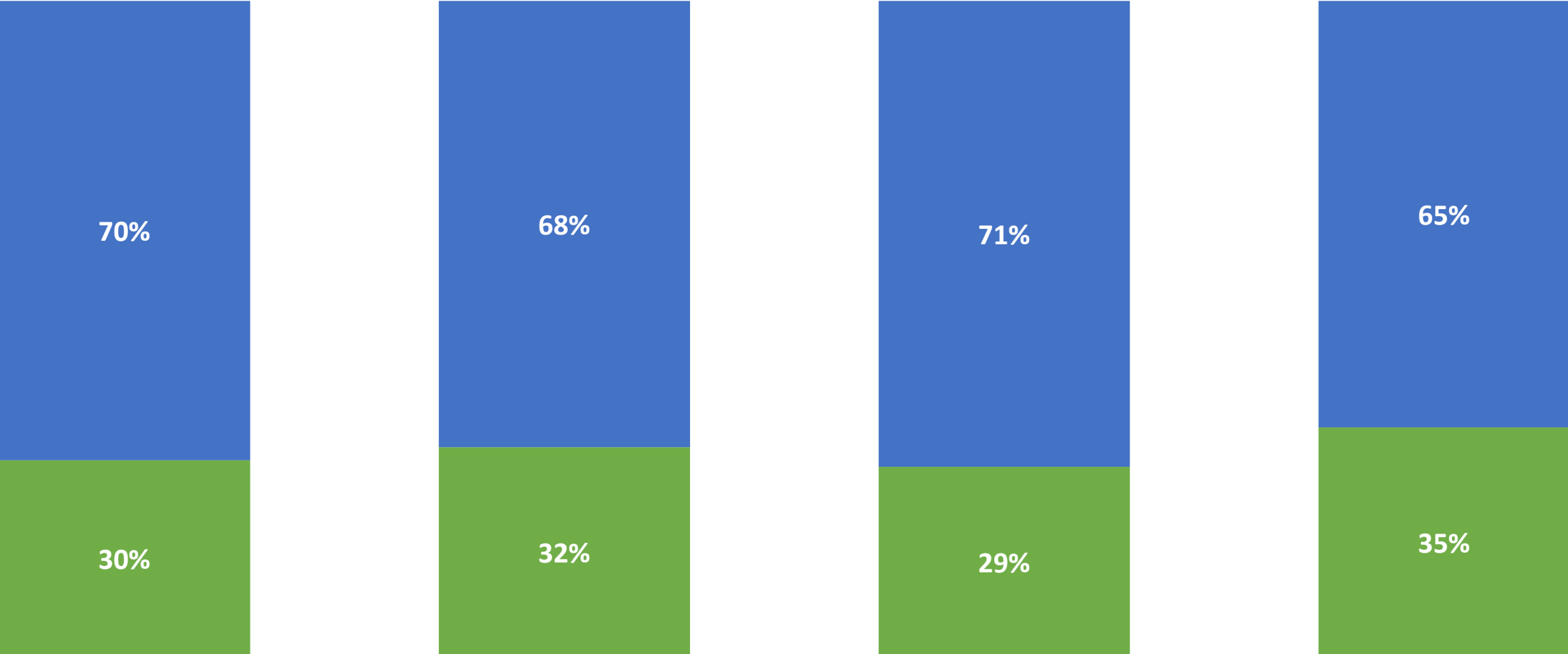
2017 PACfest Community Survey Methodology

- ❖ The purpose of this survey is to improve **PACfest** activities and gain insight from the attending students, faculty, employees and the community as means of complying with *SACS 3.3.1.5.
- ❖ From 12:30 PM to 08:00 PM, the Knowledge Management Team obtained **814 surveys** (98 more than last year) with assistance of IT Staff volunteers. Surveys needed to be filled at least 50% in key areas.
- ❖ Individuals who completed surveys secured a give away prize (Sunglasses with PAC logo or Tumbler with PAC logo)

