Introduction

Following successful virtual presentations and subsequent Assessment Day activities, the 2023 – 2024 Annual Assessment Showcase occurred via Teams on April 12, 2024 with participation from academic department faculty, chairs, and deans. This report serves as dissemination of Institutional Student Learning Outcomes Assessment Day results to maintain transparency and promote continuous discussion and improvement. Assessment Day was originally scheduled to be conducted in three separate activities: Calibration Training (completed by Feb. 8), Individual Assessment (Feb. 9 – Feb. 15), and Consensus Scoring Day (Feb. 16). However, due to all departments completing Calibration training early, the assessment folders were opened for scoring one week earlier. Assessment Day activities involved 59 faculty assessors and department chairs from all five Arts and Sciences departments.

Institutional Process

In order to maintain compliance and accountability, St. Philip's College assesses Institutional Student Learning Outcomes (ISLOs) adopted from the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board's competencies/objectives for general education core curriculum. These competencies include:

- Critical Thinking Skills (CT) - creative thinking, innovation, inquiry, and analysis, evaluation and synthesis of information
- Communication Skills (COM) - effective development, interpretation and expression of ideas through written, oral and visual communication
- Empirical and Quantitative Skills (EQS) - manipulation and analysis of numerical data or observable facts resulting in informed conclusions
- Teamwork (TW) - ability to consider different points of view and to work effectively with others to support a shared purpose or goal
- Social Responsibility (SR) - intercultural competence, knowledge of civic responsibility, and the ability to engage effectively in regional, national, and global communities
- Personal Responsibility (PR) - ability to connect choices, actions and consequences to ethical decision-making

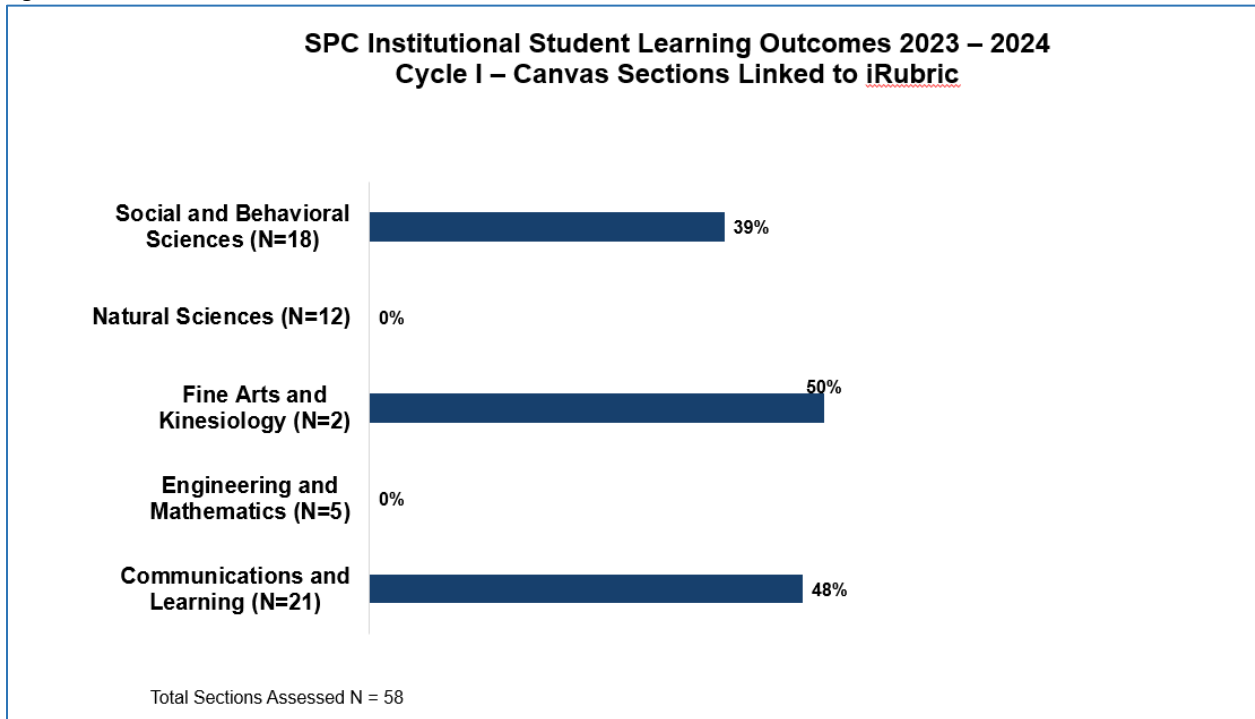
St. Philip's College uses a 2-year assessment cycle. Assessed in 2023-2024, Cycle I included **Communication, Critical Thinking, and Personal Responsibility**; Personal Responsibility is assessed every cycle as part of the institution's Quality Enhancement Plan – Ethical Decision-Making. The cycle is comprised of artifact collection and submission during the fall semester, followed by Calibration Training and Assessment Day activities in the spring semester. Students produce artifacts (student assignments) in all general education courses, and faculty submit this work for randomly selected course sections. Subsequently, departmental faculty assess these artifacts to determine learning outcome proficiency from the following levels: skillful, emerging, or not demonstrated; (i.e., Communications and Learning faculty assess courses from their departmental disciplines, et. al.). In 2023-2024 the additional rating of, Assignment Not Submitted, was created to account for students that did not submit the assessment assignment. This additional rating was necessary due to the upgraded version of iRubric used 2023-2024, which pulls the names of all students registered in the course sections, even if they did not submit the assessment assignment. Therefore, the number of assignments not submitted were counted into the course section total number. This allowed for a true representation of student skill level in each course section by accounting for every student enrolled.



Linking Canvas Course Sections to iRubric

In 2023-2024, all course sections being assessed were required to link their Canvas course section to iRubric. This new process was put in place to facilitate for IPRE to be able to automatically pull copies of the completed student assignments. Although the goal was to have 100% of the Canvas sections linked to iRubric, not all instructors linked their section. Some instructors were reluctant to the change, or used another unsupported platform to administer the assessment assignment. In 2024-2025, sections that do not link their Canvas sections to iRubric will receive an automatic rating of competencies *Not Demonstrated*. Electronic files will not be accepted for manual upload into iRubric. Figure 1 shows the percent of sections linked in 2023-2024 by department.

Figure 1. Canvas Sections Linked to iRubric 2023-2024

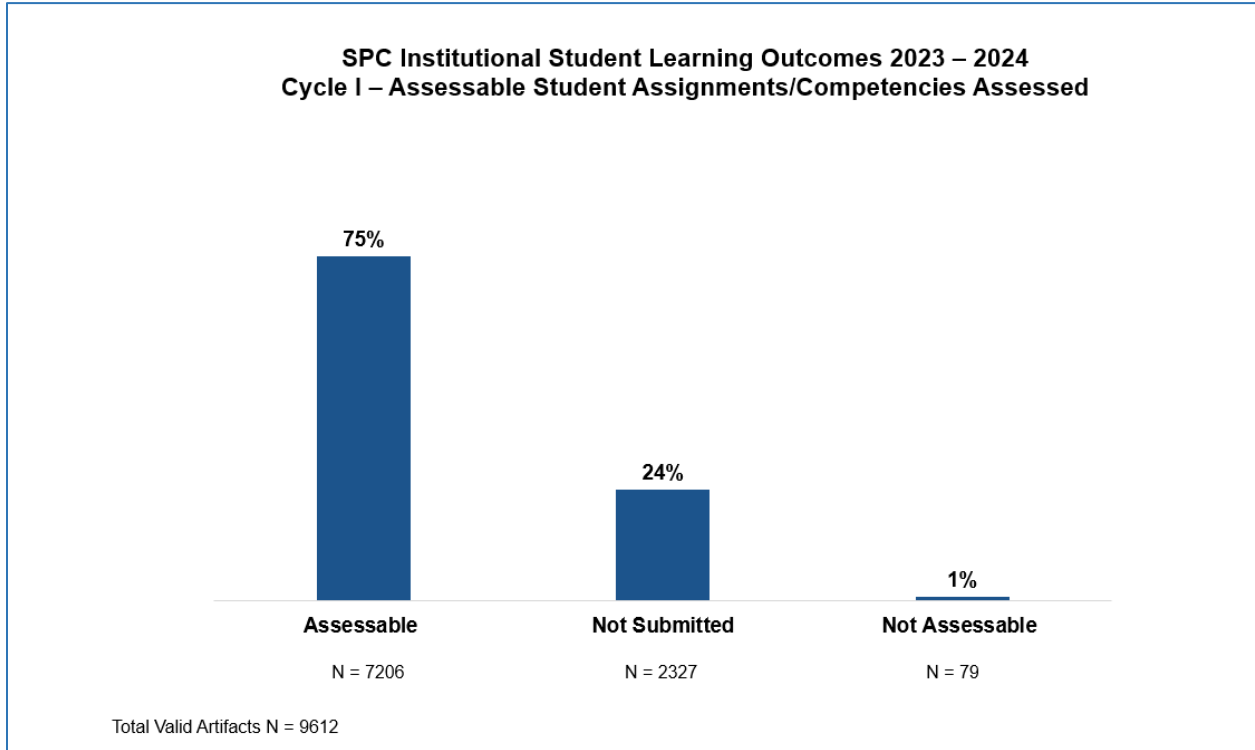


Assessment Day Results 2023 – 2024

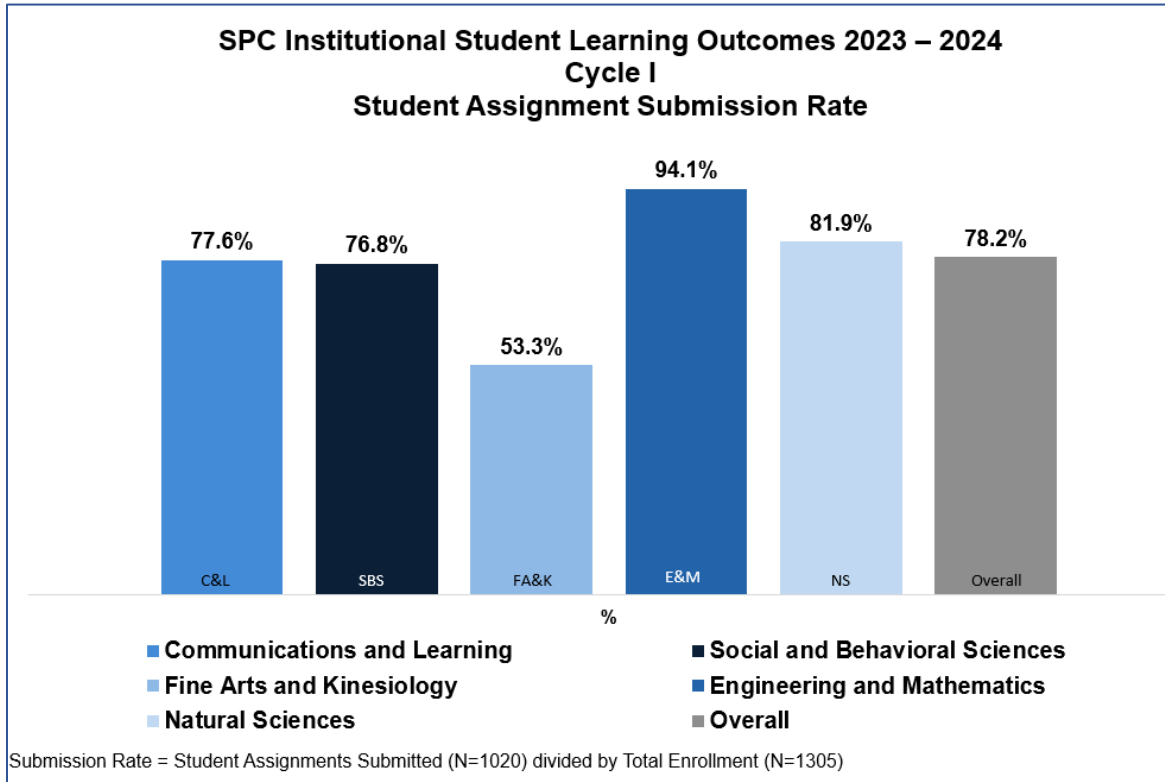
Figure 2. Assessable Student Assignments/Competencies Assessed 2023-2024

The Coordinator of Measurement and Evaluation shared the following overview of Institutional Student Learning Outcomes and results with SPC Faculty, Department Chairs, and Deans from across the college on April 12, 2024 via Teams (Appendix A). In 2023-2024 there were a total of 1,020 student assignments submitted for assessment. The total student enrollment for the 58 sections assessed was 1,305. Out of the 1,020 student assignments submitted, there were 1,007 valid student assignments and 13 were not assessable. When all the competencies and SLOs are taken into account, there were 9,612 SLOs to be assessed. Out of the 9,612, 75% were assessable, 24% were not submitted, and 1% were not assessable. Figure 2 shows the percent of assessable student assignments/competencies assessed for 2023-2024.

The submission rate of assessable artifacts (student assignments) by department were: Fine Arts & Kinesiology, 53%; Communications and Learning, 77%; Natural Sciences, 82%; Engineering and Mathematics, 94%; and Social and Behavioral Sciences, 77%. The overall assessable assignment rate was 78%.

Discussion of the Cycle I 2023 – 2024 results for Critical Thinking, Communication, and Personal Responsibility followed.

