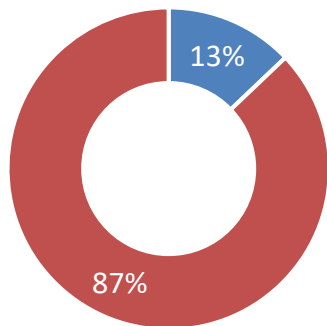

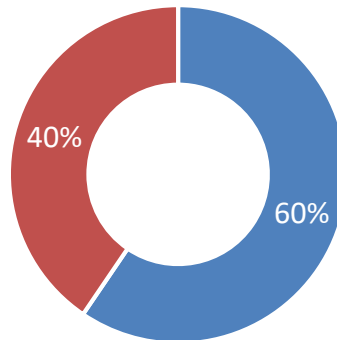

Enrollment Status



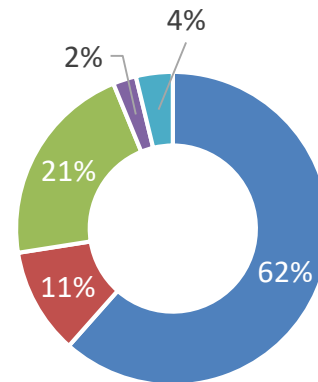

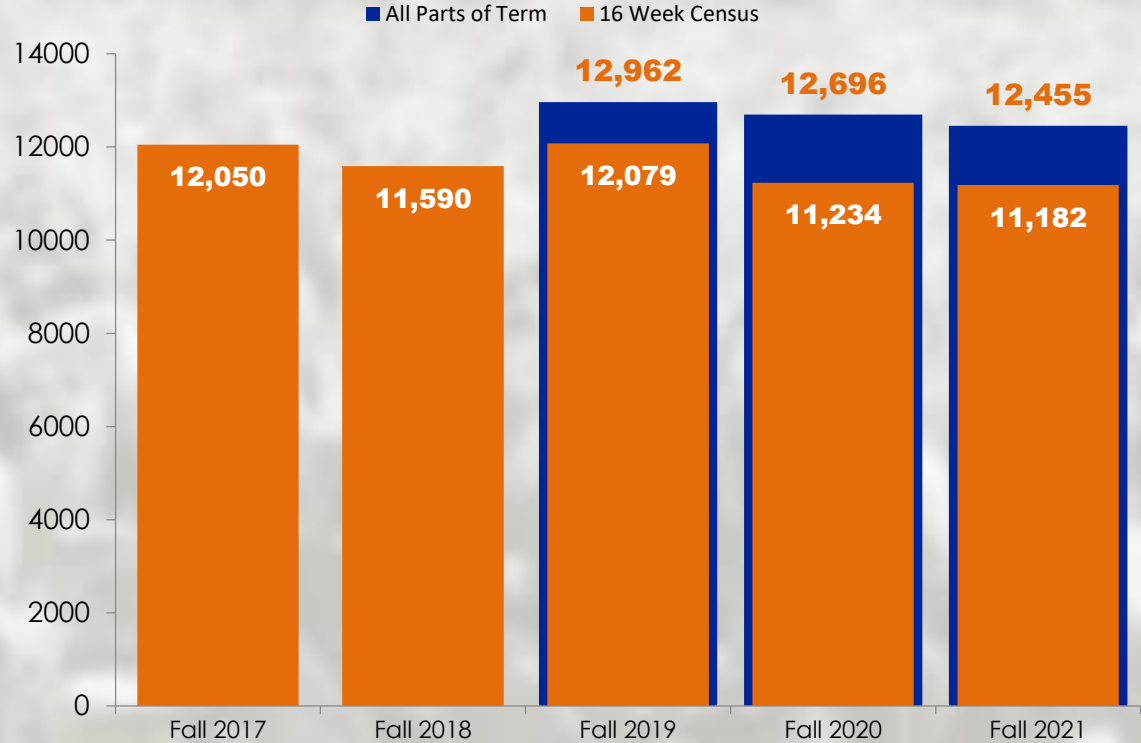