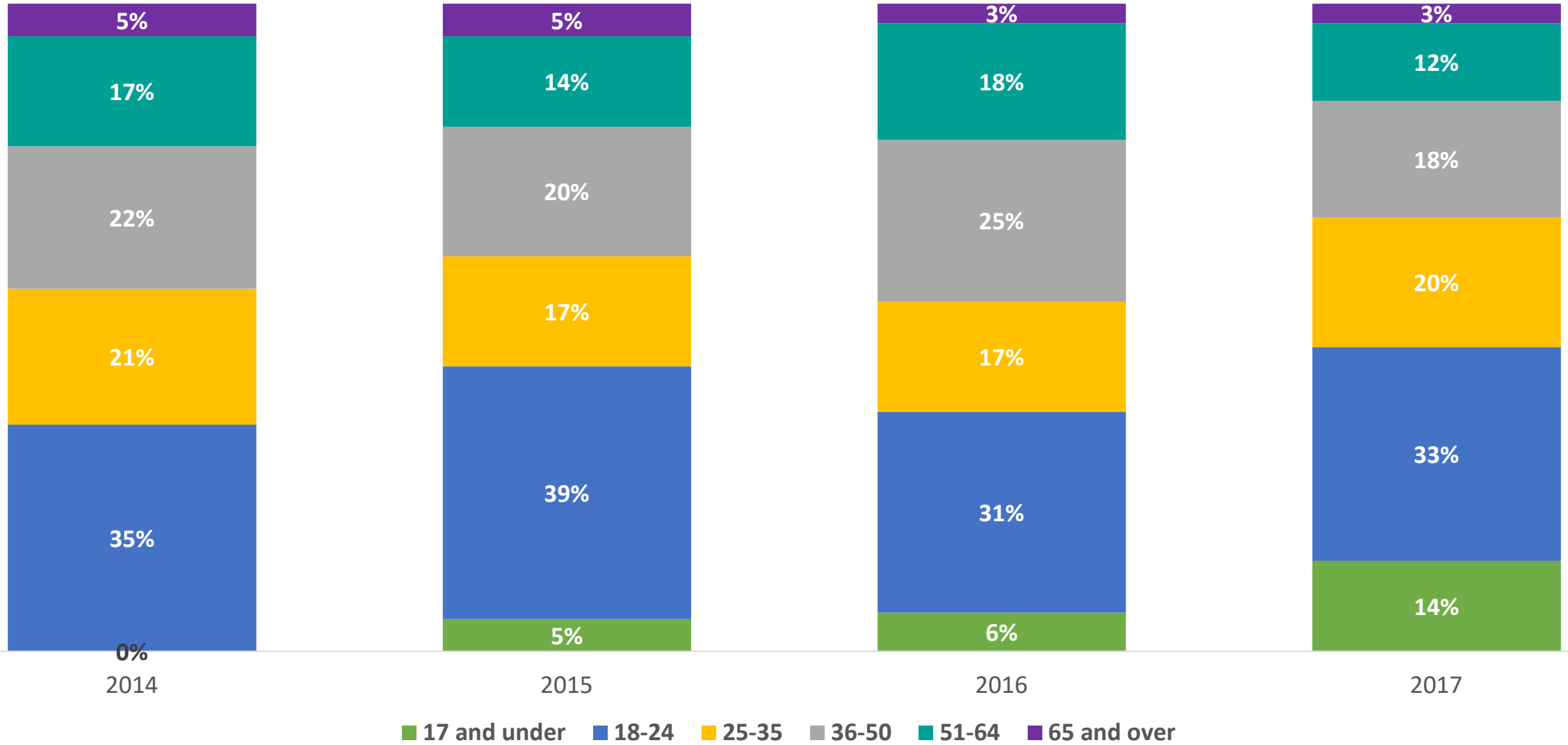

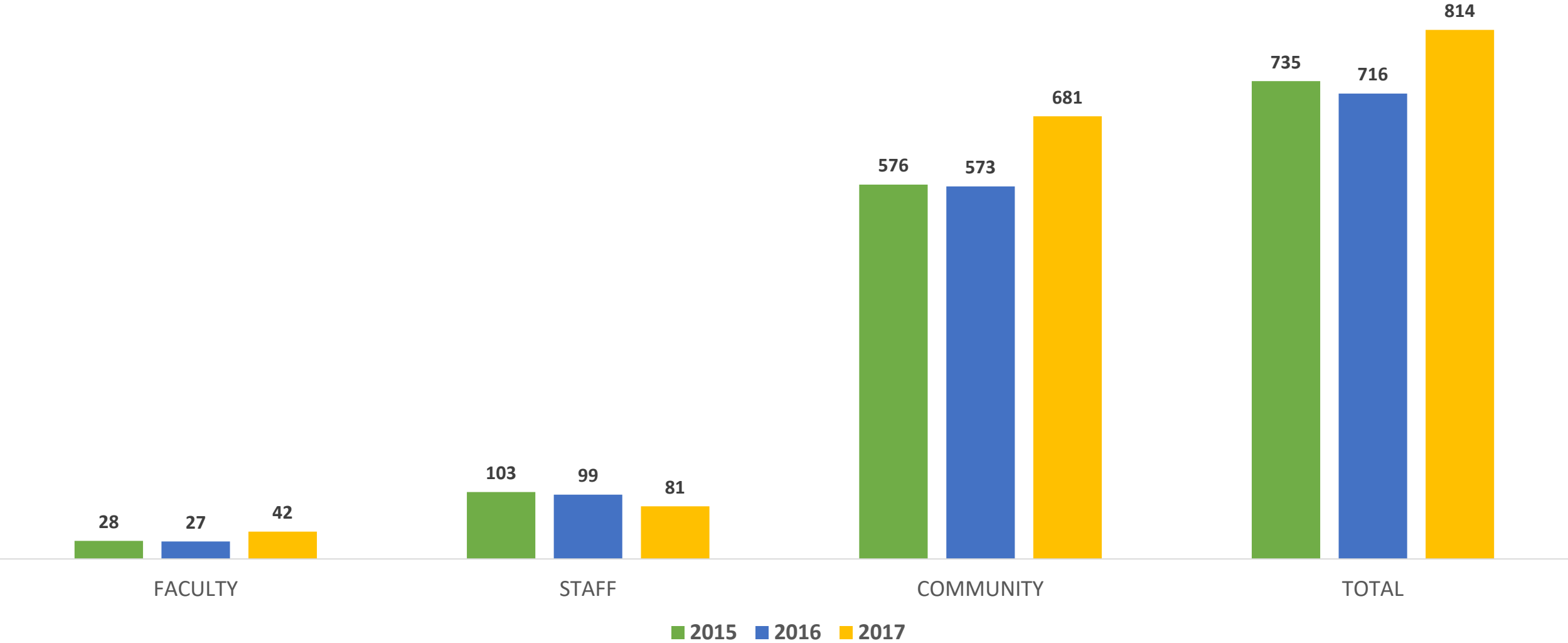

Historical Age Distribution