2023 – 2024 Cycle I Overall Results

As shown in Figure 3, overall skillful and emerging (S + E) results for 2023 – 2024 Cycle I did not meet the 70% target by 3.1%. It is important to note that assignments not submitted by the students were taken into account in the course section totals, therefore, the number of assignments that were skillful and emerging in each section were lower than in other years where unsubmitted assignments were not taken into account in the section totals. Accounting for all students enrolled in the course section ensures higher chances for a truly representative sample of the course section. For example, only counting five assignments submitted from a section of twenty students, does not show a clear level of student skill in that section. If we only counted the assignments submitted in 2023-2024, all areas would have an overall skillful and emerging (S + E) result over 70%. Since this was the first assessment cycle where we accounted for the student assignments not submitted, we cannot provide the longitudinal trends across Cycle I this year. We will compare 2023-2024 Cycle I to 2025-2026 Cycle I.



Figure 4. Overall S&E Assessment Results 2023-2024

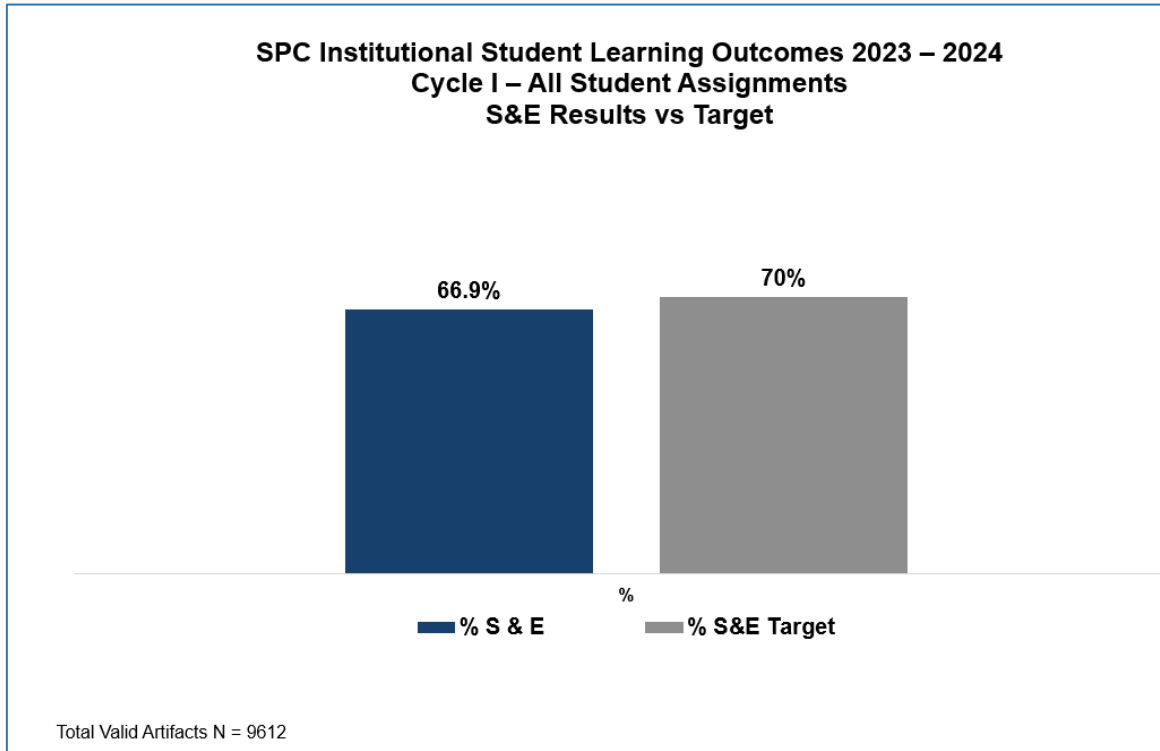
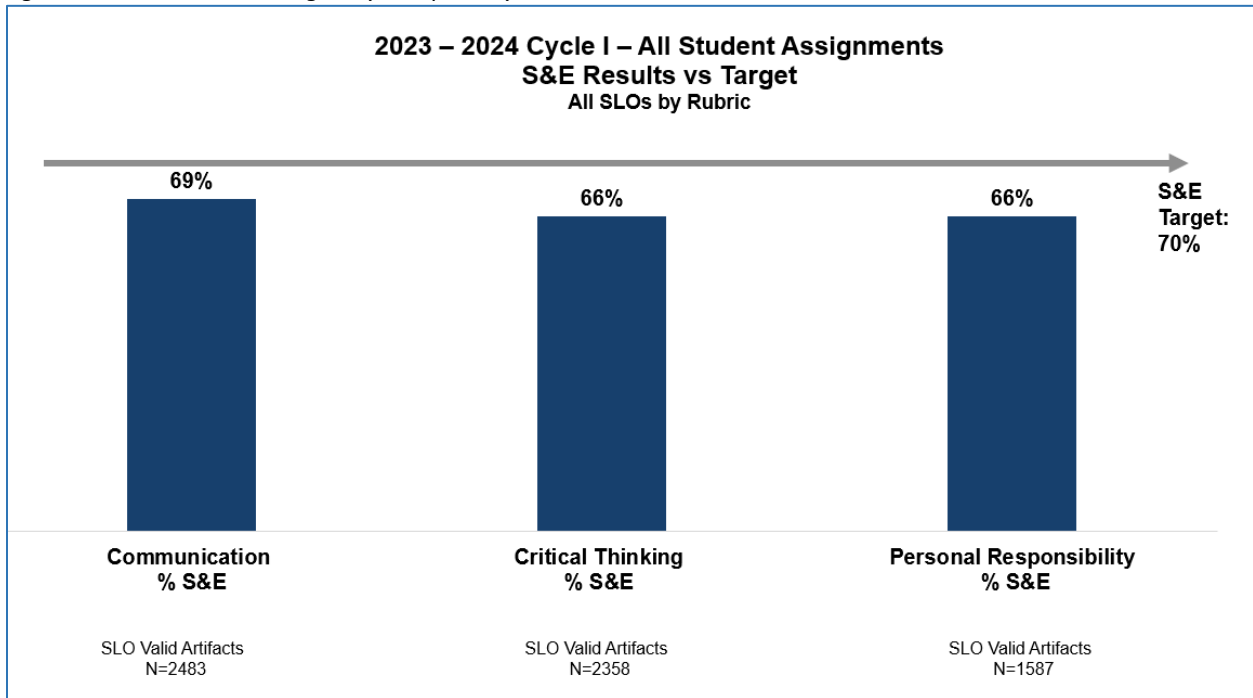


Figure 5 shows all Skillful and Emergent (S&E) results by competency. Seen in Figure 5, although close, none of SLOs for met the 70% target.

2023 – 2024 Cycle I Student Learning Outcome Results

Figures 6 through 8 feature Student Learning Outcomes (SLOs) by Core Competency. Figure 6 shows the Skillful and Emergent (S&E) results by for Communication competency (SLO1 Content and Purpose, SLO2 Organization, SLO3 Tools - Written).

Figure 6. Communication Competency Outcomes

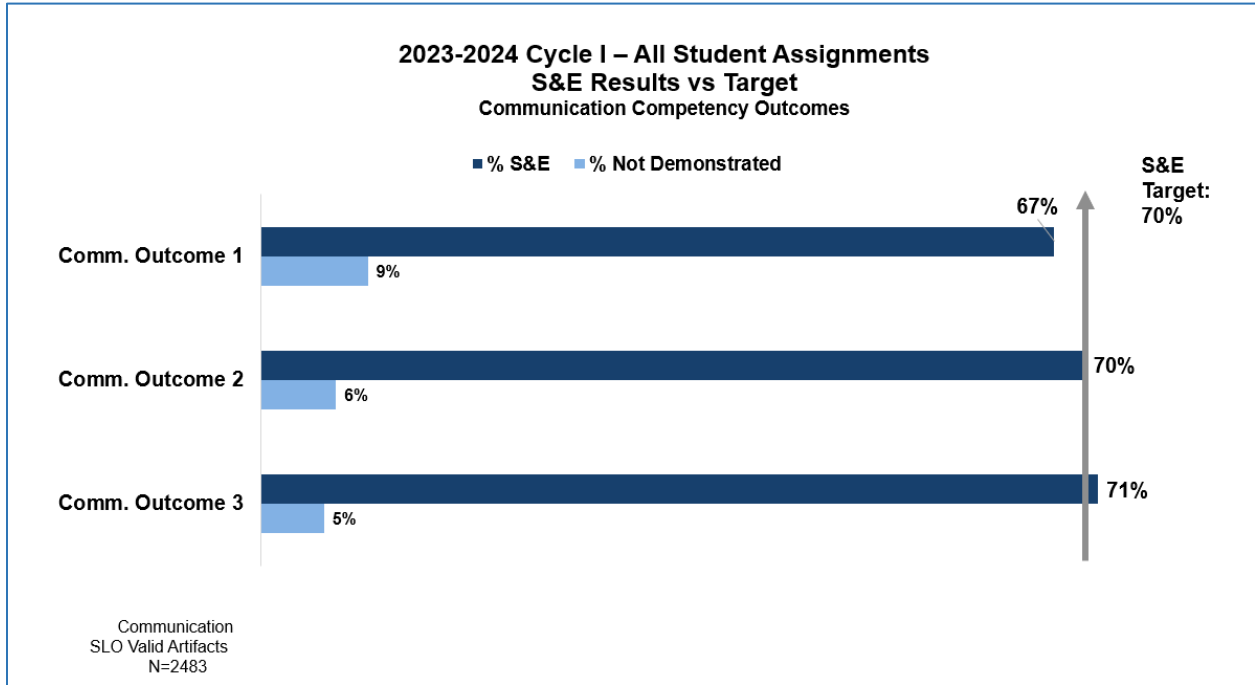


Figure 7 presents Critical Thinking SLO results. As shown, all 3 SLOs (SLO1 Inquiry and Analysis, SLO2 Evaluation and Synthesis, and SLO3 Creative Thinking and Innovation) did not demonstrate the Skillful and Emerging target of 70%.



Figure 7. Critical Thinking

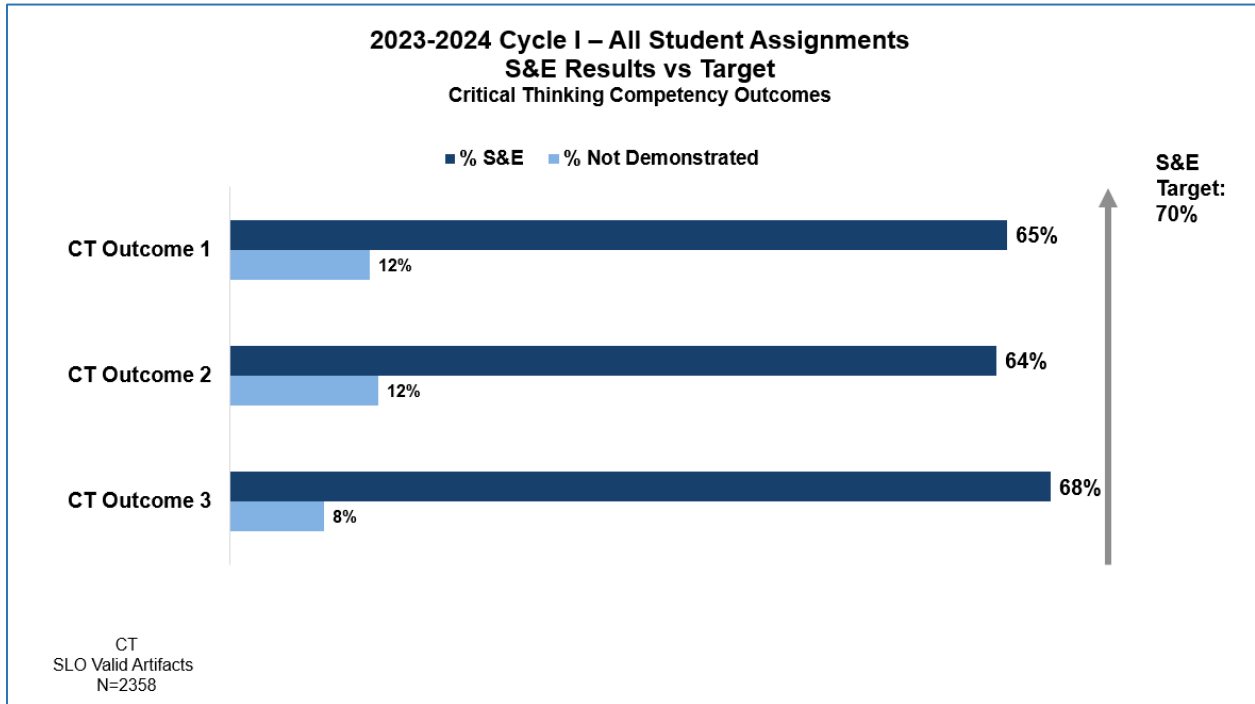
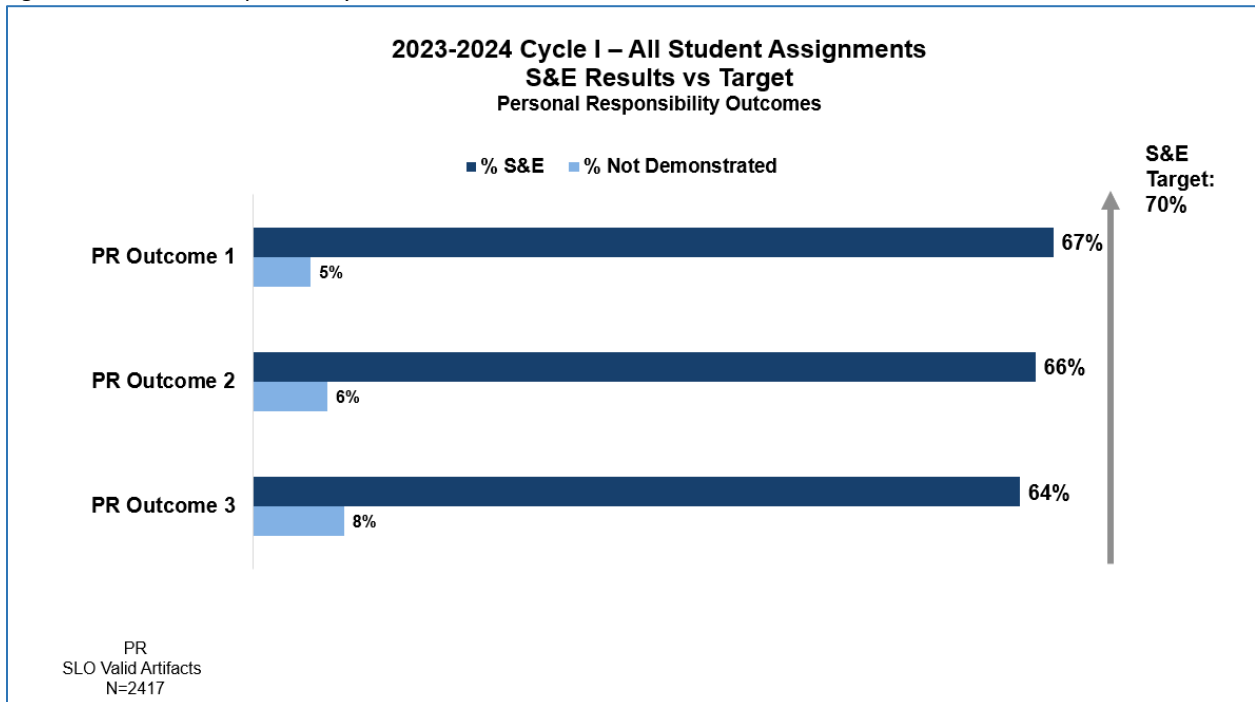