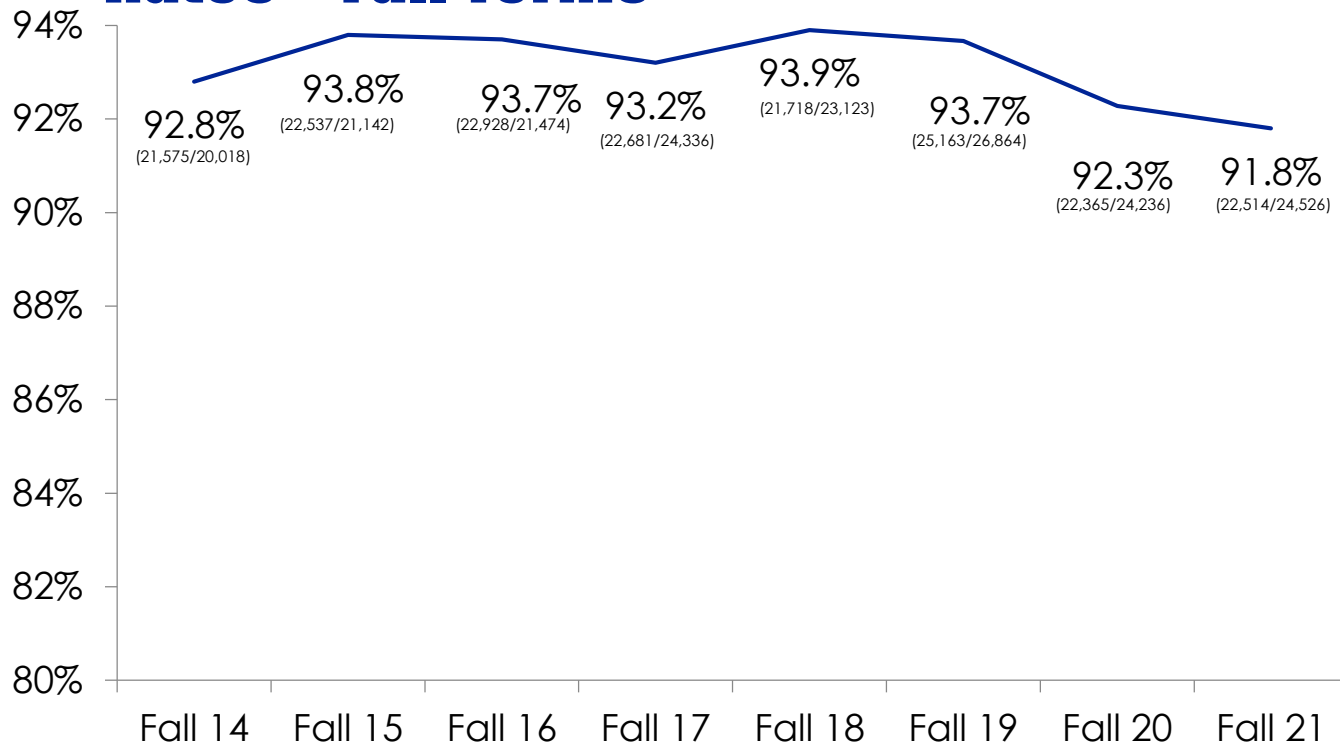

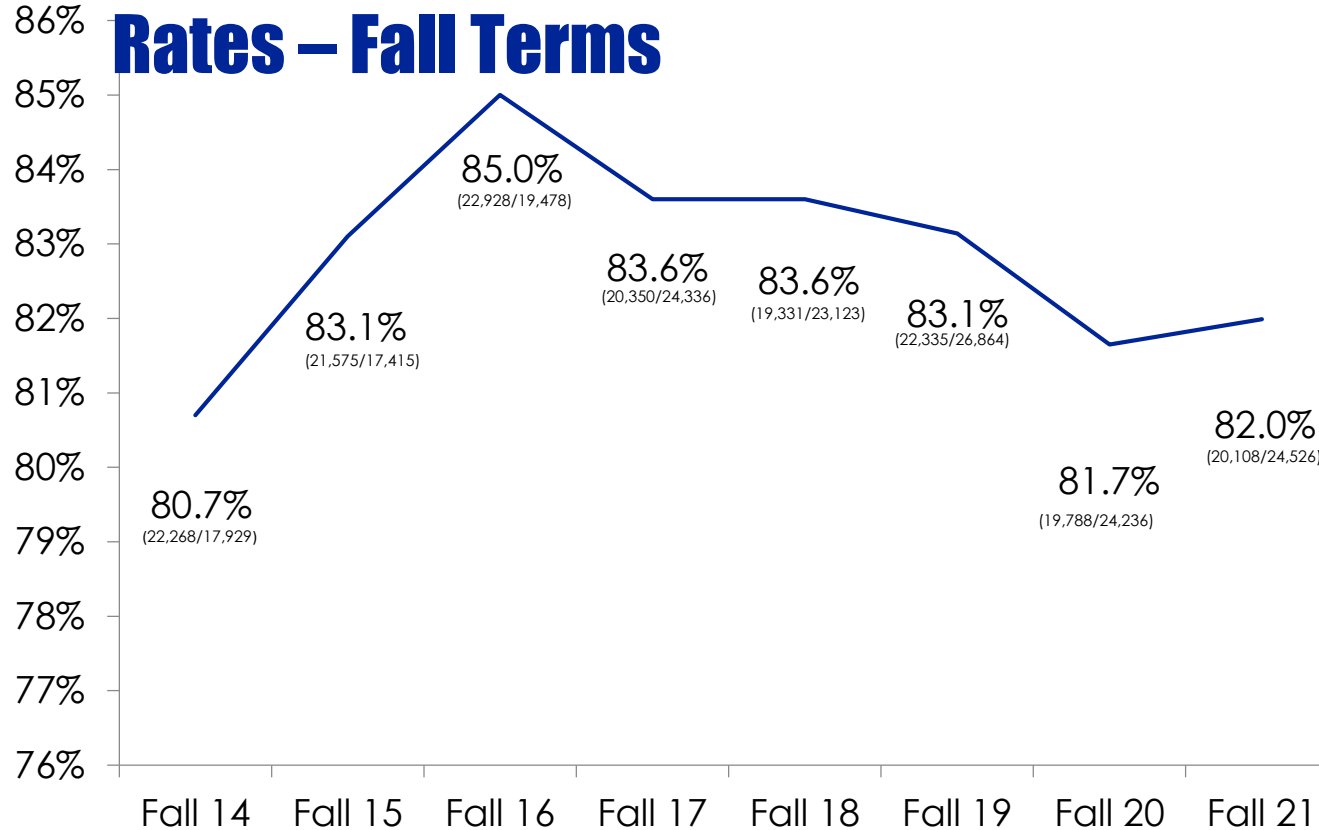

Productive Grade Rates – Fall Terms