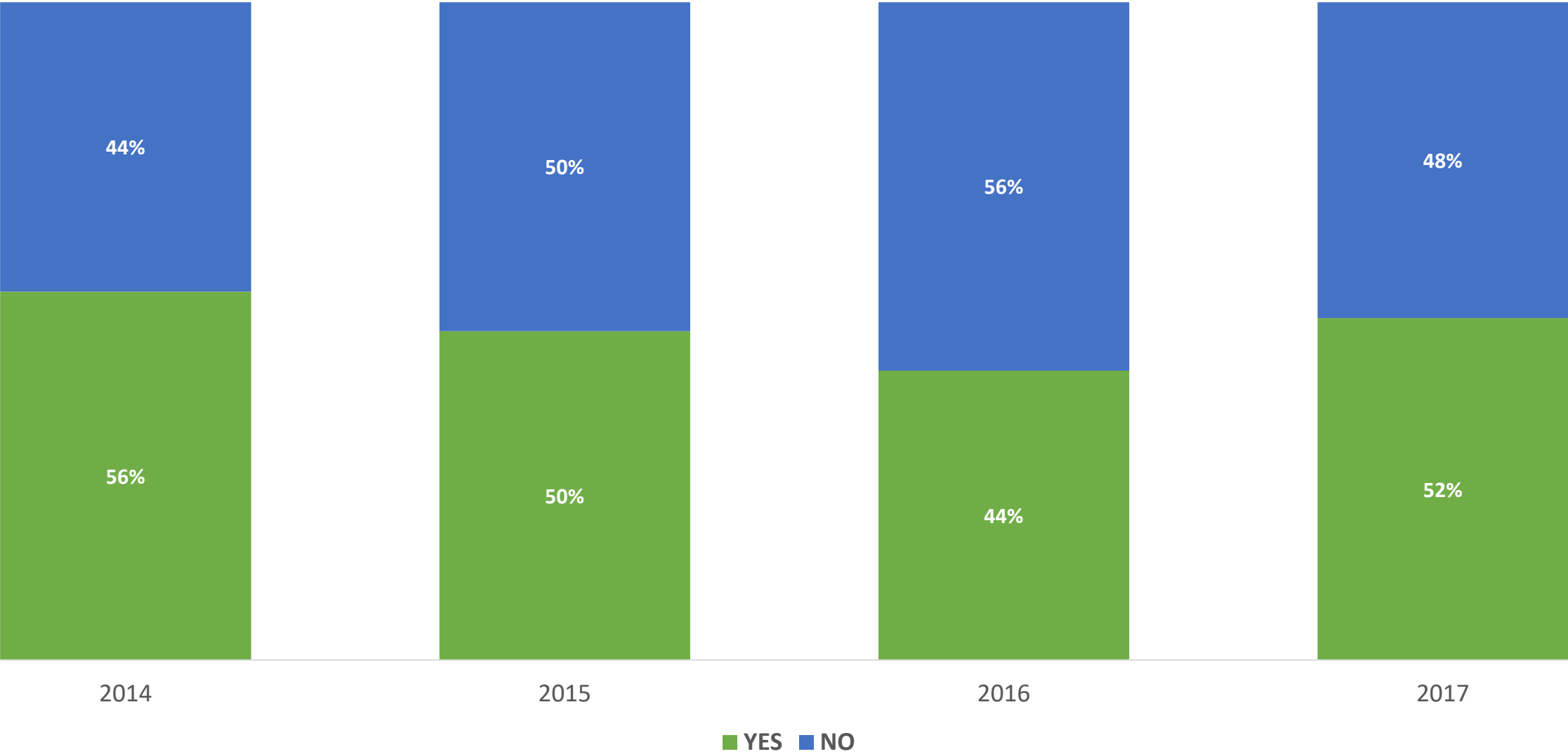
Historical Participant Type



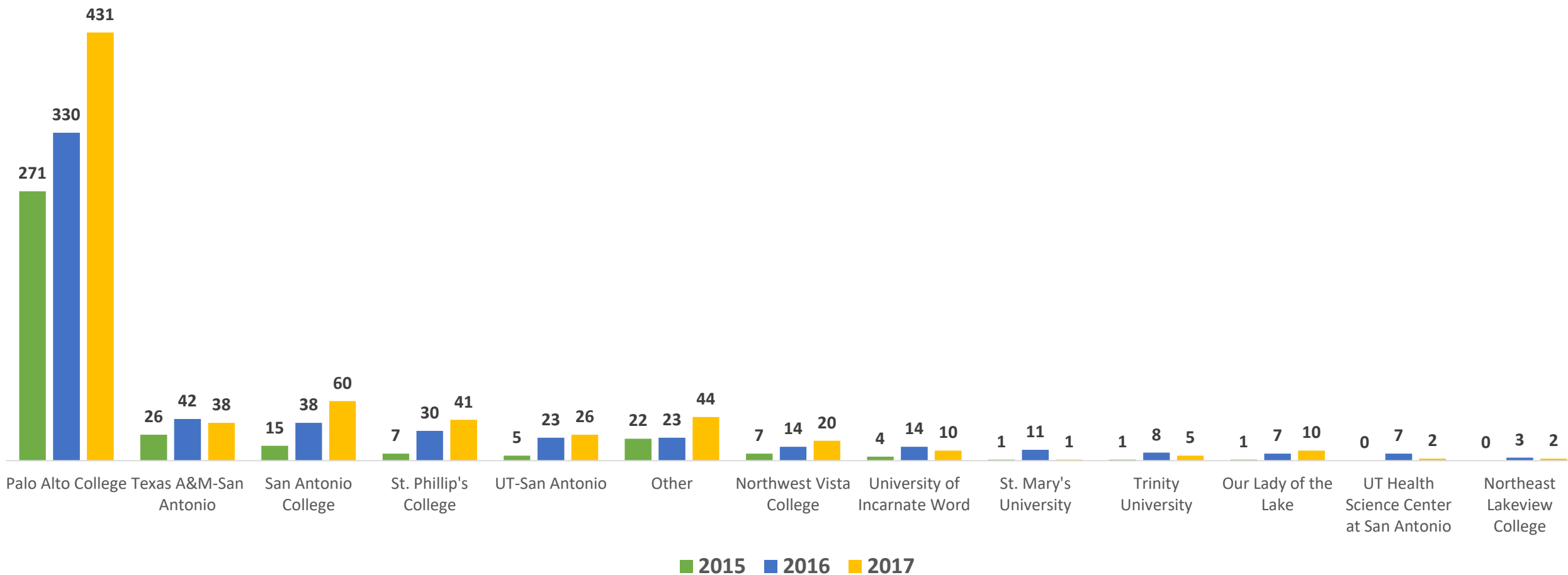