Figure 8. Personal Responsibility



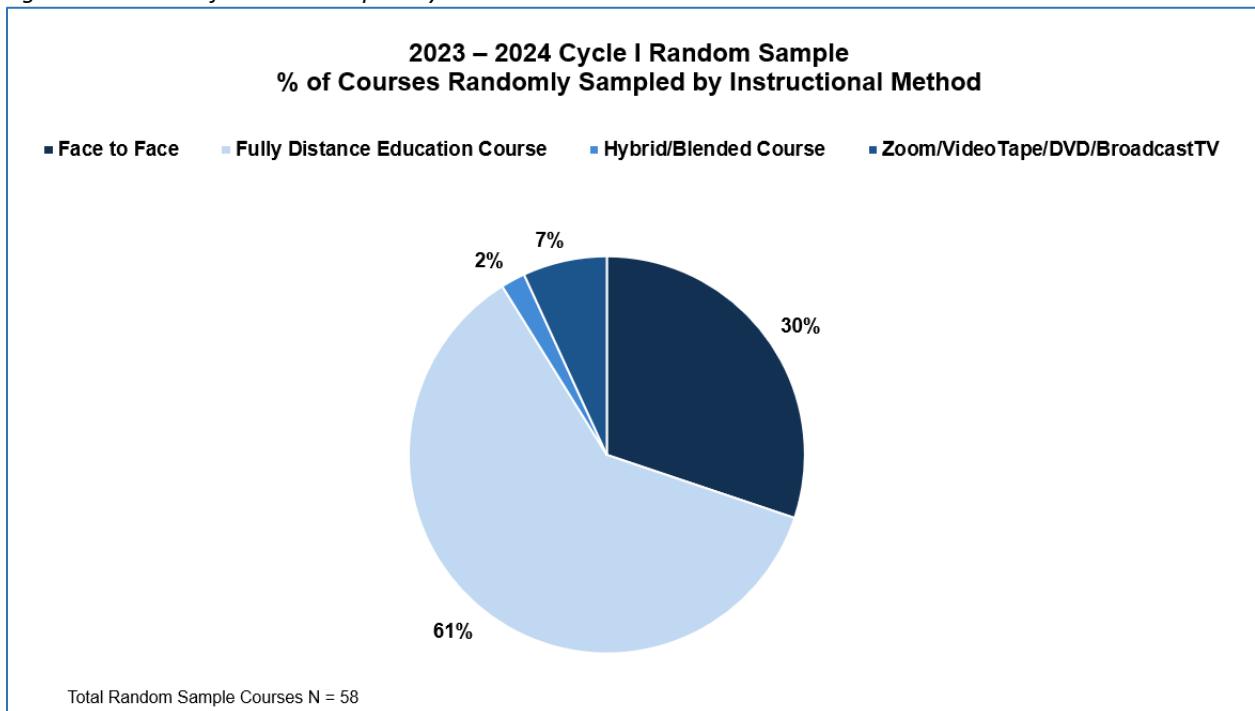
Displayed in Figure 8, Personal Responsibility SLO1 (Ethical Issues), features the highest average Skillful and Emerging score for this assessment cycle at 90%. Students performed higher in SLO1 than SLO2 and SLO3. SLO2 (Perspectives) scored above the target at 85%, and SLO3 (Values), scored at 77%.



2023 – 2024 Cycle I Instructional Method Analysis

Annual ISLO assessment random sample includes general education courses offered through various instructional methods. Figures 9 – 12 display data and results by face to face, fully distance, Hybrid/Blended course, and Zoom/Video/Broadcast TV instructional methods. Figure 9 (below) addresses the percentage included by instructional method. Fully distance accounted for over half of all assessments completed (61%).

As seen in Figure 10, Communication skills overall SLO results differed by instructional method, with Face to Face course results exceeding all other instructional methods. For SLO1 (Content and Purpose), Face to Face and Hybrid Blended tied at 70%. SLO2 (Organization) had 73% in Face to Face sections, and SLO3 (Tools - Written) also had 73%. Hybrid Blended courses scored as the second highest in all three SLOs with percentages of 70%. Zoom/video Tape/DVD/Broadcast TV results fall below the 70% target in all three SLOs by up to 16%.



Figure 10. Communication Skills SLO Comparison by Instructional Method

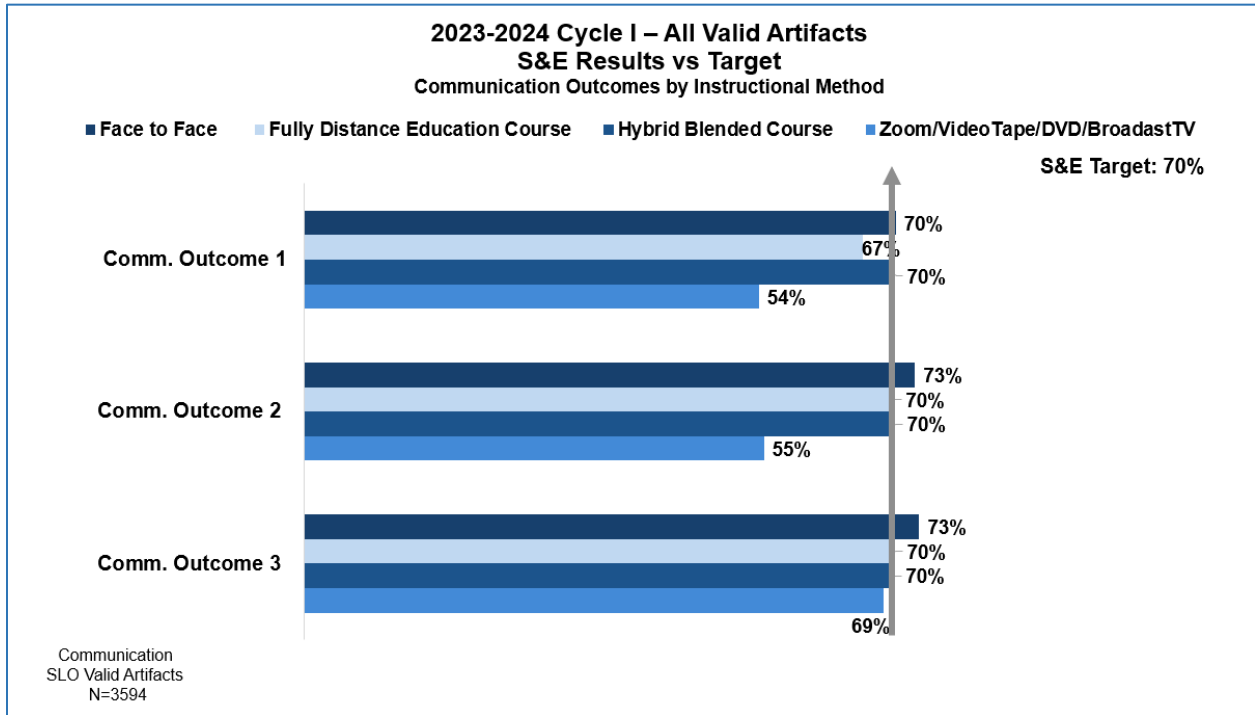


Figure 11. Critical Thinking SLO Comparison by Instructional Method

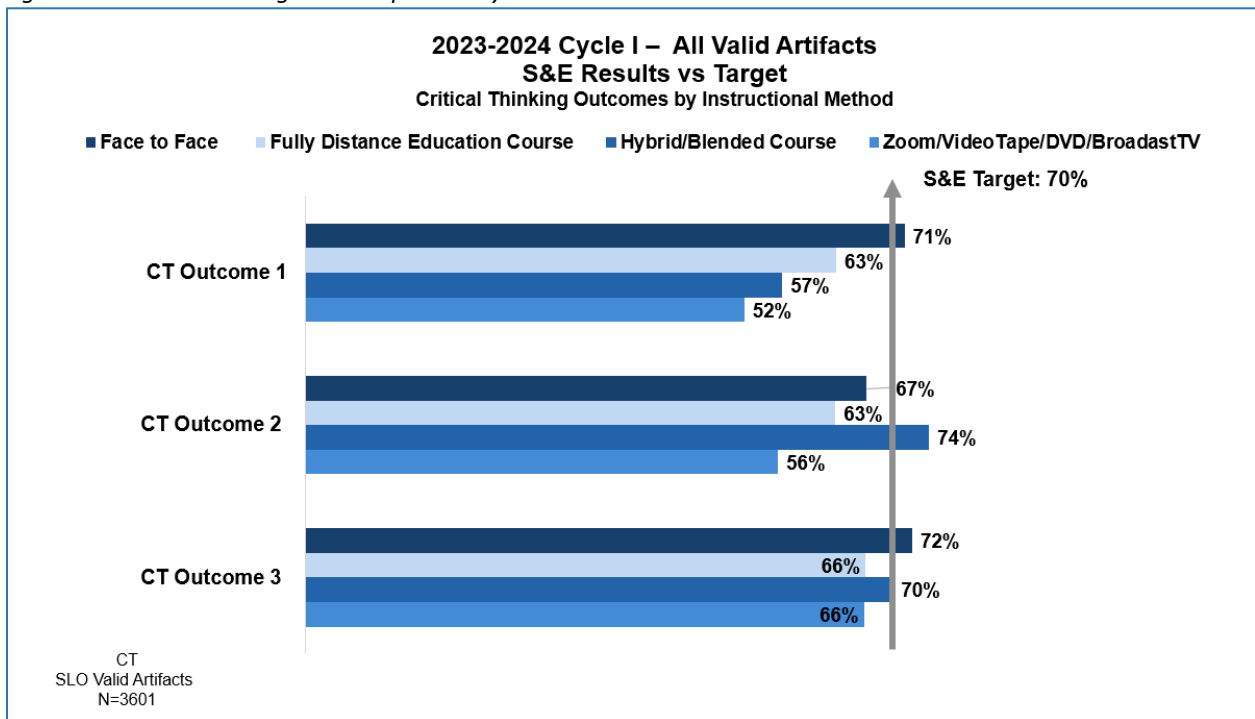
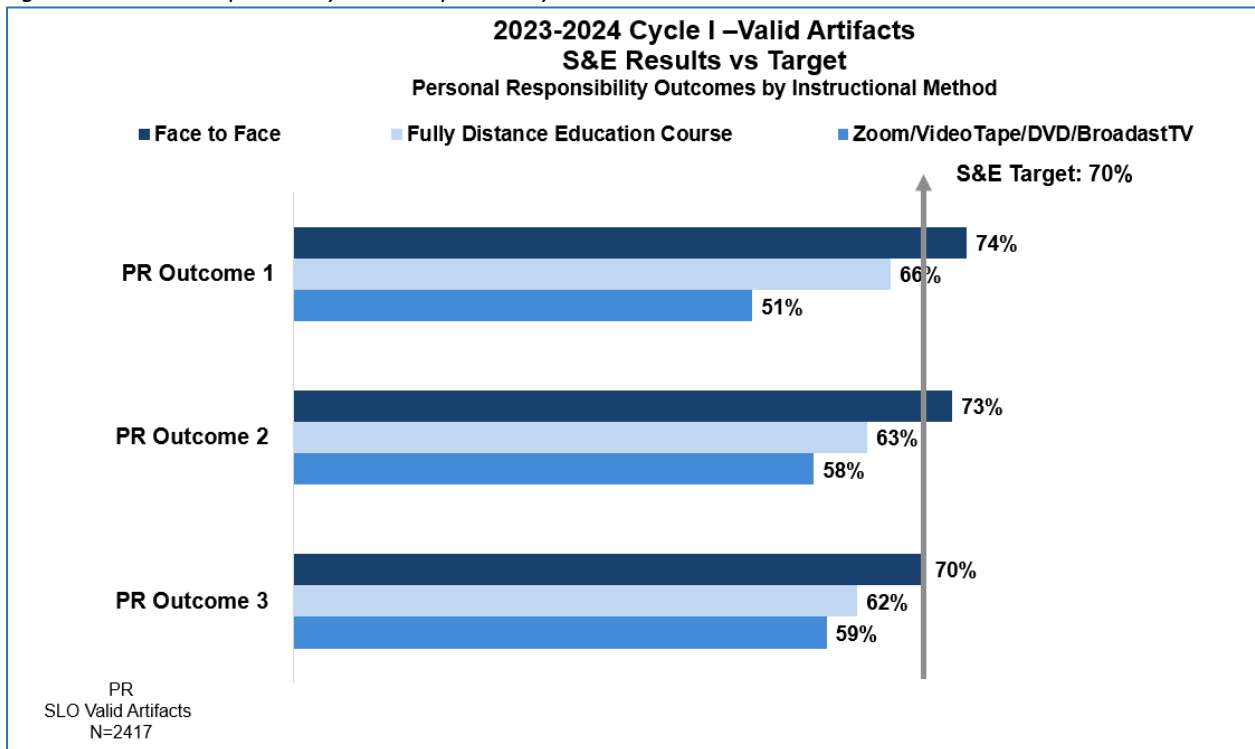