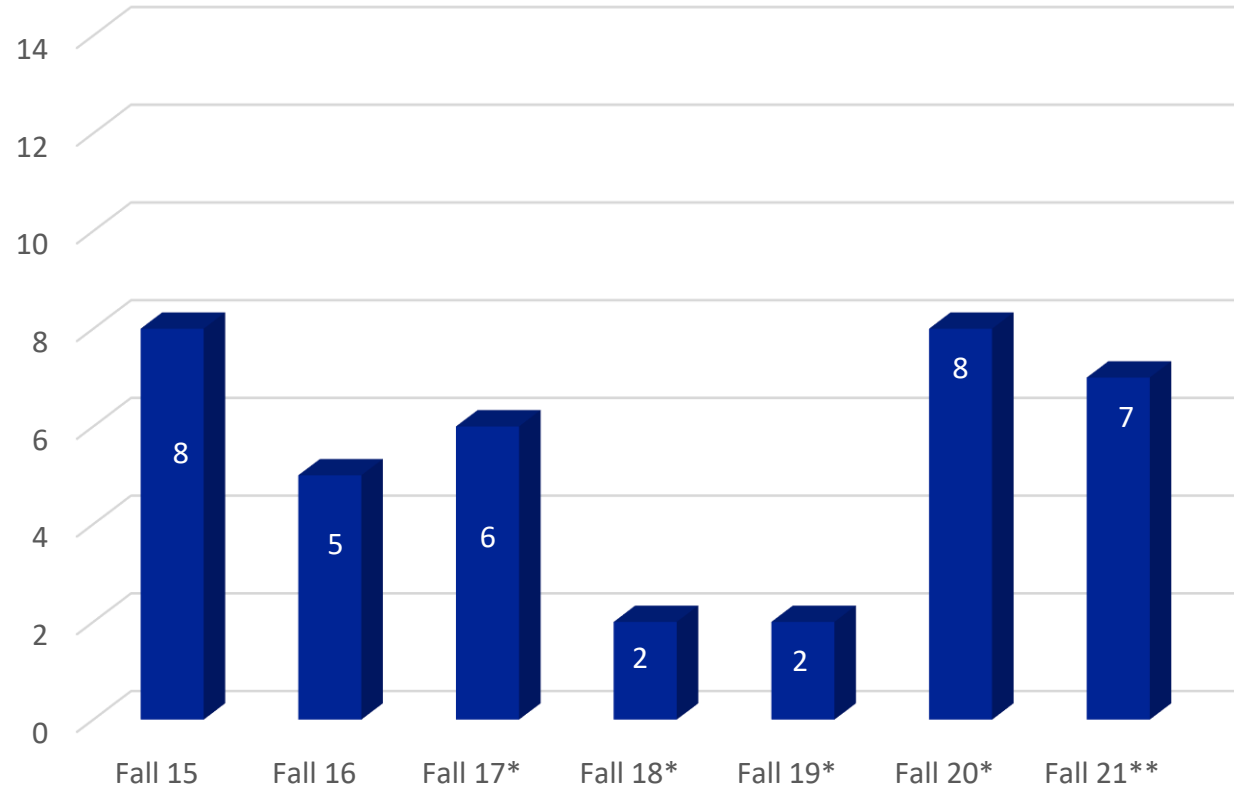

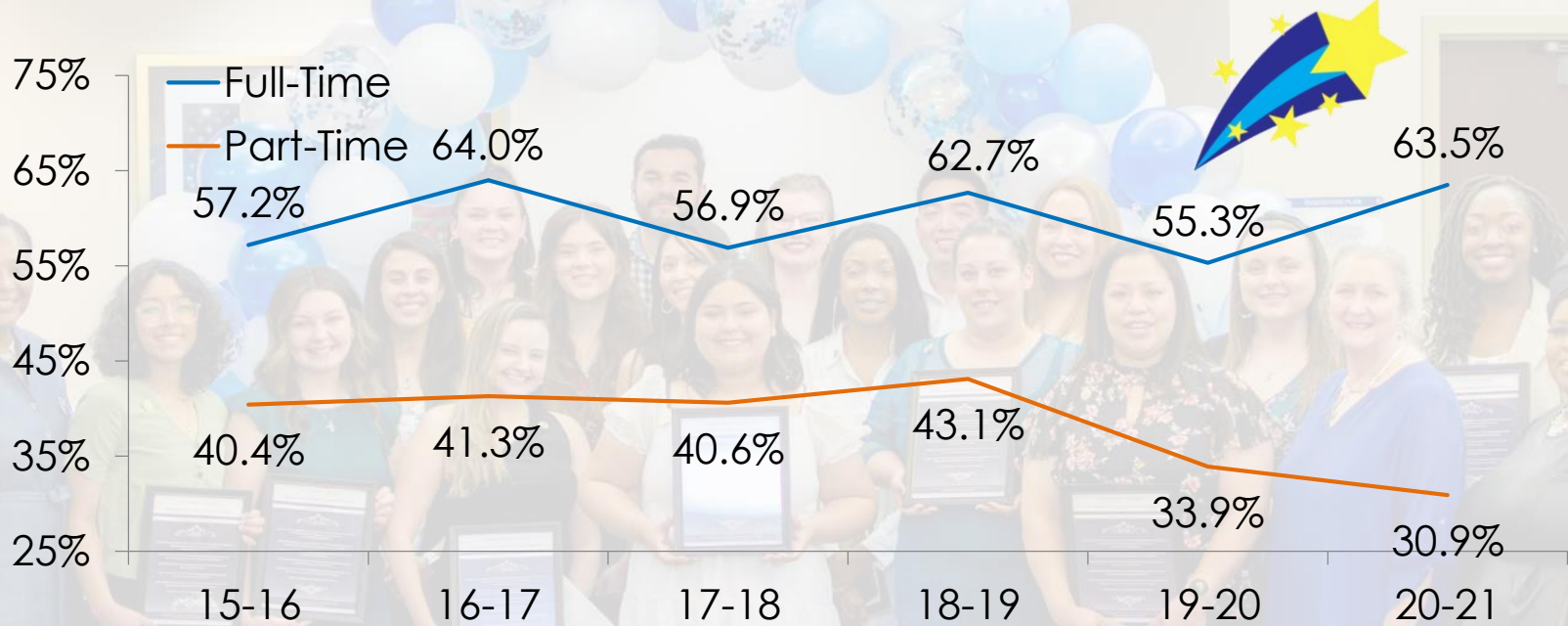