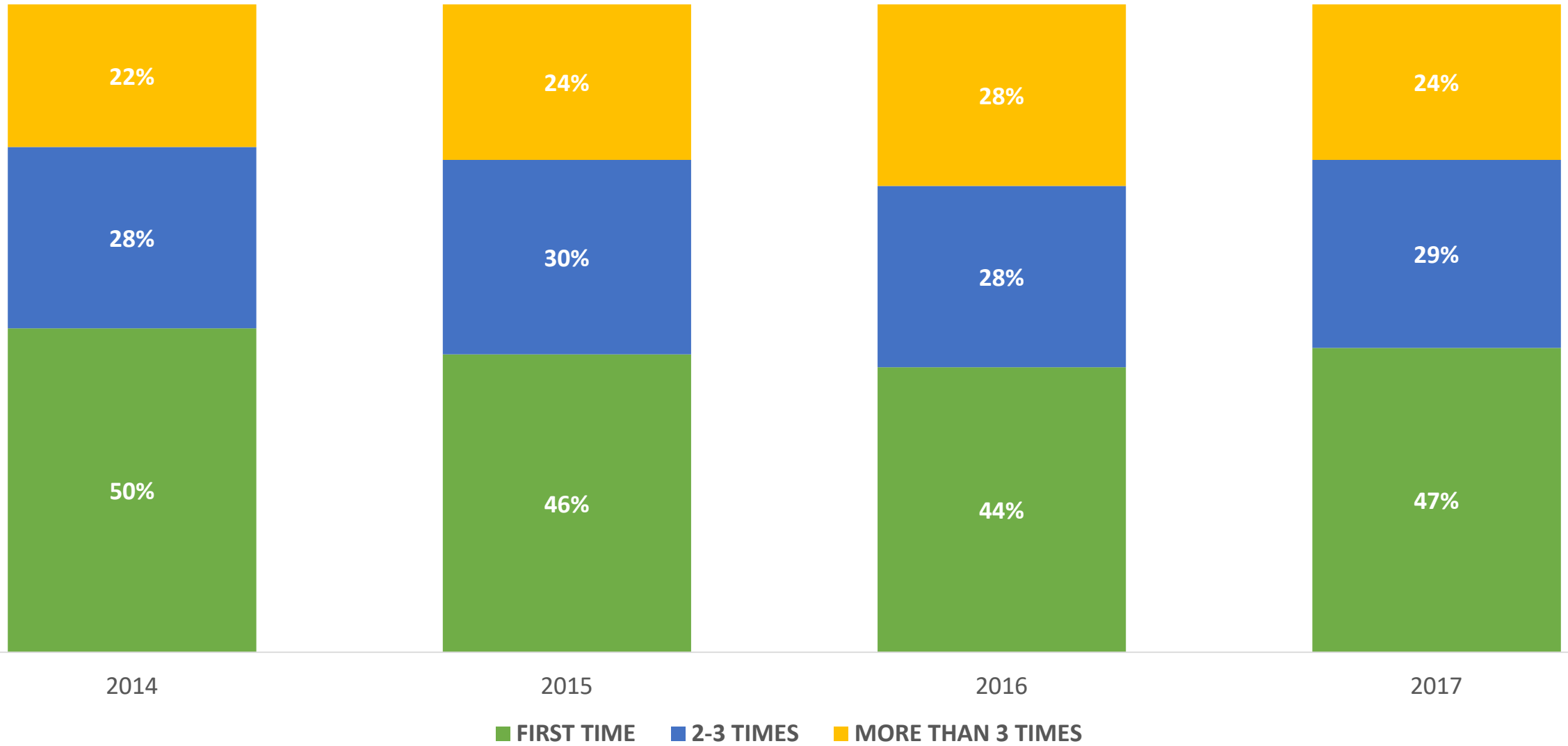
Are you currently enrolled at a college or university?