Figure 11 reveals highest results for Critical Thinking in Face to Face and Hybrid Blended courses. For SLO1 (Inquiry and Analysis), there is a high deviation between Face to Face at 71% and Fully Distance instruction at 63%. However, there is a considerably lower score in Zoom/Video Tape/DVD/Broadcast TV that is 19% lower than Face to Face at 52%. For SLO2 (Evaluation and Synthesis), there is a lower deviation between Hybrid Blended and Face to Face instruction at 74% and face to face at 67%. Zoom/Video Tape/DVD/Broadcast TV considerably lower by 18%. SLO3 (Creative Thinking and Innovation) has the highest in Face to Face at 72%, followed by Hybrid/Blended courses at 70%. Fully Distance and Zoom/Video Tape/DVD/Broadcast TV are the lowest at 66% each. All results for Face to Face and/or Hybrid/Blended SLOs fall above the 70% target.

Addressed in Figure 12, Personal Responsibility shows consistent results with face to face having the highest percentages (74%, 73%, 70%), Fully Distance Education instruction second across all SLOs (66%, 63%, 62%), and the lowest in Zoom/Video Tape/DVD/Broadcast TV (51%, 58%, and 59%). Fully Distance and Zoom/Video Tape/DVD/Broadcast TV results fall below the 70% target in all three SLOs (SLO1 Ethical Issues, SLO2 Perspectives, and SLO 3 Values).

Figure 12. Social Responsibility SLO Comparison by Instructional Method



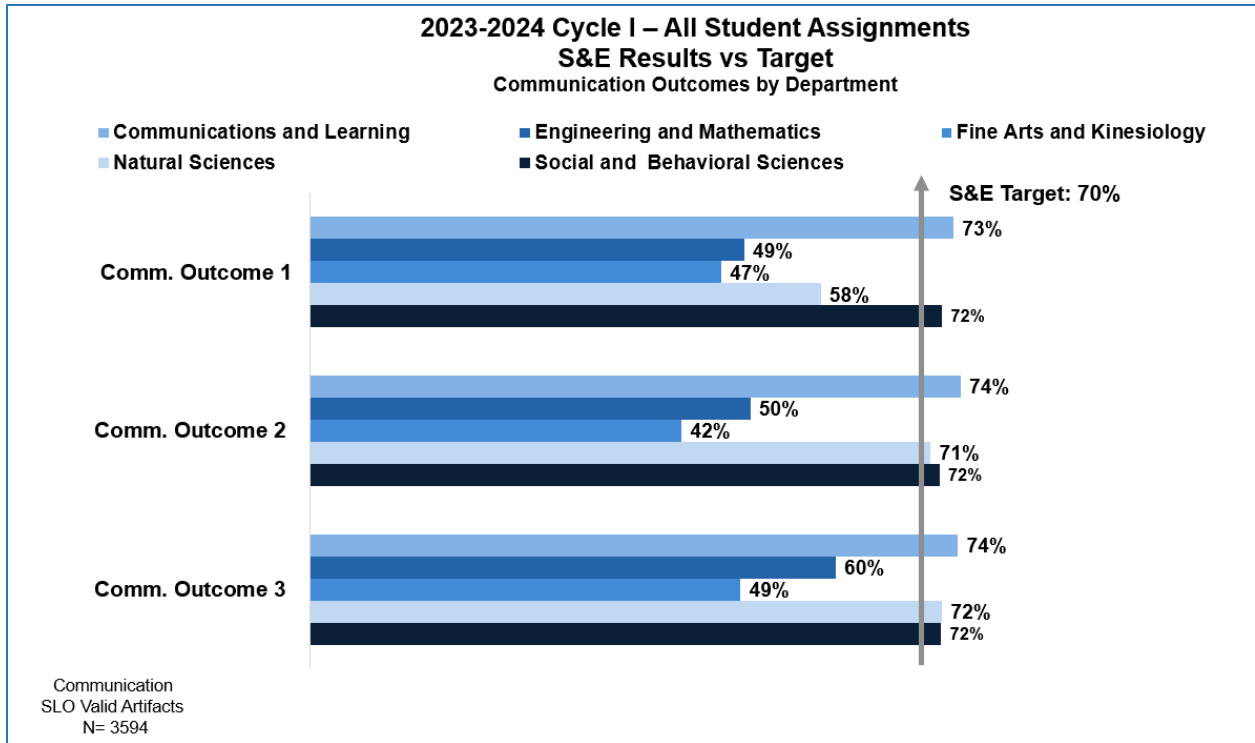
2023 – 2024 Cycle I Departmental Results by Student Learning Outcome

Annual ISLO assessment random sample includes general education courses offered by all Arts and Sciences Departments: Communications and Learning (C&L), Engineering and Mathematics (E&M), Fine Arts and Kinesiology (F&A), Natural Sciences (NS), and Social and Behavioral Sciences (SBS). Figures 13 – 16 display data and results by core competency and department. Figure 13 (below) addresses Communication Skills overall Skillful and Emerging by department. Communications and Learning and Social and Behavioral Sciences scored over 70% in all three SLOs (SLO1 Content and Purpose, SLO2 Organization, SLO3 Tolls-Written). Natural Sciences scored over 70% in SLO 2 and SLO3. Engineering and



Mathematics and Fine Arts and Kinesiology both had considerably lower scores with Fine Arts and Kinesiology consistently in the 40's and lowest score of 42% in SLO2.

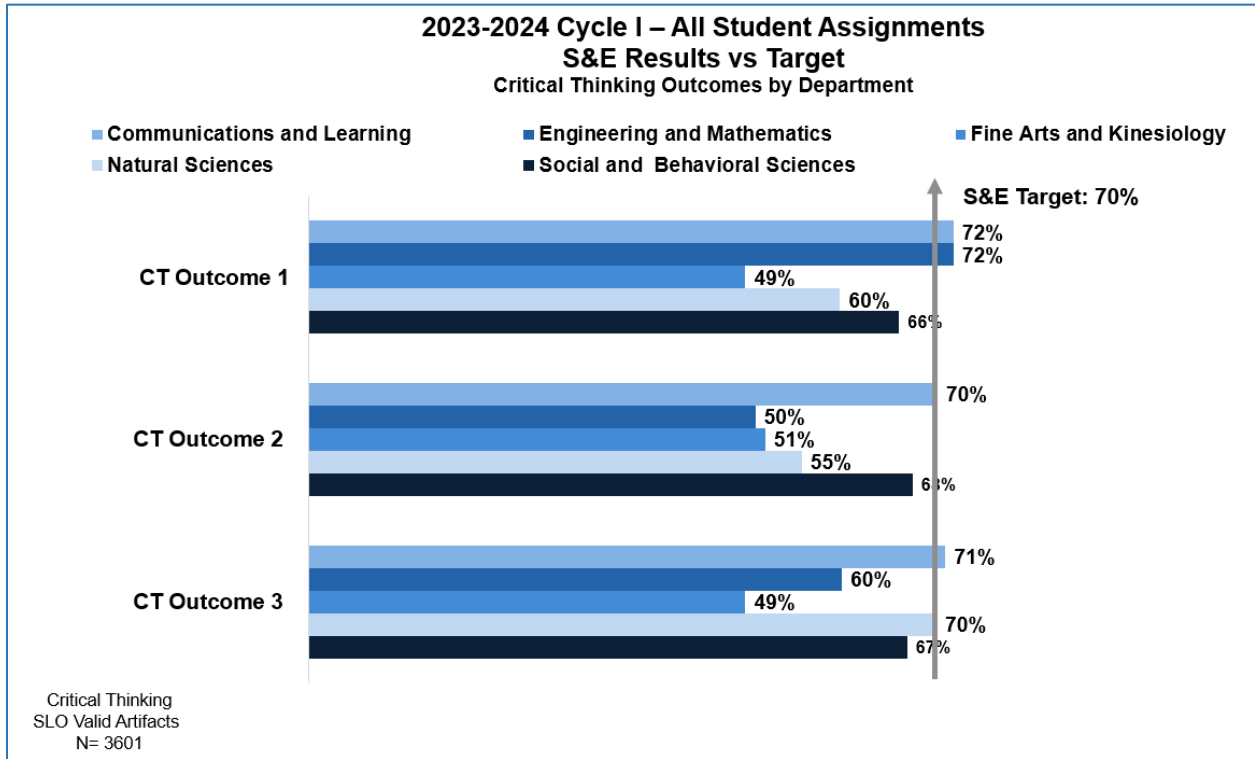
Figure 13. Communication Skills SLOs by Department

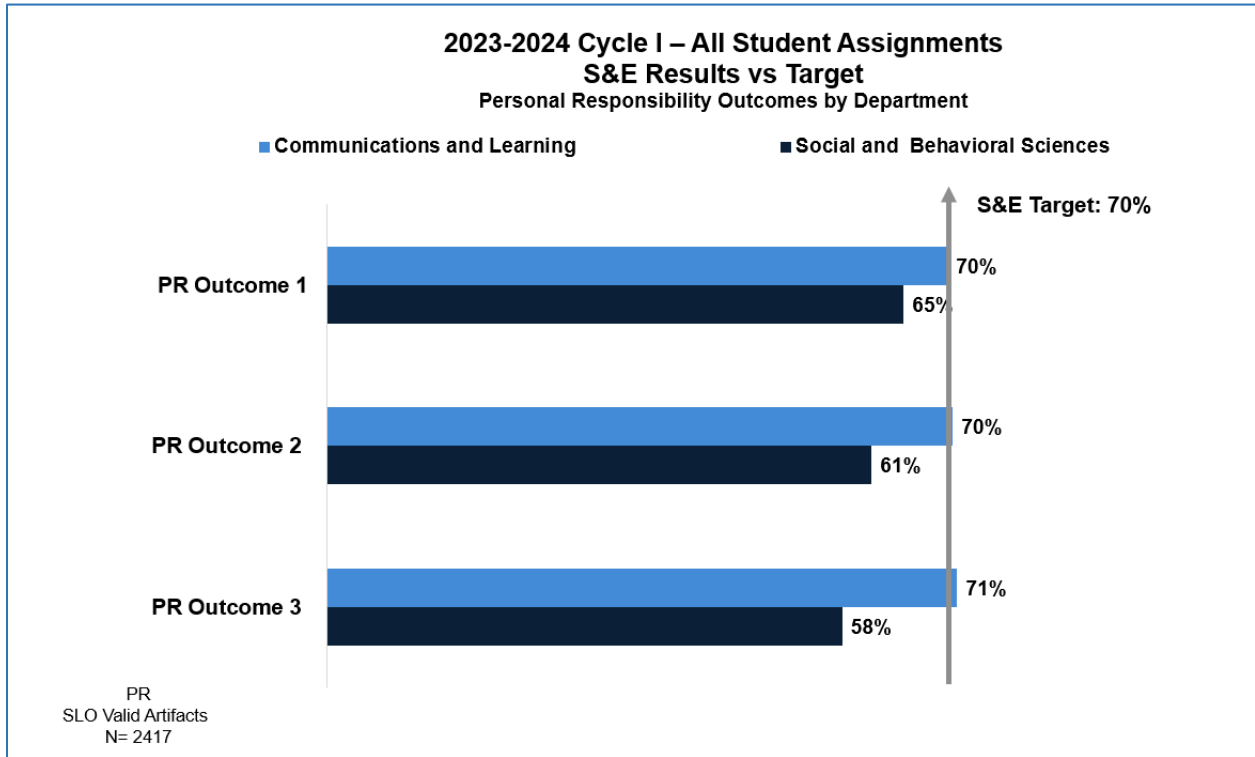
Figure 14. Critical Thinking SLOs by Department

As seen in Figure 14, Communications and Learning was the only department to meet the 70% target for Critical Thinking Skillful and Emerging results across all SLOs (SLO1 Inquiry and Analysis, SLO2 Evaluation and Synthesis, SLO3 Creative Thinking and Innovation). Engineering and Mathematics met the 70% target for SLO1. Fine Arts and Kinesiology had the lowest scores with 49% in SLO1 and SLO3.