Number of High-Challenge Courses

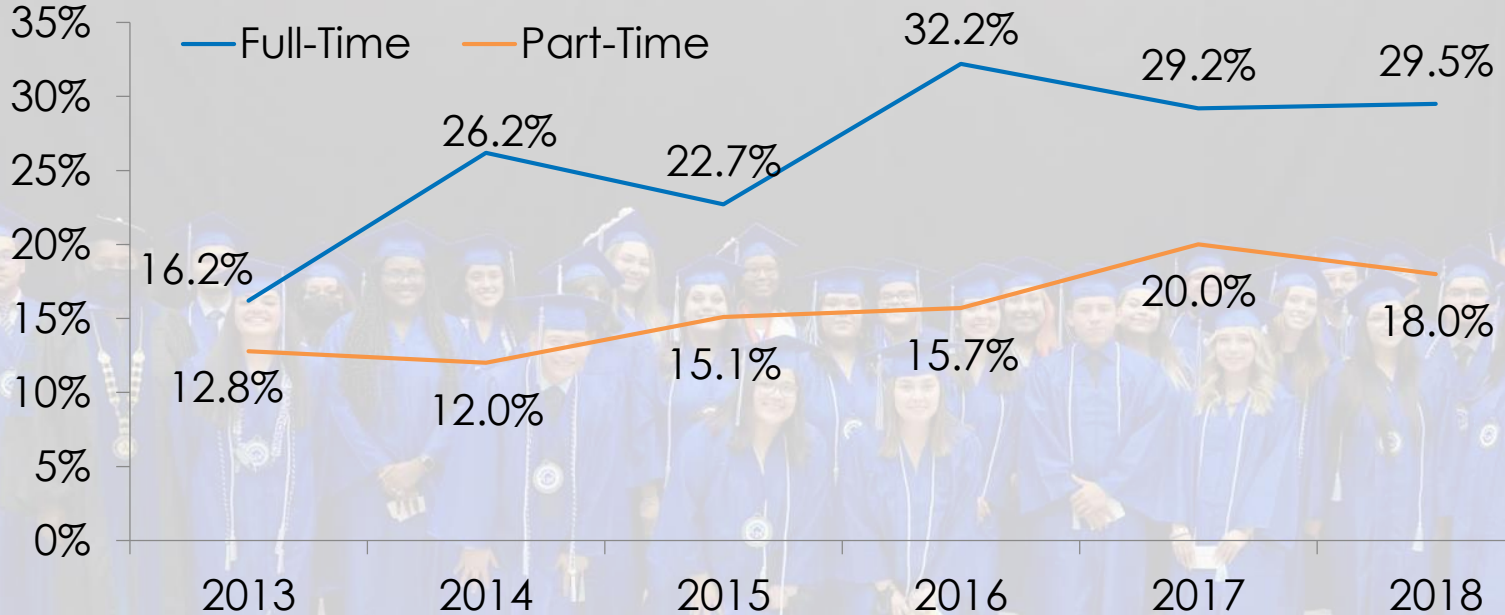

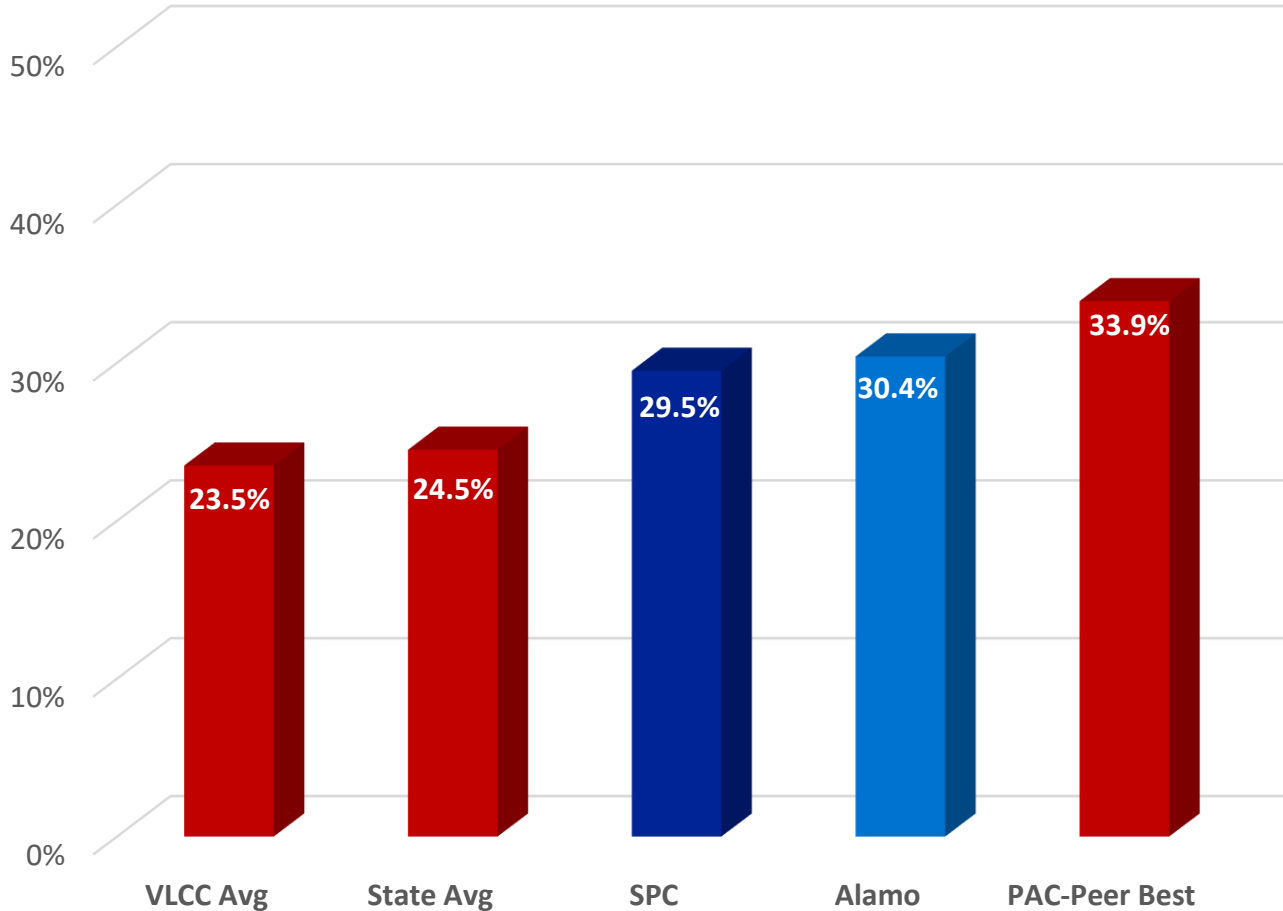