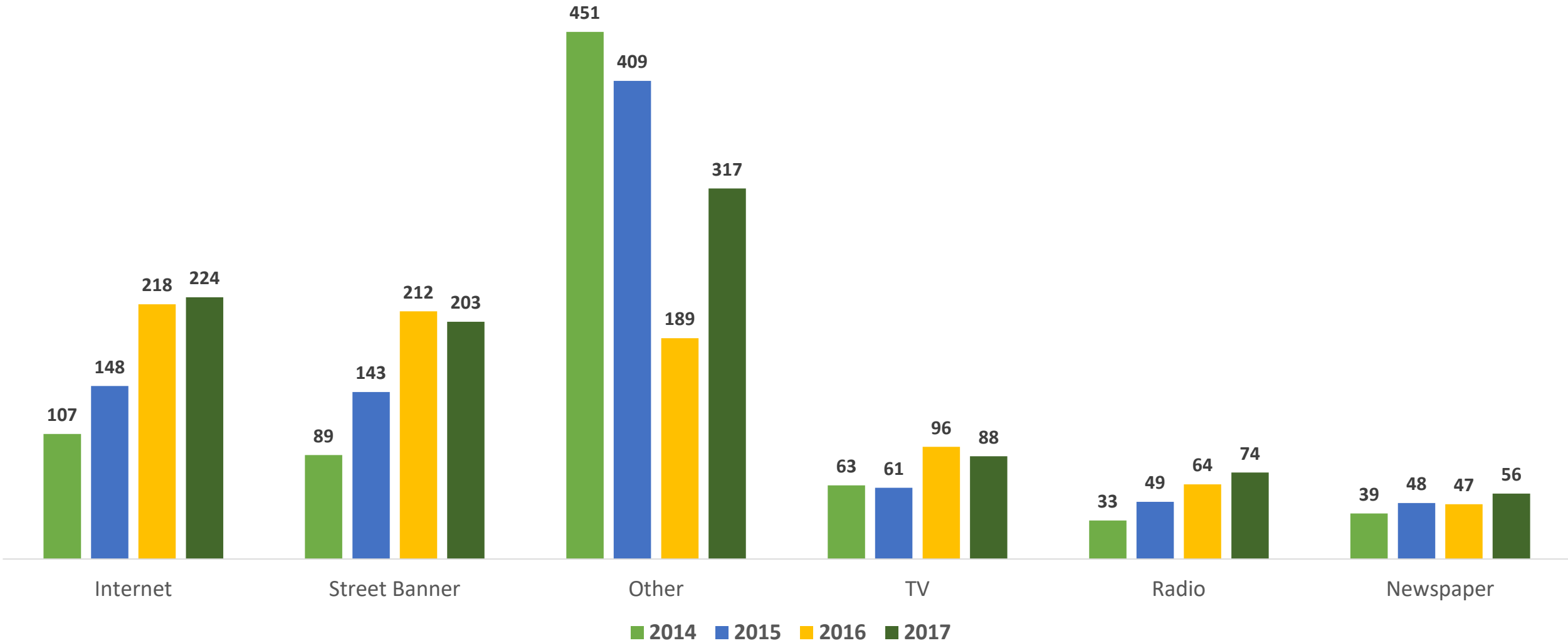

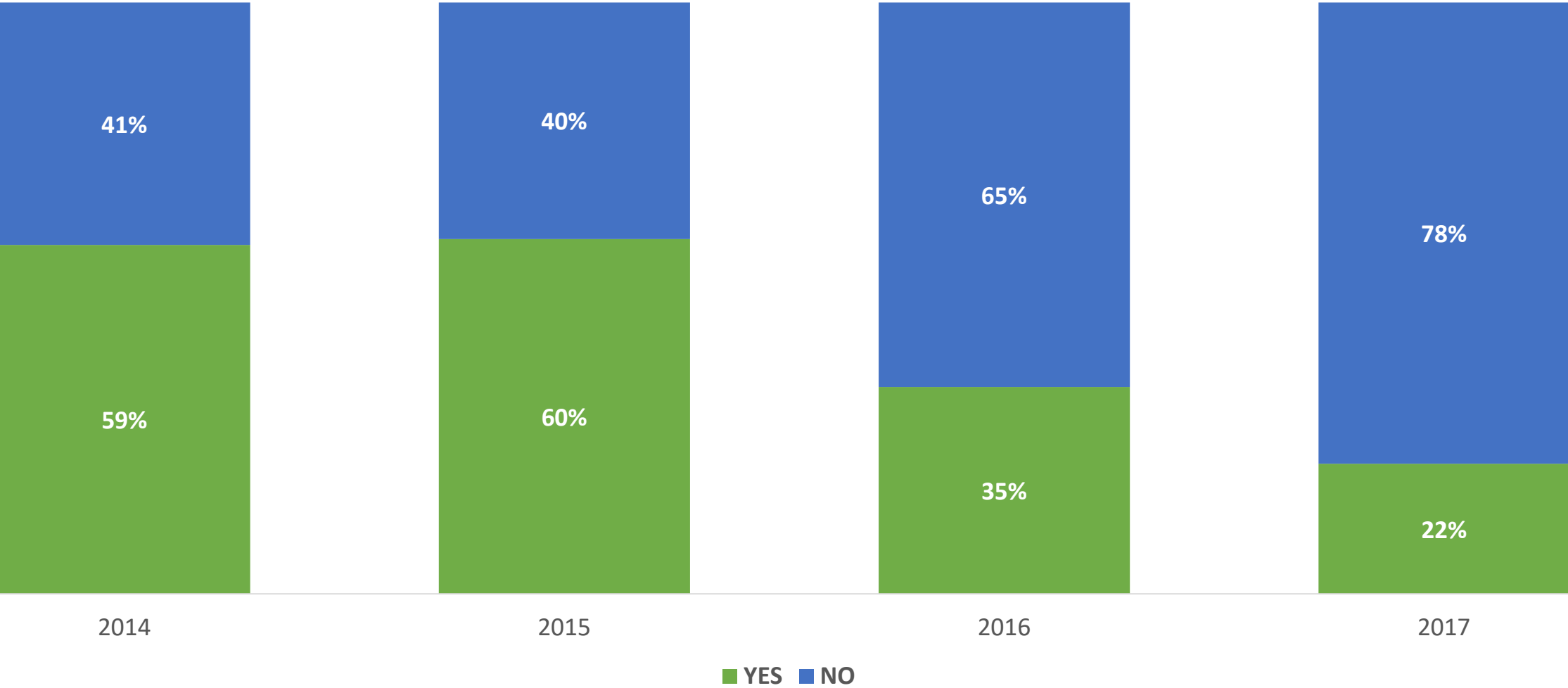
How many times have you attended PACfest?



