## Palo Alto College Nursing A.A.S.

This two-year program prepares students to become Registered Nurses. Students earn an Associate of Applied Science degree. Upon successful program completion, the graduate is eligible to take the Texas Nursing Jurisprudence Exam. Upon passing the Texas Nursing Jurisprudence Exam, the graduate is eligible to take the National Council Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses.
