

# Updated CDC and ACD COVID-19 guidance If you test <u>POSITIVE for COVID-19</u>:

- Stay home for 5 days
- Notify your supervisor
- Submit a COVID-19 Report if you test positive for COVID-19. <u>https://alamonvc.gualtrics.com/jfe/form/SV\_87kT2C53V2wzRfn</u>
- On your 4th day at home, contact Gerald T. Dove, Risk Coordinator to report the status of your symptoms to determine when you can return to work on-site.
  - If you are feeling better or symptoms are resolving after 5 days