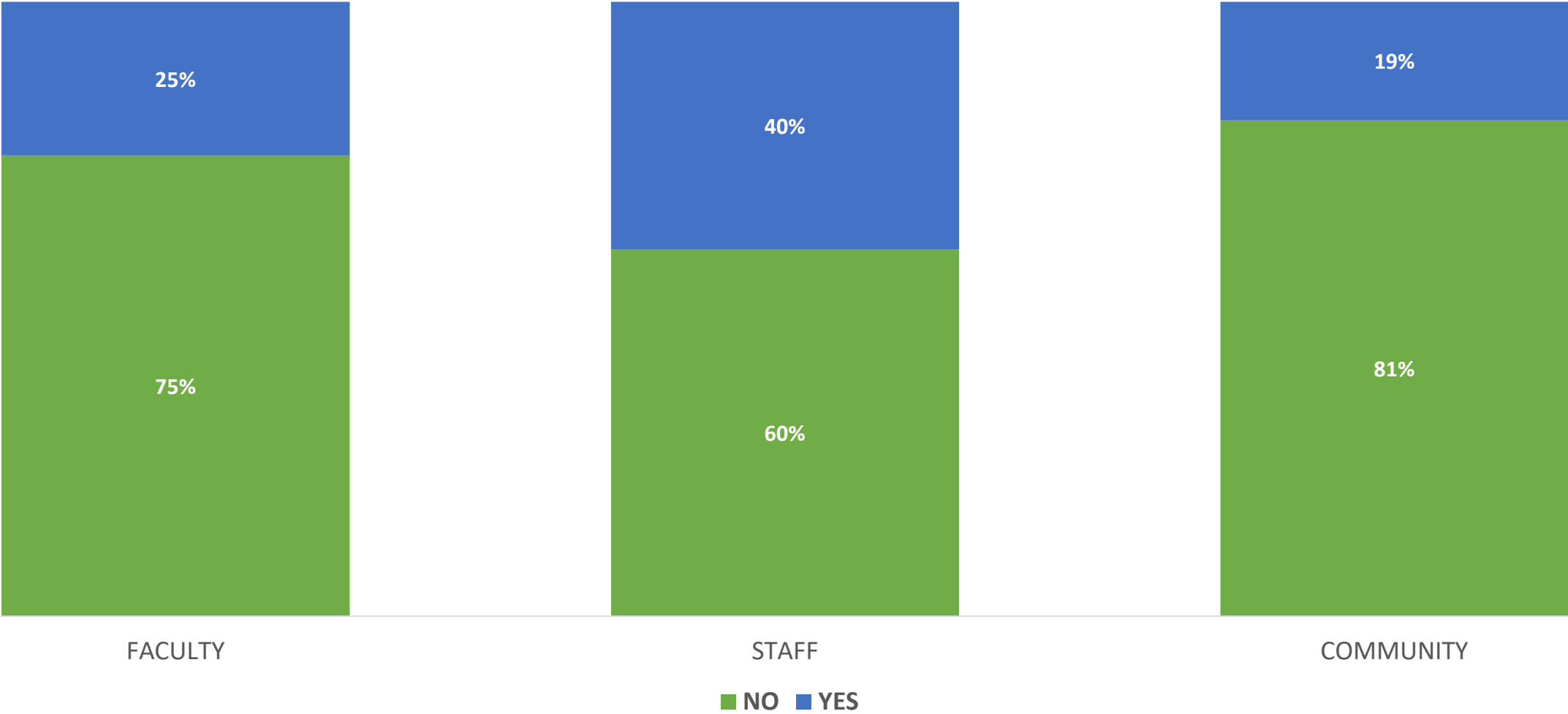
How did you hear about this year's PACfest?



Other than PACfest, have you ever attended any event at Palo Alto College, or used any of the services on campus?