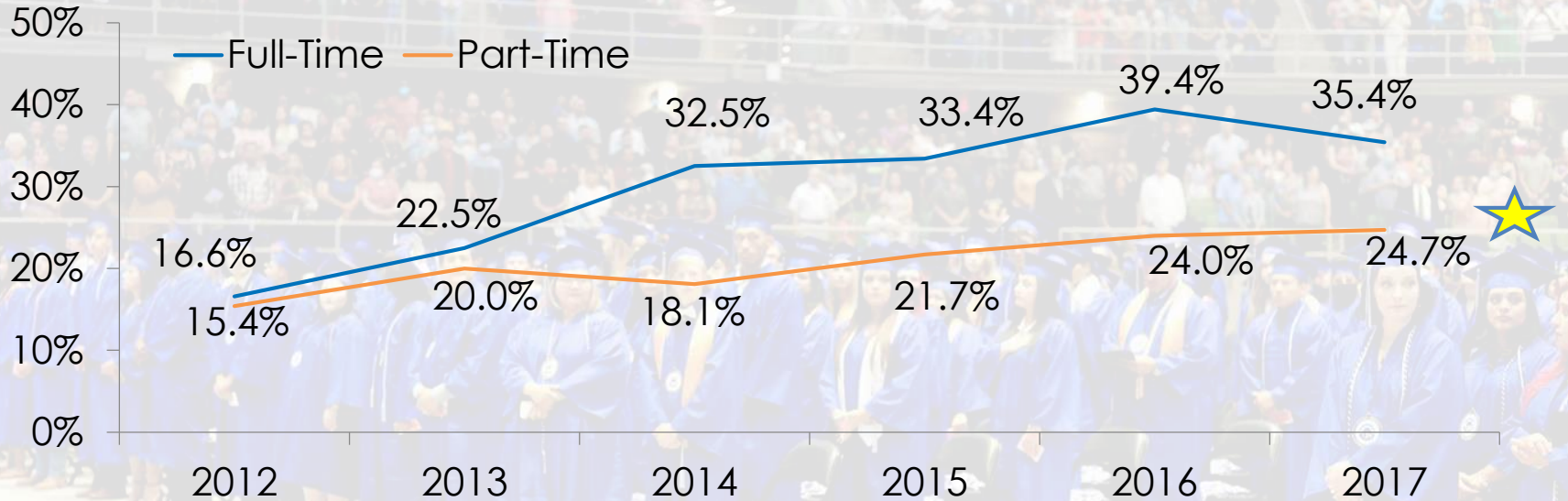




3-Year FT FTIC Graduation Rates