Shown in Figure 15, only two departments were assessed in Personal responsibility, Communications and Learning and Social and Behavioral Sciences. Communications and Learning met the 70% target in Personal Responsibility across the three SLOs (SLO1 Ethical Issues, SLO2 Perspectives, SLO3 Values). Social and Behavioral Sciences did not meet the 70% target with scores between 58-65% in the three SLOs.

Shown in Figure 16, when just looking at all student assignments by competency, all three competencies surpass the 70% target with Personal responsibility at 89%, Critical Thinking at 88%, and Communication at 89%.

2023 – 2024 Off-campus Instructional Sites (OCIS)

Figure 16. Results by Core Competency across Off-Campus Instructional Sites

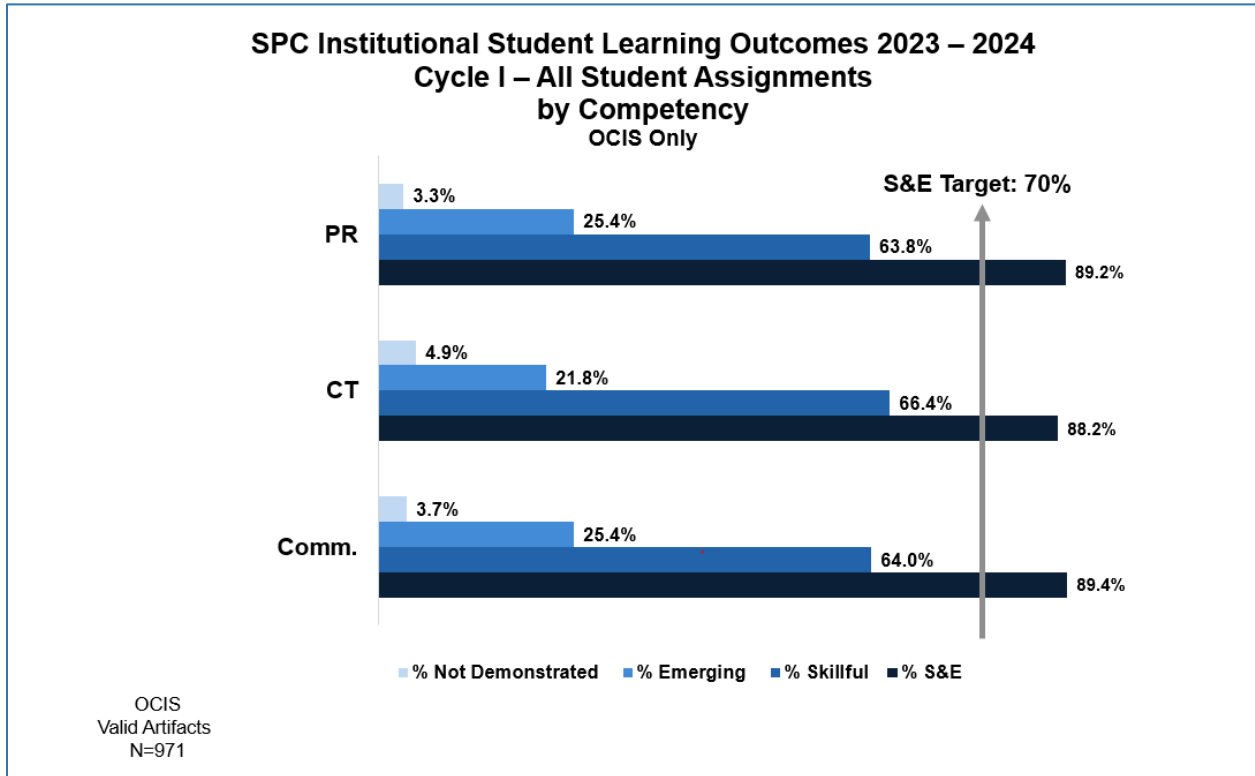


Figure 16 features overall core competency results for Off-Campus Instructional Sites (OCIS). As displayed, targets were exceeded by 18.2 – 19.4% across all competencies. OCIS included in the assessment: Alamo Heights HS, Ingram HS, Judson HS, Seguin DC/ECHS, and Wagner HS.

Improvements 2023 – 2024

Accountability forms were once again gathered electronically. This made it easier for Department Chairs to ensure their faculty submitted the forms. In 2022-2023, Assessment Day was separated into three days/activities for everyone’s convenience: Calibration Training Day (held by IPRE during department meeting), Individual Assessment (Assessors had 1 week to complete), and Consensus Scoring Day. In 2023-2024, the process was further improved. Course folders were opened one week early for Assessors to begin reviewing and scoring student assignments. The folders were opened as soon as all departments completed Calibration Training. The Assessors received their assignments from the Department Chairs and did not have to show up to Individual Assessment Day to receive their assignments. IPRE was still available in case there were any questions.

There was excellent participation in all activities held. A survey to measure satisfaction regarding Assessment Day Activities was distributed to Assessors, Department Chairs, and Dean. Unfortunately, the response rate for the survey was low and only 6 responses were received. The results were as



follows: 2 of 6 respondents were Very Satisfied, 1 of 6 were Satisfied, 1 of 6 were Neutral, 1 of 6 were Dissatisfied, and 1 of 6 were Very Dissatisfied. When asked if they felt the process was easier than in previous years, 4 of 6 responded Yes, 1 responded No, and 1 did not respond.

Electronic survey forms were used for Closing the Loop Action Plans. The electronic survey forms allowed for more faculty feedback and interaction. All course faculty were required to submit the form, even if they met the 70% target. The faculty feedback forms were to be completed by all 58 faculty who had a course assessed during this cycle and provided the opportunity for faculty to develop specific action plans to address any shortcomings or intended improvements. The submission rate of faculty feedback forms was 74%. The Discipline Leads survey form allowed the 18 Discipline Leads to complete one form per discipline (not by course) as well as collecting more general action plans from discipline leads that can be implemented throughout discipline courses. The submission rate of the Discipline Leads survey form was 72%. Chairs provided important feedback and were part of the process of improvements during the 2023-2024 cycle.

Challenges 2023 -2024

In previous years, the reliability of assessment results was questionable due to a high non-submission of student assignments for certain courses, and only the assignments submitted were included in the score for each section. For example, if only 5 of 15 students submitted the assignment, the score was based on those 5 assignments only. In 2022-2023, nine out of sixty-four courses had less than 50% submission rates based on assignment submission/total enrollment (14% of courses). In 2023-2024, nine out of fifty-eight courses had less than 50% submission rates based on assignment submission/total enrollment (15% of courses). Although we still had courses with low assignment submission rates in 2023-2024, all students enrolled in the course section were accounted for and included in the section score. We expect that in 2024-2025, the number of course sections with low assignment submittal rates will decrease.

Additional Showcase Results and Discussion 2023-2024

Feedback and strategies for improvement highlighted faculty modifying assignment due dates to be able to meet the IPRE deadline for assignment submissions. Gaps were seen as artifact collection commenced in fall 2023; specifically, some faculty reported problems linking their Canvas course sections to iRubric, and some faculty just did not link their course sections. Faculty Assessors reported to be very satisfied with the training, assistance, and support provided during the assessment cycle. They particularly liked having Assessment Day activities separated, rather than everything completed in one day. They also liked having the course folders opened one week earlier and the flexibility to complete their individual assessments on their own.

Although 2023-2024 may be considered a hard year for faculty teaching the courses because some new guidelines were implemented, we expect that 2024-2025 will be more efficient and accurate in results. Due to the change in all students enrolled in a course section being taken into account into the section score, we expect that faculty will find ways to further incentivize students to submit the assessment assignments and the sections will receive higher and more accurate scores. In 2024-2025 IPRE will not be accepting electronic files of student assignments to manually upload into iRubric, and sections that are not linked to iRubric will receive an automatic score of *Not Demonstrated*. With this in mind, we expect that all courses being assessed will link the assignment to iRubric and have a higher submission rate in 2024-2025. As mentioned at the beginning, the overall skillful and emerging (S + E) results for 2023 – 2024 Cycle I missed the 70% target by 3.1%. However, we are highly optimistic that the experience from the 2023-2024 cycle, as well as increased and earlier preparation sessions will increase the results in 2024-2025.

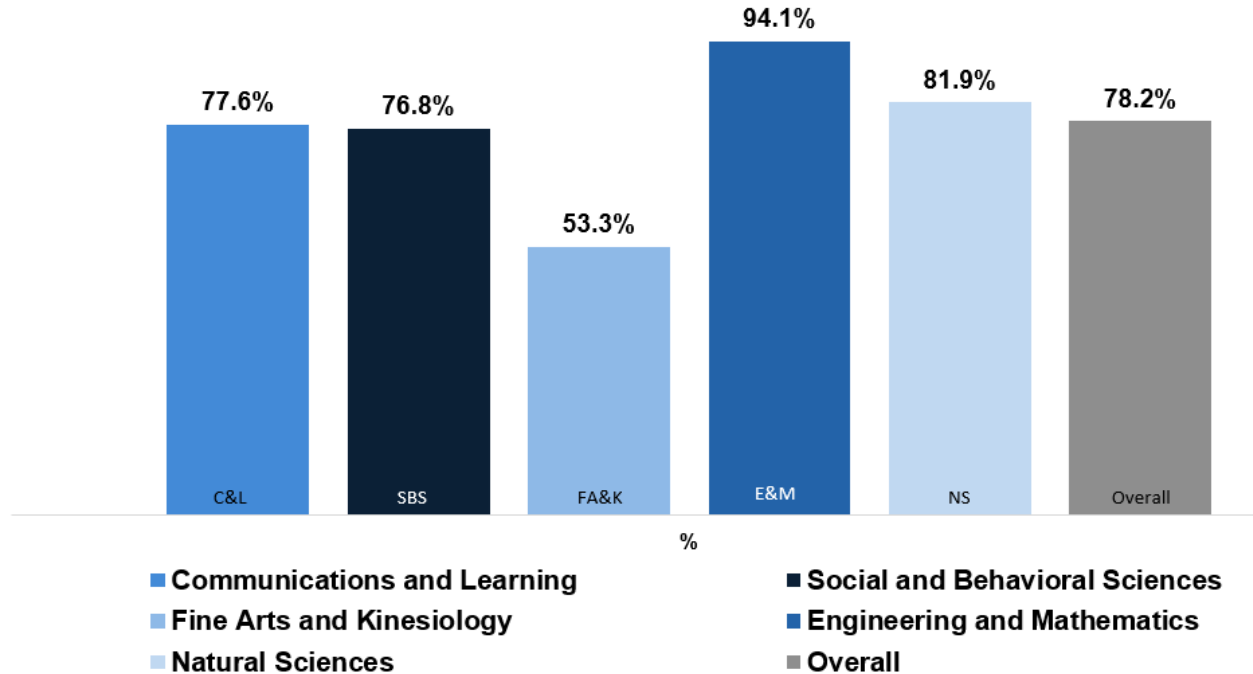

CYCLE I OVERALL RESULTS



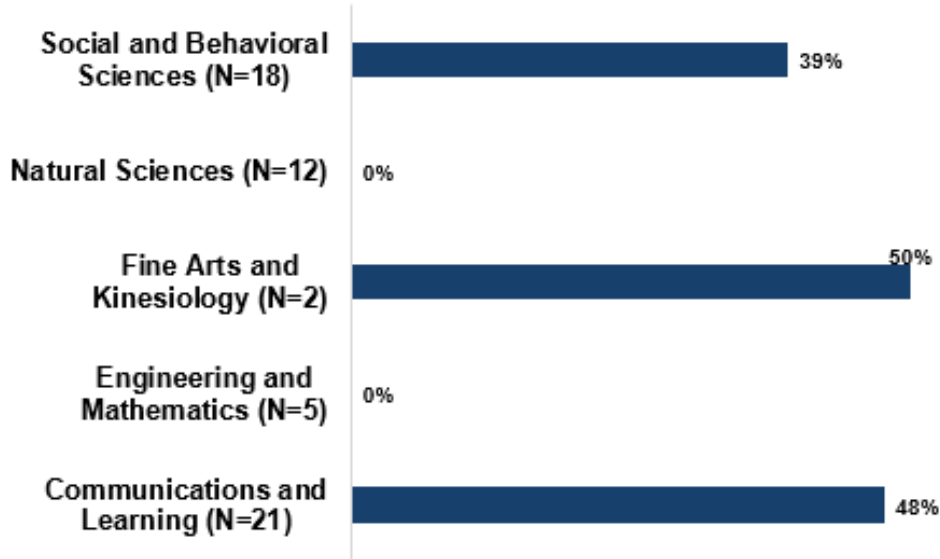
SPC Institutional Student Learning Outcomes 2023 – 2024 Cycle I Student Assignment Submission Rate

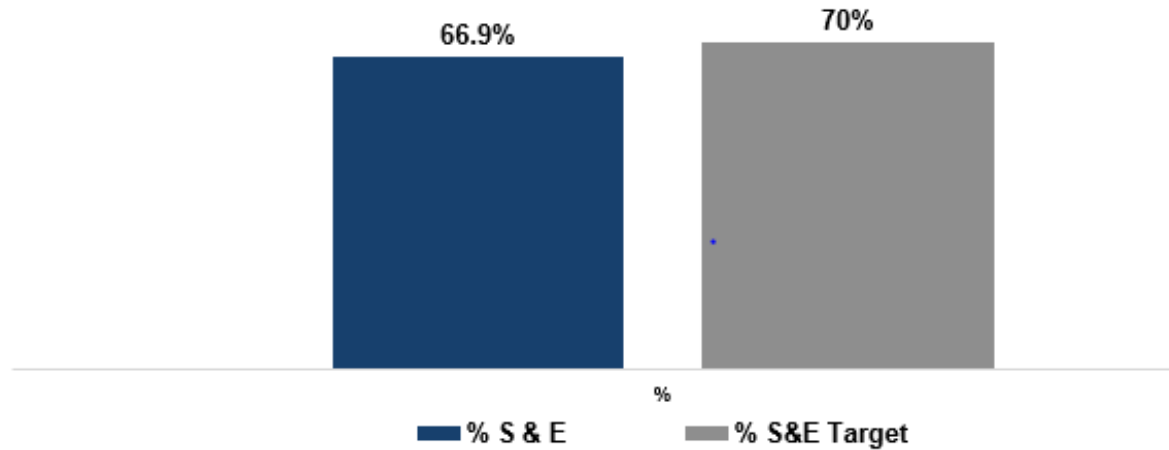
SPC Institutional Student Learning Outcomes 2023 – 2024 Cycle I – Canvas Sections Linked to iRubric

