### **COVID Update**

- It has been over a year since we transitioned to remote work and learning, and during that time we have maintained a commitment to safety and student success. Our plans have evolved to meet the emerging needs in our community and our commitments to student access and success.
- We've begun returning to work on site in a carefully phased transition plan in order to serve students in the best way possible, while also ensuring a safe return to on-site work for everyone.
- Updated Return to Campus Plans for Summer and Fall are as follows:
- Summer 2021: Plan for Level 3 up to 25% occupancy effective May 31, 2021
- Summer 2021: Plan for Level 2 up to 50% occupancy effective July 6, 2021
- Fall 2021: Plan for Level 1 up to 75% occupancy— effective August 16, 2021
- These effective dates are provided to allow for increased support personnel on-site, to assist students with enrollment and registration for classes in the upcoming semesters. Detailed plans may include staffing services at various levels in each department to ensure adequate student and academic support.





### **Student Support Services**

In order to provide greater access to Student Success services, such as Welcome Centers, Advising, Financial Aid and Advocacy Centers services:

- **Beginning June 1**, Student Success and services will be available to students in person, on site from 8 a.m.-7 p.m. Mondays and Thursdays (up to 25% occupancy).
- **Beginning July 6**, Student Success services will be open to students in person Monday-Thursday 8 a.m.-7 p.m. (up to 50% occupancy).
- **Beginning July 26**, Student Success services will be provided in person, on site on Fridays and Saturdays as well (up to 75% occupancy).
- Student Success services will be available both on-site and remotely.

## SPC Family Safety Performance

### Screening/Check-In Data:

• SPC HSOs screen/check-in an average of 3,100 SPC family members (employees, students, contractors, and vendors) per week – 1,600 at MLKC and 1,500 at SWC.

#### COVID-19 Case Data:

- Between March and December 2020, SPC received 170 reports of COVID-19 impacting our employees and students.
- Between January 1 to May 19, 2021, SPC has received 159 COVID-19 reports from our family members.
  - 74 Positive Cases (employees & students)
  - · 82 Exposure Cases (employees & students)
  - 3 Unfounded Cases (employees & students)
- No onsite transmissions




