## Low visibility operations and tactics level 1 - Pistol and Rifle - #3327

LVOT 1 is the 1<sup>st</sup> of three successive courses that build upon each other as a foundation to help officers win deadly encounters while off duty or in a covert (low vis) capacity.

There are 168 hours in a week. After a 40-hour work week, that leaves 128 hours outside of the job requirements to potentially respond to deadly situations in a concealed carry capacity.

Many departments require or highly encourage officers to carry firearms off duty and respond to major situations. However, most departments don't provide the training needed for off-duty or plain-clothes response. This course is designed to bridge that gap and provide an in-depth, practical and common-sense approach to give officers the skills and confidence to survive in off duty or covert lethal encounters.

### **Course Objectives:**

Officers will train in plain clothes or off duty attire. Upon completion of this 3-day course in Low Vis Operations and Tactics, students will become proficient in:

1. Solidify and build upon basic essential firearm skills
2. Draw and accurately engaging suspects under stress from concealed carry with a pistol.
3. Conduct reloads and malfunction drills under stress from concealed carry with a pistol
4. Demonstrate proficiency and understanding of innovative tactics to regain a tactical advantage over an adversary who had initial superiority.
5. Students completing the rifle portion of the training will gain proficiency in deploying and using a patrol rifle in low vis operations.