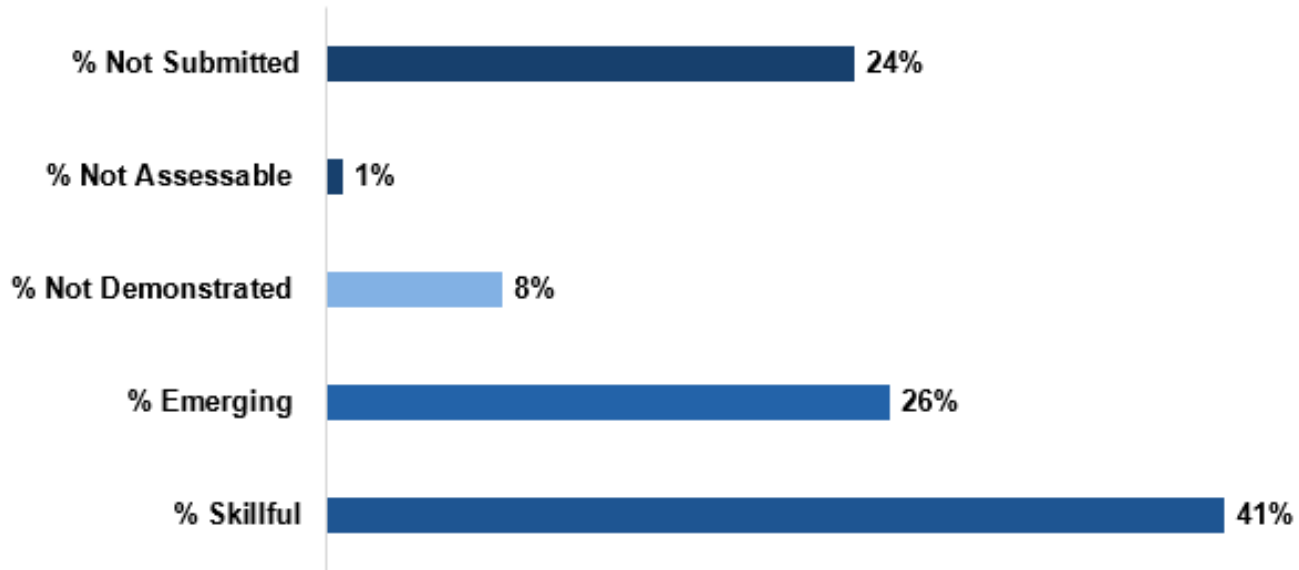
SPC Institutional Student Learning Outcomes 2023 – 2024 Cycle I – All Student Assignments S&E Results vs Target

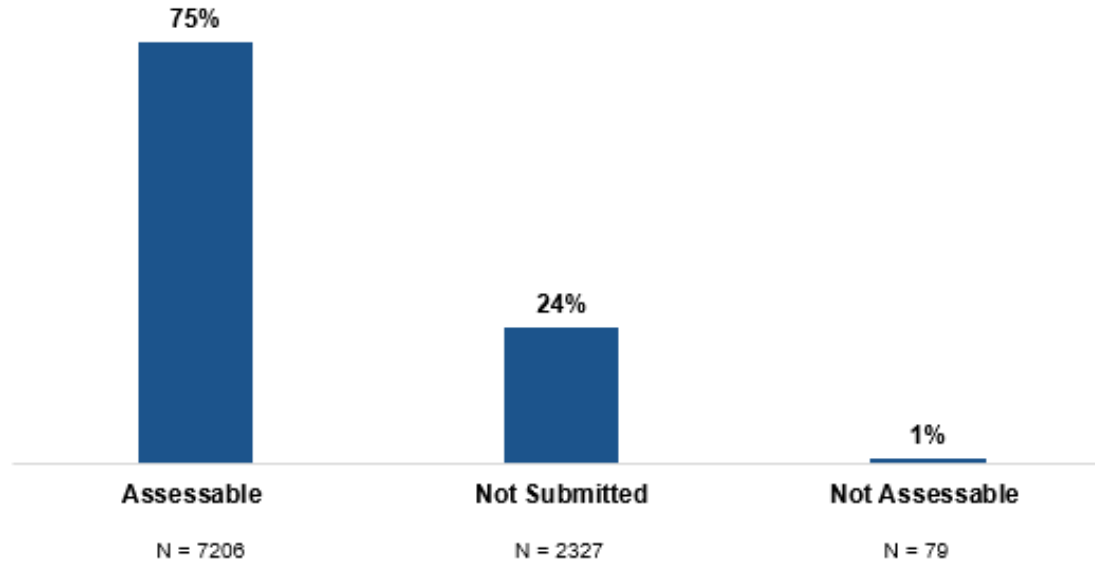

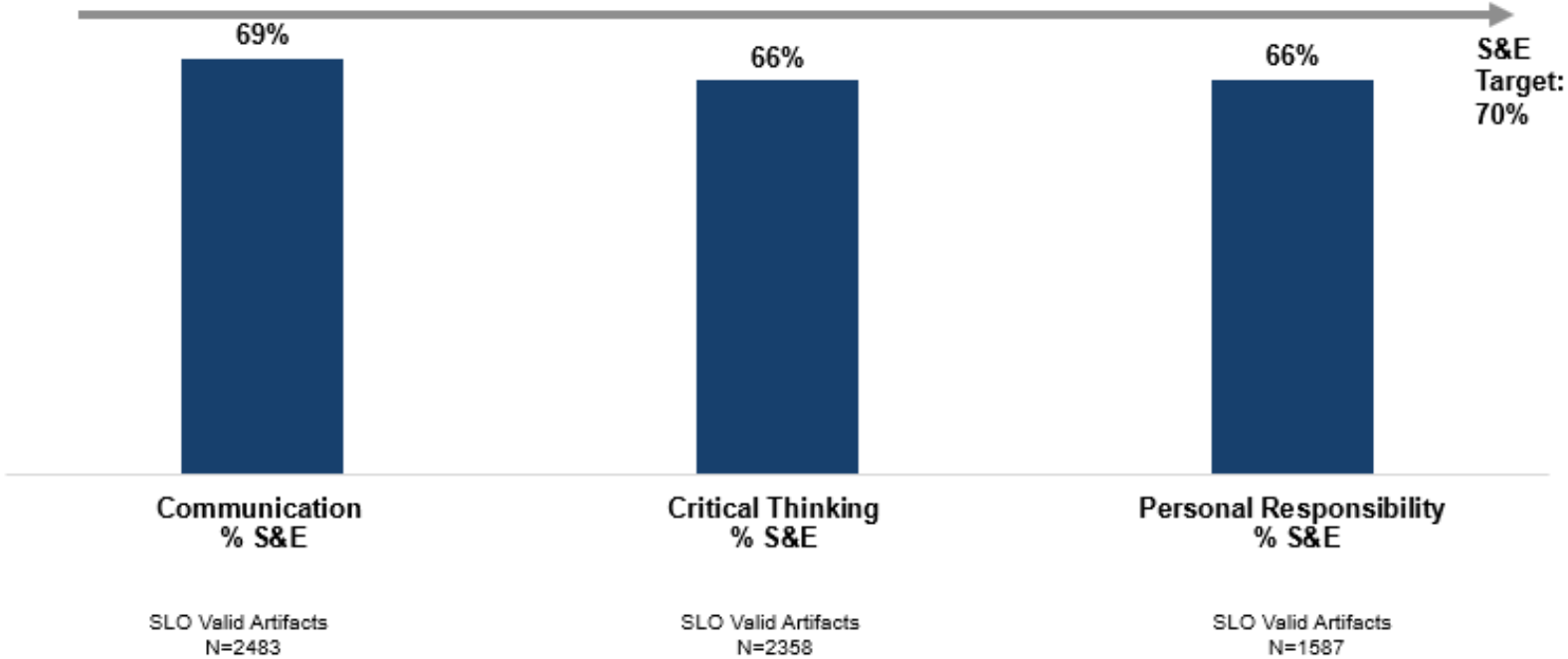

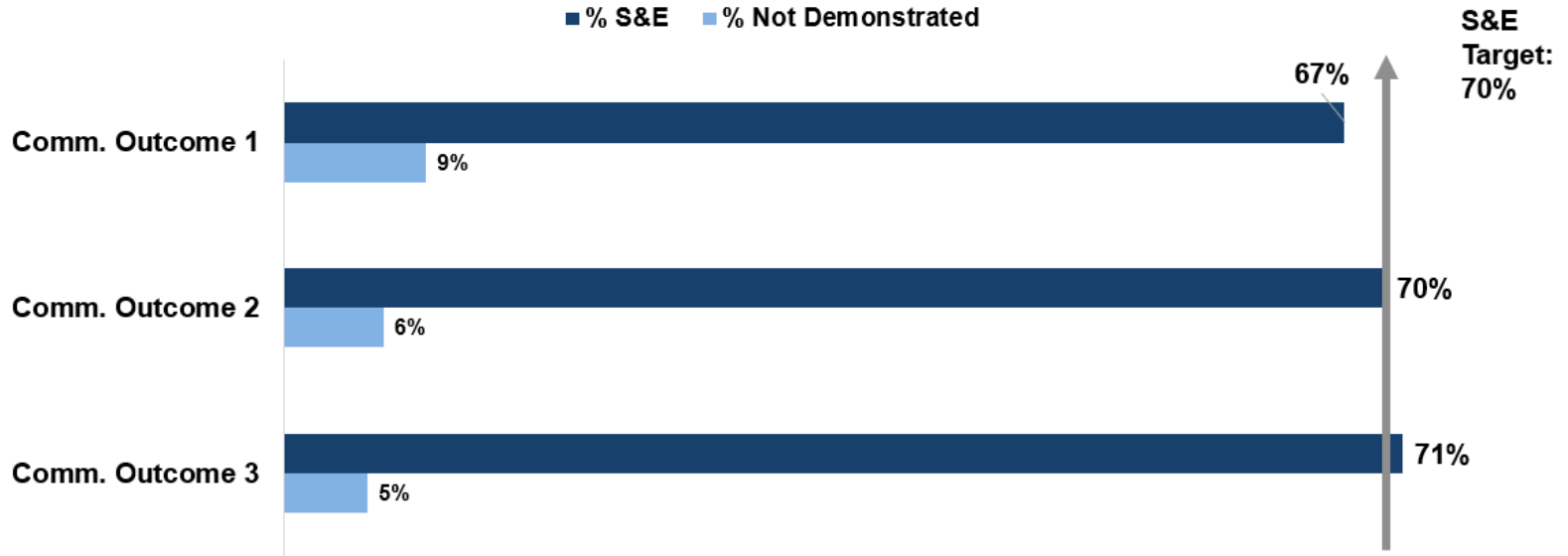

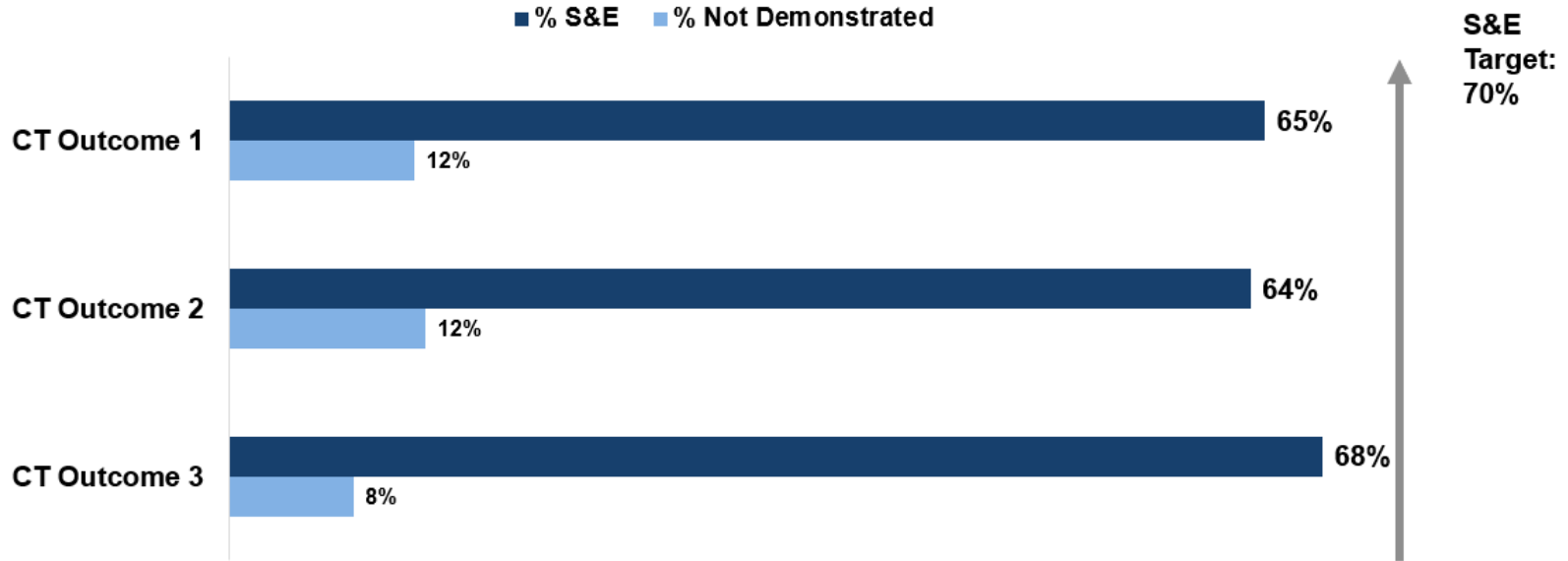

2023-2024 Cycle I – All Student Assignments S&E Results vs Target Critical Thinking Competency Outcomes