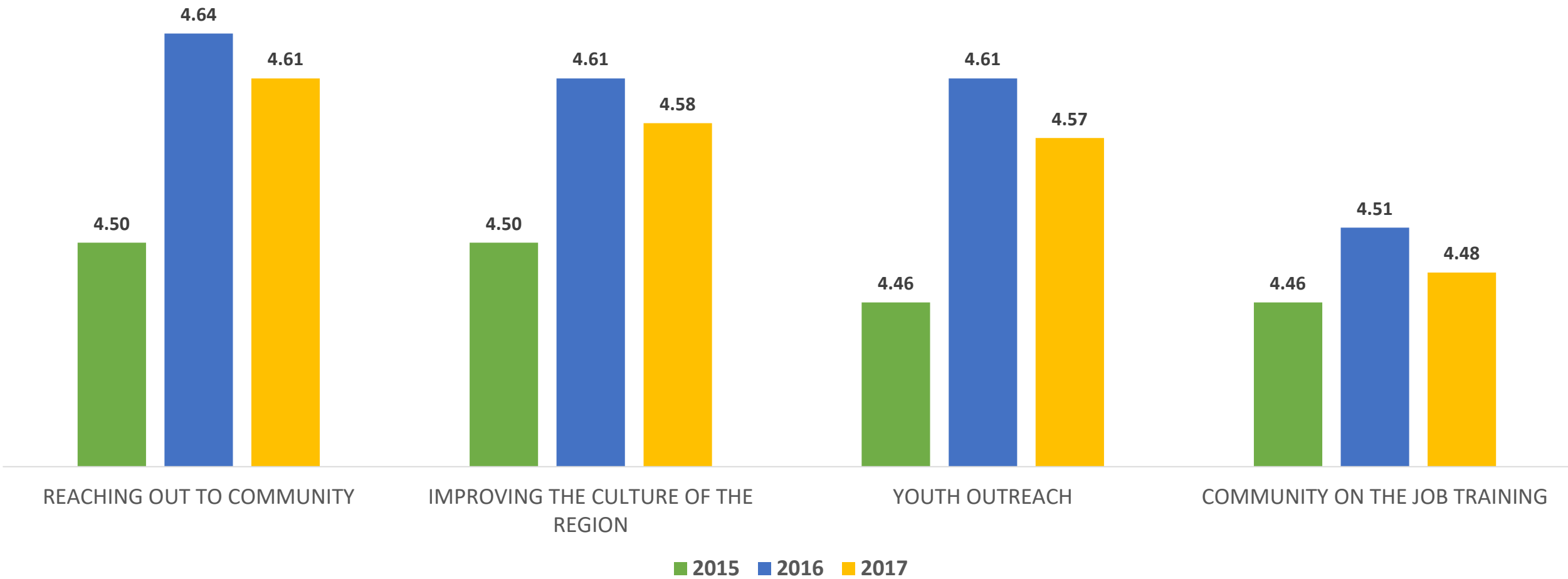

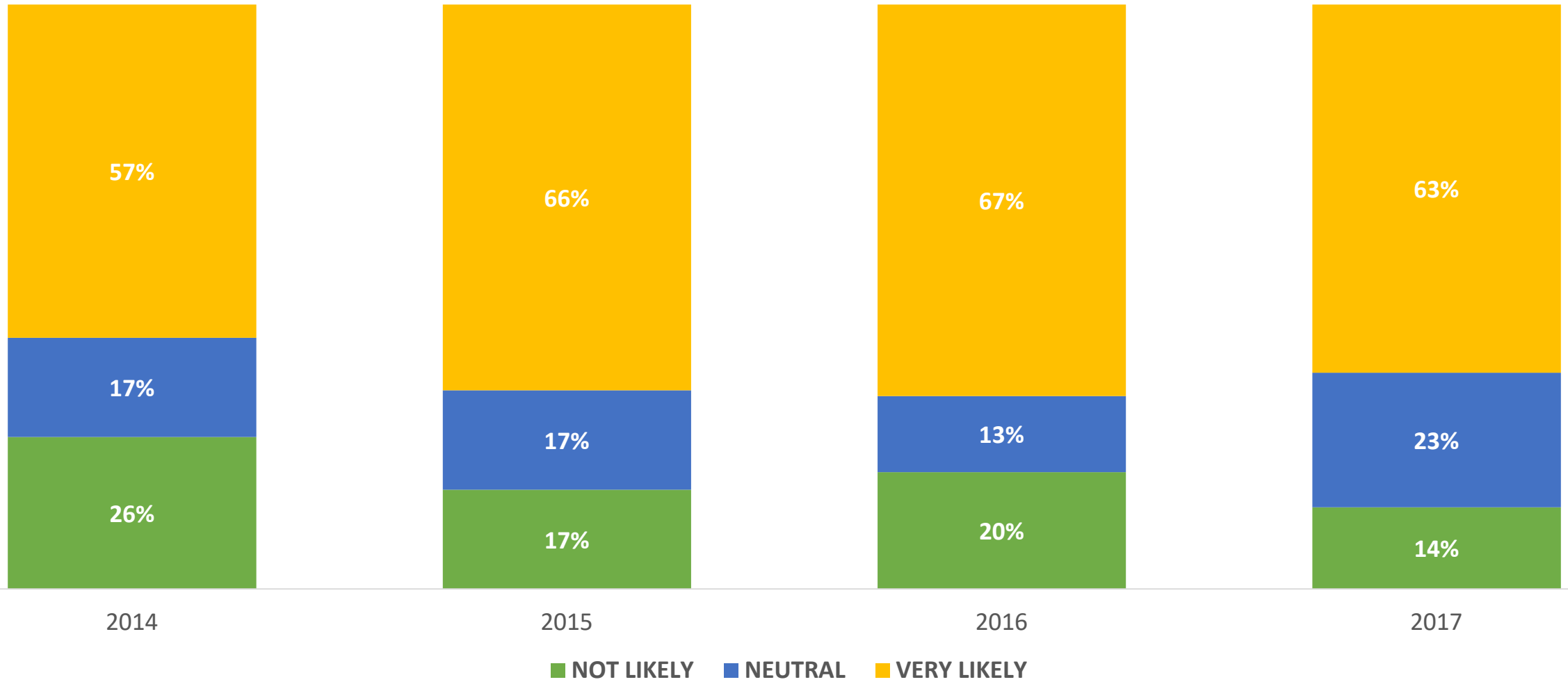


How would you rate Palo Alto College in the following areas:

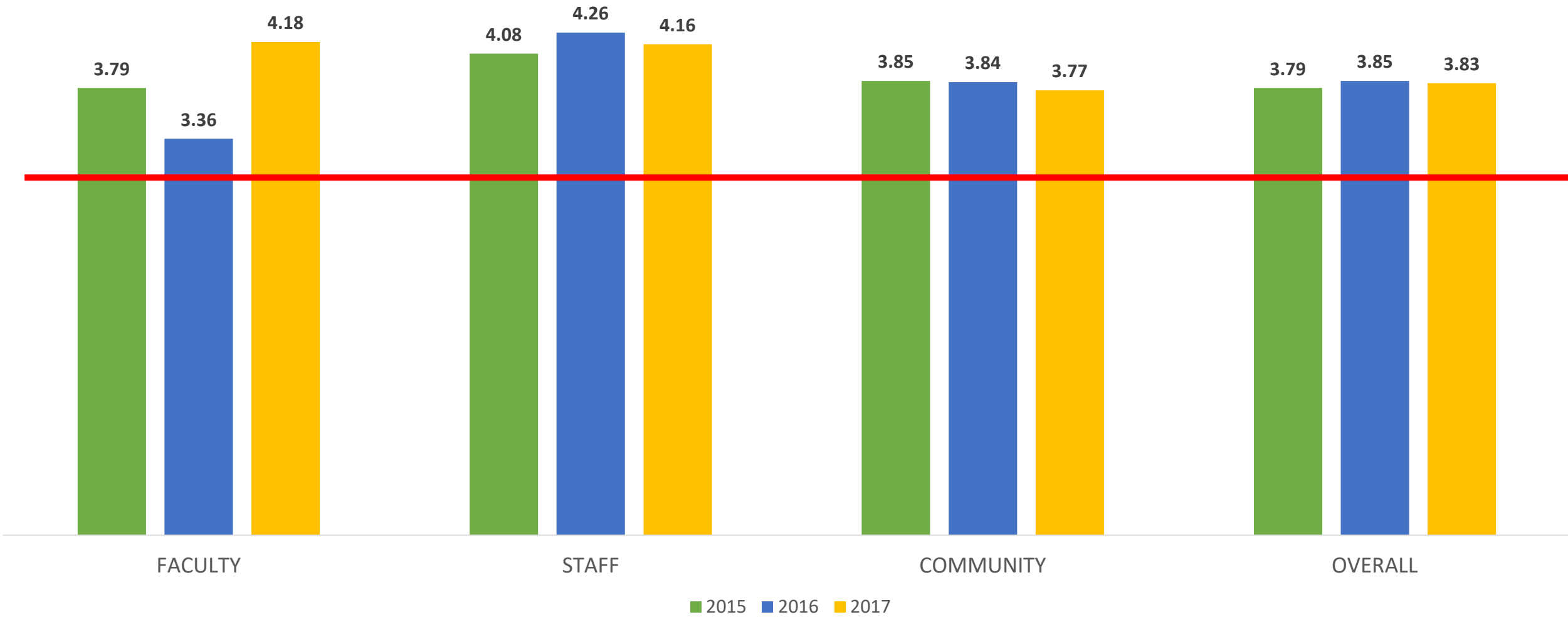

PACfest has historically been a non-alcoholic event. If beer was served in a restricted area, would you attend PACfest next year?

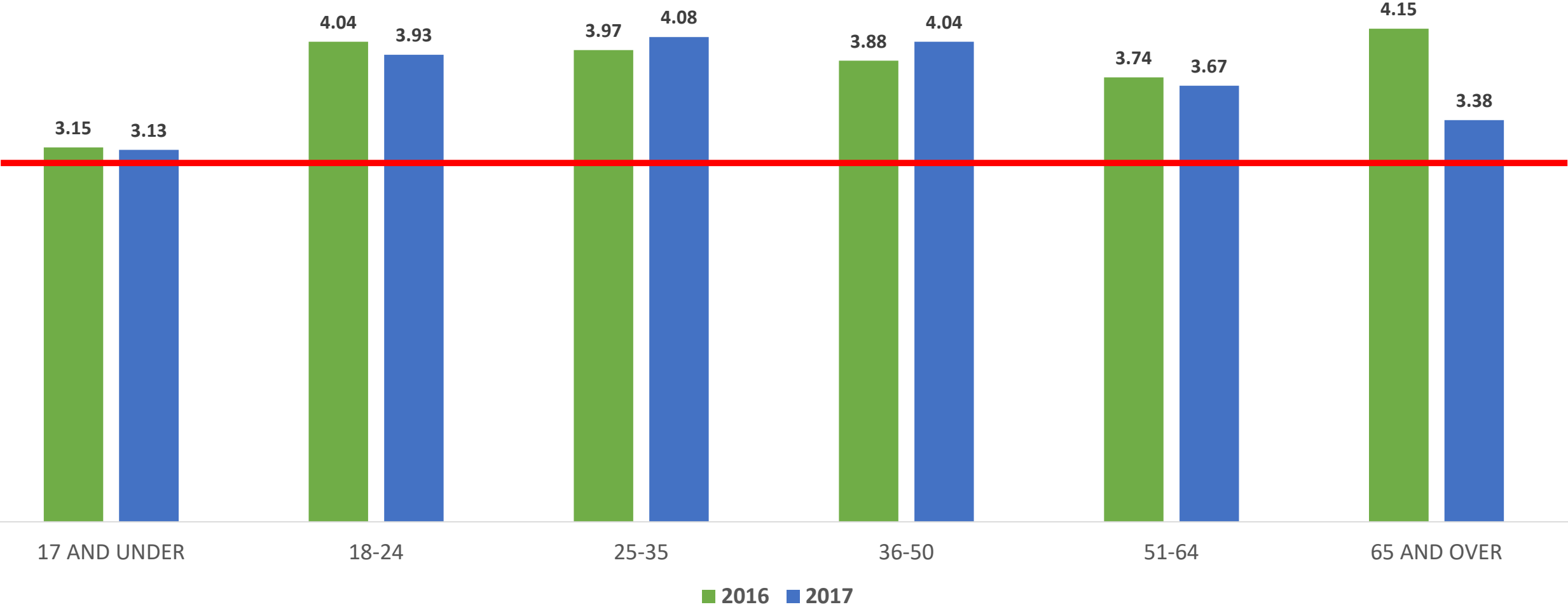
