


Figure 38-1: Fall-to-Fall full and part time (FT and PT) persistence rate 3 year comparison




Figure 38-2: 3-year graduation rate by FT, PT, and all students 3 year comparison Data Source: SPC IPRE





Figure 38-4: 6-year graduation rate by FT, PT, and all students 3 year comparison Data Source: SPC IPRE

#### GRADUATION CONTINUED

As displayed in *Figures 38-3* and 38-4 (left), 4-year and 6-year graduation rates increased from fall 2013 to fall 2015 among full time and all student cohorts. Despite a decline in the 4-year part time graduation rate between the fall 2013 and fall 2014 cohorts, the 2015 part time cohort showed the highest rate at 21.7%.



As shown in *Figure 38-5* (below left), SPC students consistently achieve Productive Grade Rate (PGR) above 80%. PGR is calculated based on student course completion with final course grades A, B, and C, while Course Completion (*Figure 38-6*, below right) demonstrates the percentage of all students who completed courses. As seen in *Figure 38-6*, SPC students consistently attain greater than 90% course completion.