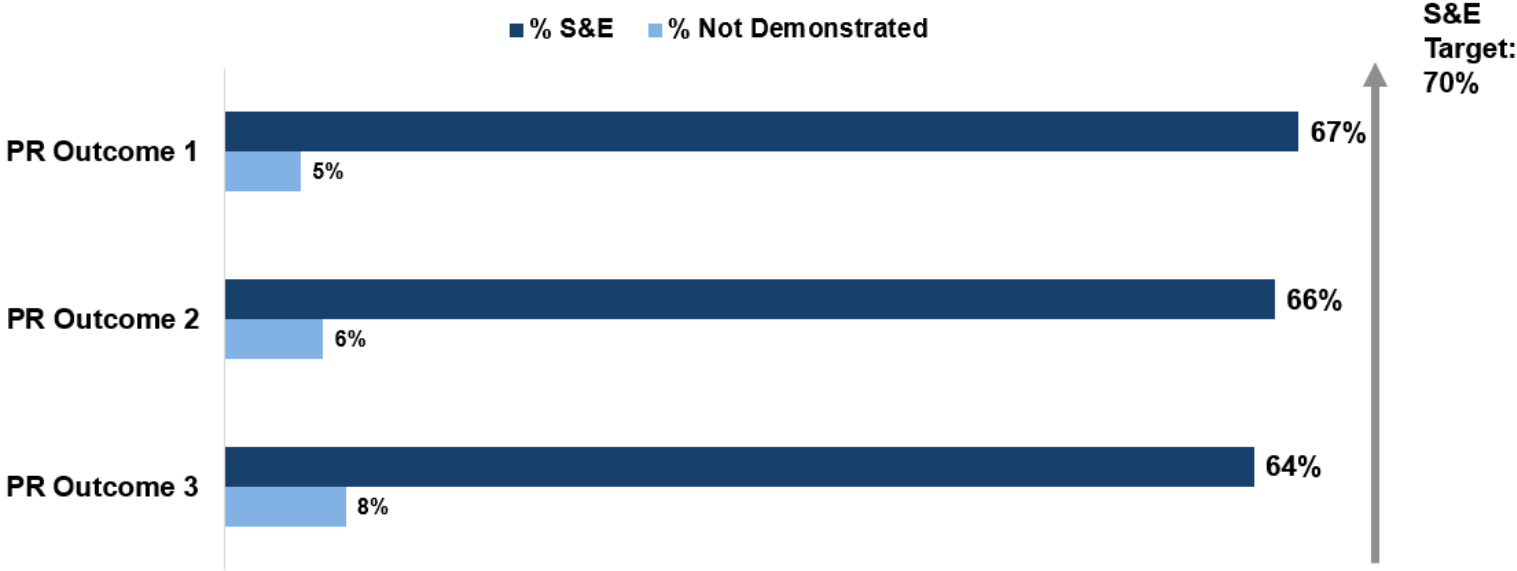

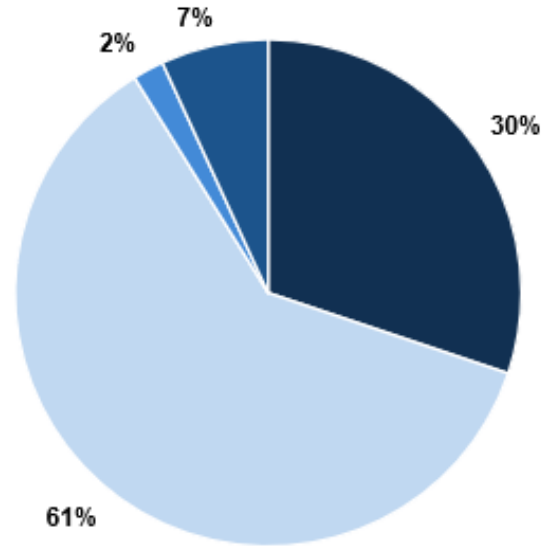

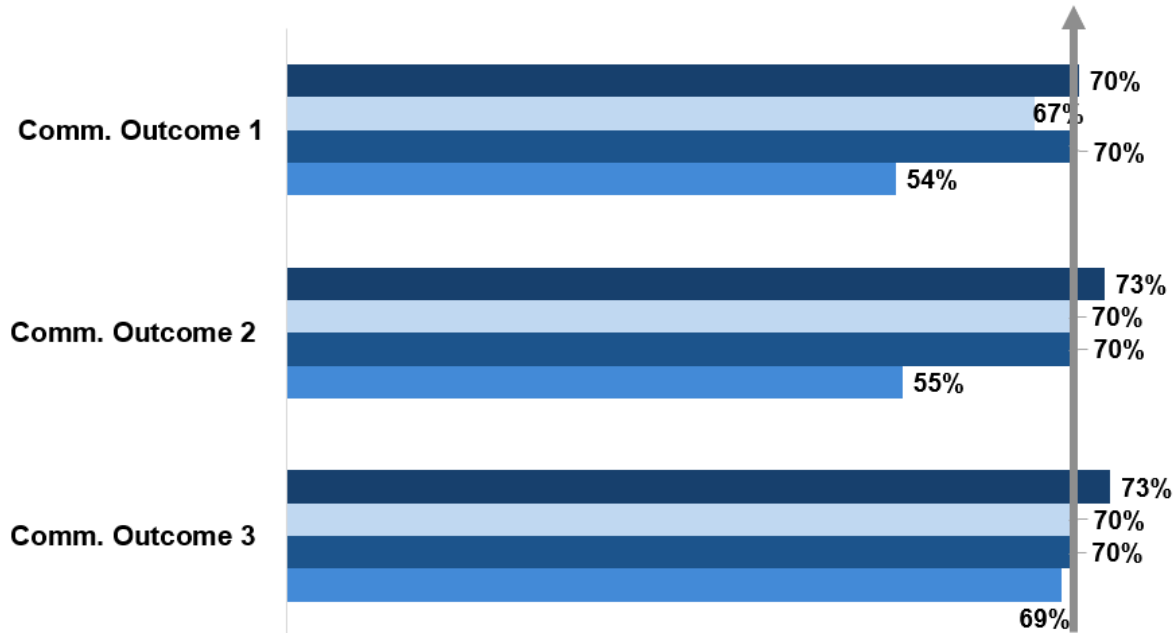

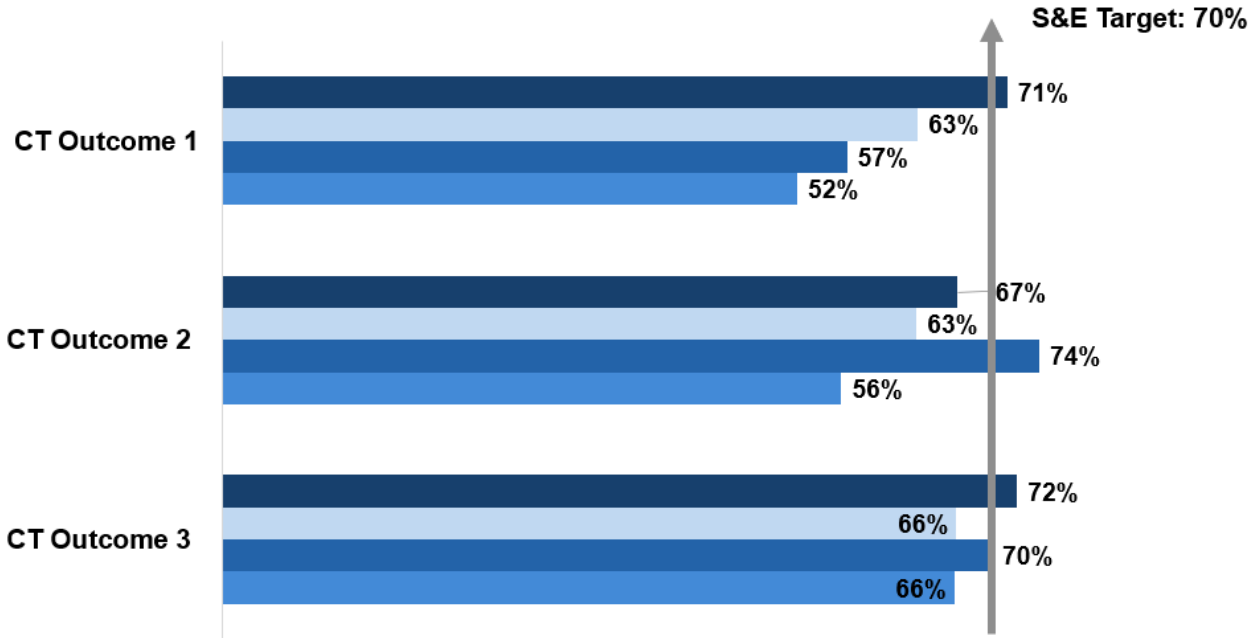

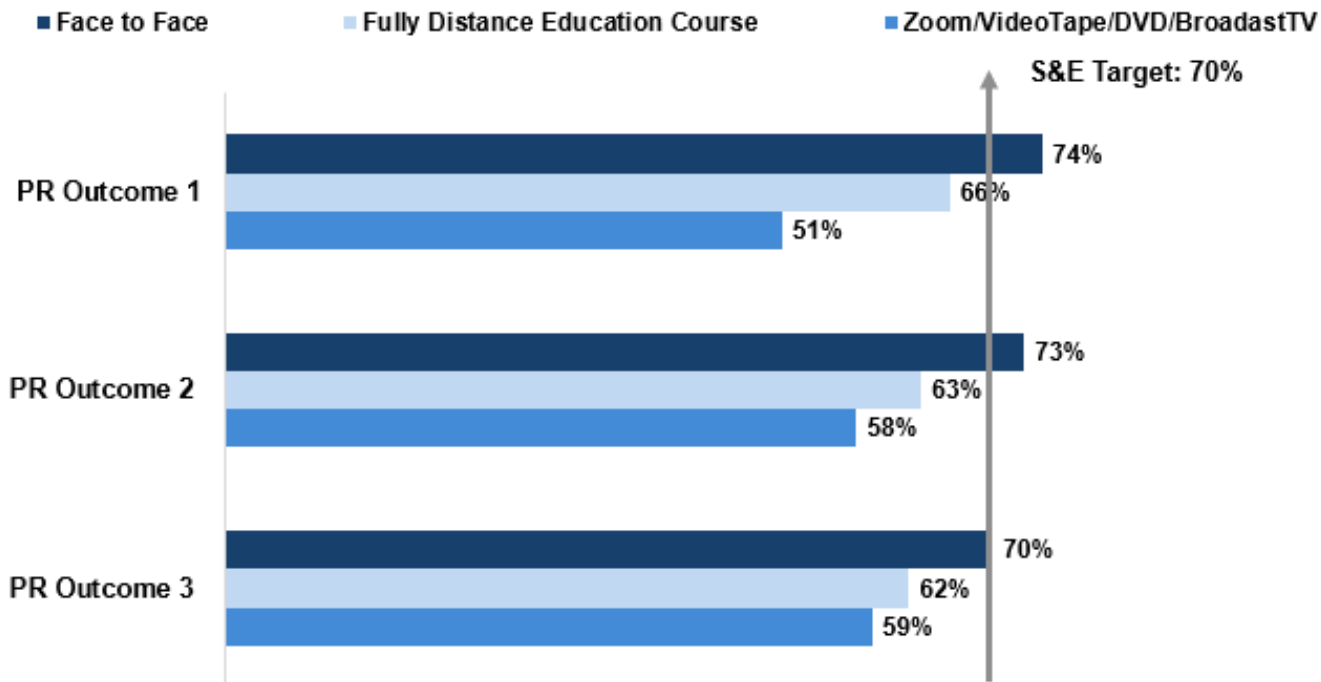

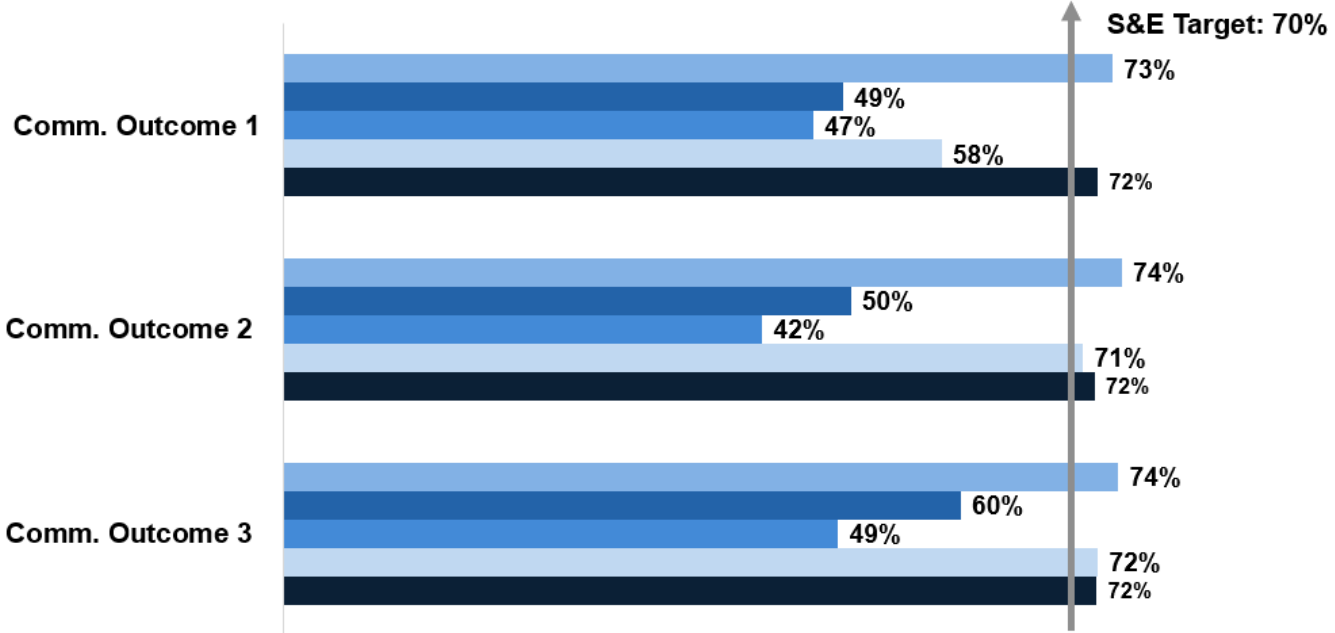

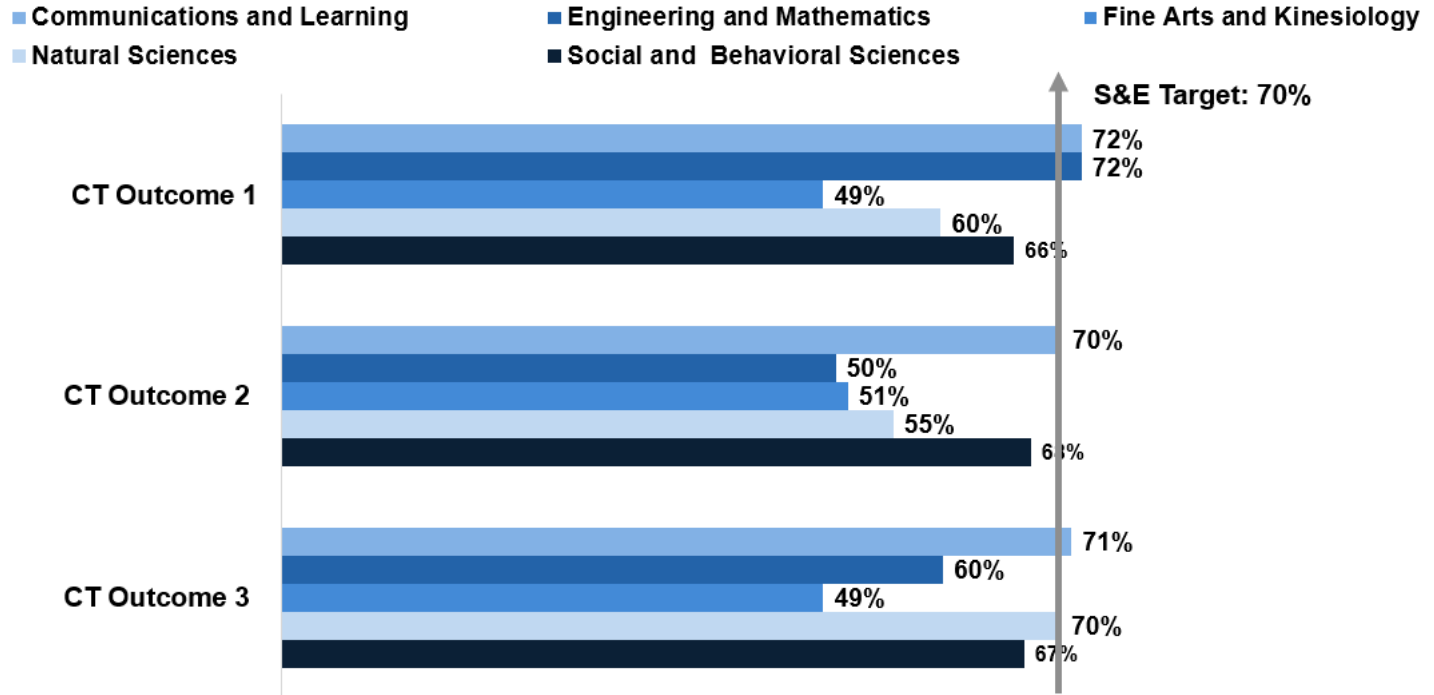

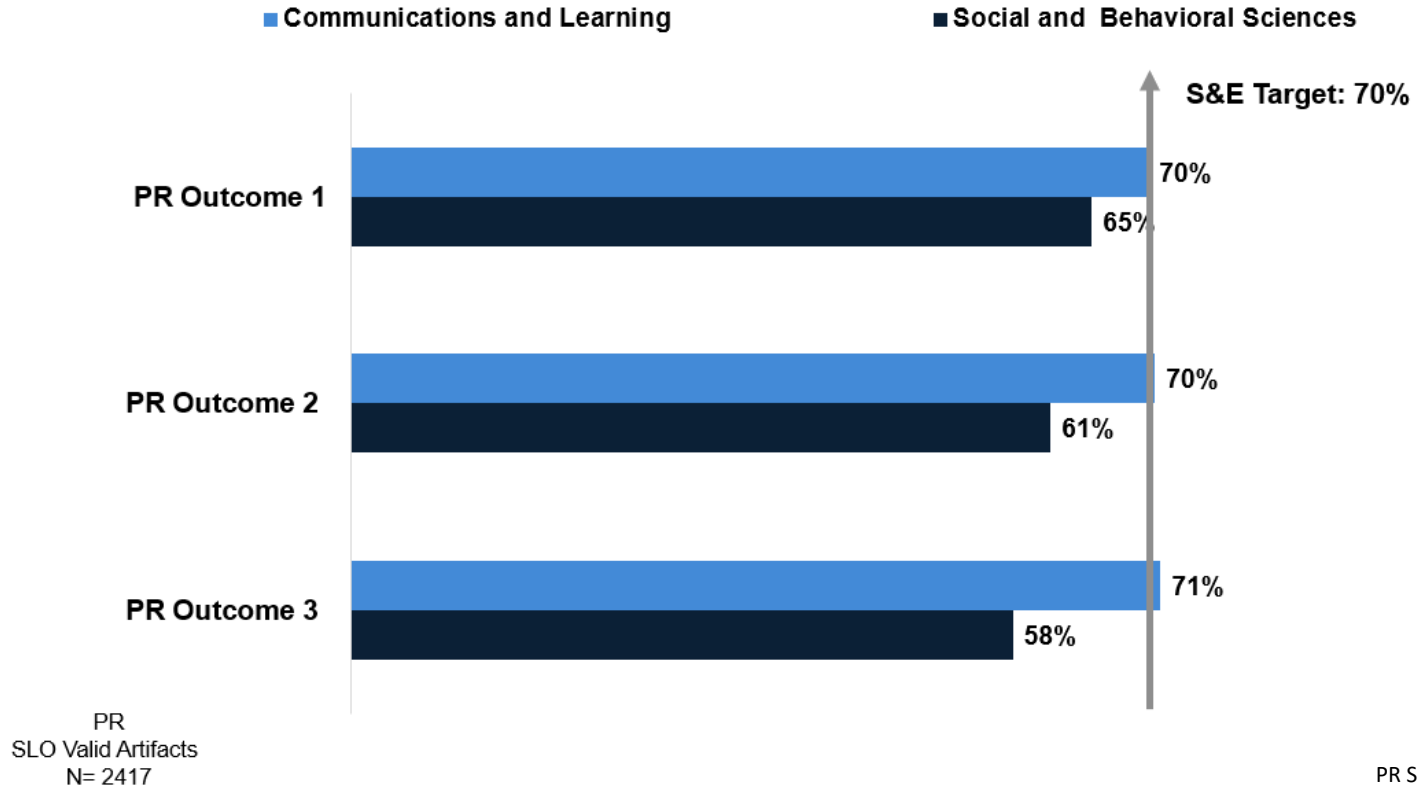

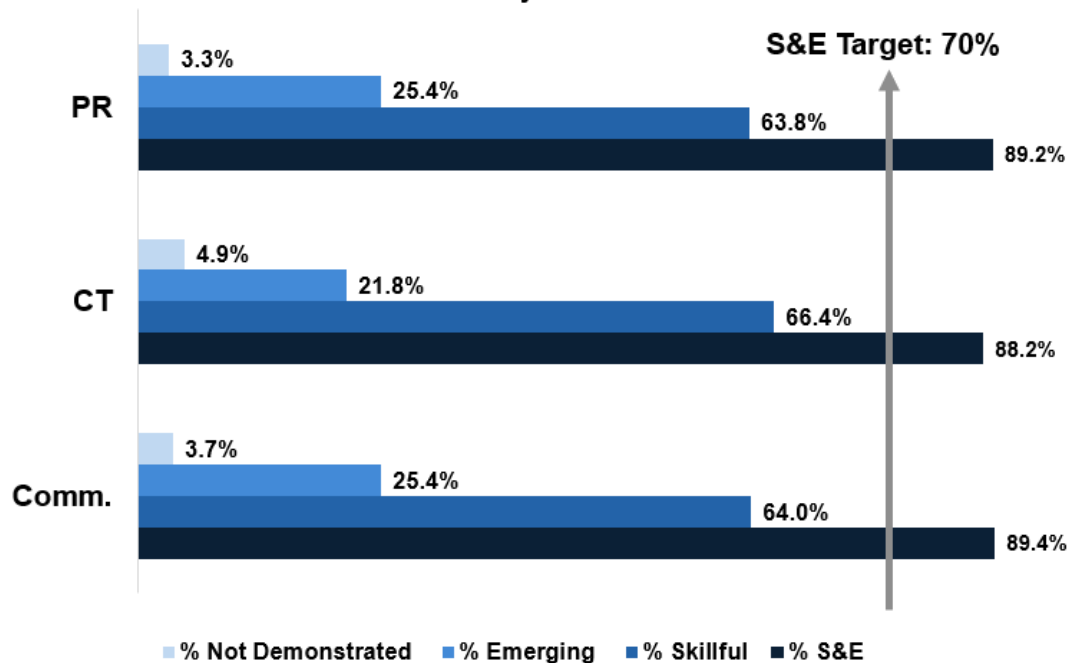

- Provided online form for **Discipline Leads** to complete
 - Discipline Leads completed their form by discipline (not each course assessed).
 - Course Faculty feedback was reviewed and taken into consideration when completing.

IMPROVEMENTS AND CHALLENGES



IMPROVEMENTS

- **iRubric course section folders were open for scoring after Calibration Trainings**
 - Excellent participation rate in Calibration Trainings
 - Assessors had more time to complete their scoring
- **Social and Behavioral Sciences once again had all their FT faculty serve as assessors**
 - Resulted in less assignments for each faculty to assess (about 20-30 each)
- **Electronic feedback forms were used for Course Faculty and Discipline Leads**
- **All course faculty required to provide feedback and action plan, regardless of results**
- **Discipline Leads completed feedback/action plan in one form for discipline, not per course**

CHALLENGES

- **Electronic feedback forms were used for Course Faculty and Discipline Leads**
 - All course faculty required to provide feedback and action plan, regardless of results.
 - 15 of 58 course faculty did not provide feedback/action plan (25%). Higher than last year (17%).
- **Discipline Leads completed feedback/action plan in one form for discipline, not per course**
 - 5 of 18 Discipline Leads did not provide feedback/action plan (28%). Last year, only 1 Discipline Lead did not provide feedback.

