- Be a high school graduate from one of these independent school districts: East Central, Edgewood, Harlandale, San Antonio, Somerset, South San, SouthSide or Southwest ISD. (Preference will be given to First Time in College students. Prior enrollment in dual credit or advanced placement math, accounting, economics, science and/or computer technology courses does not alter First Time in College status in the application of this preference.)
- 2. Have a minimum cumulative 3.0 grade point average on a 4.0 scale (equivalent to 80 or higher on 100-pt. scale)
- 3. Complete the Alamo Colleges Common Scholarship Application <u>and</u> the Harvey Najim Pathways Scholarship Certification Form.
- 4. Enroll at one of these Alamo Colleges PAC, SAC, SPC or NVC as a full-time student (min. 12 hrs. per Fall/Spring semester).
- 5.