CHALLENGES

- **Reliability of assessment results due to high non-submission of student assignments for certain course sections**
 - 9 out of 58 courses had less than 50% submission rates based on assignment submission/total enrollment (15% of courses)
 - We assess by entire course **section**, not by student, therefore courses with less assignments submitted received lower overall scores.
 - iRubric pulls names/enrollment of all students in a section, including ones that did not submit the assignment.
 - We cannot make assumptions about the skill level of students who did not submit the assignments.
 - We cannot generalize the section score with only a few student assignments.
 - Maximum student participation is crucial to have an accurate representation of student skill level in each section.

FOR NEXT YEAR

- **iRubric**
 - iRubric will be the only mode used for IPRE to pull/accept student assignments from Canvas.
 - Electronic files will not be accepted for manual upload into iRubric.
 - All students enrolled in each section assessed will be accounted for, including those that do not submit the assignment.
- **Late November Due Date for All Terms**
 - We need to make sure course sections being assessed complete their assignments by the November deadline.
 - Sections should not complete assessment assignment on first day of class.
 - Late assignment submissions will not be accepted
 - Sections that do not complete the assignment by the deadline will automatically receive a **Not Demonstrated** rating for all students enrolled.
- **All electronic forms used in 23-24 will remain in 24-25.**
- **Student assignment submission rate per section needs to be increased for better and more accurate results**