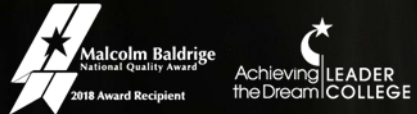

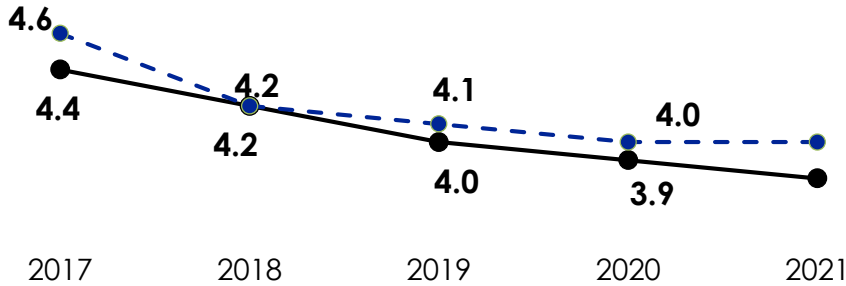

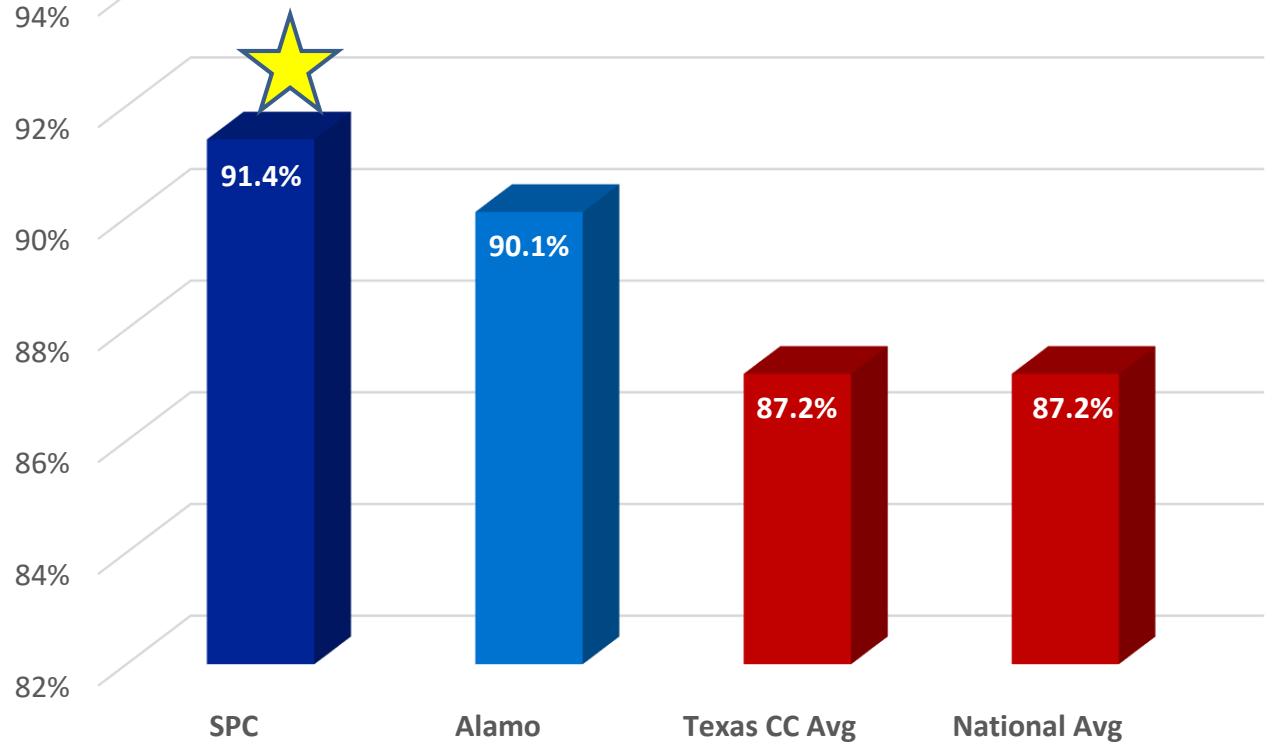

Percentage of Students Rating their Entire Educational Experience as "Good or Excellent"

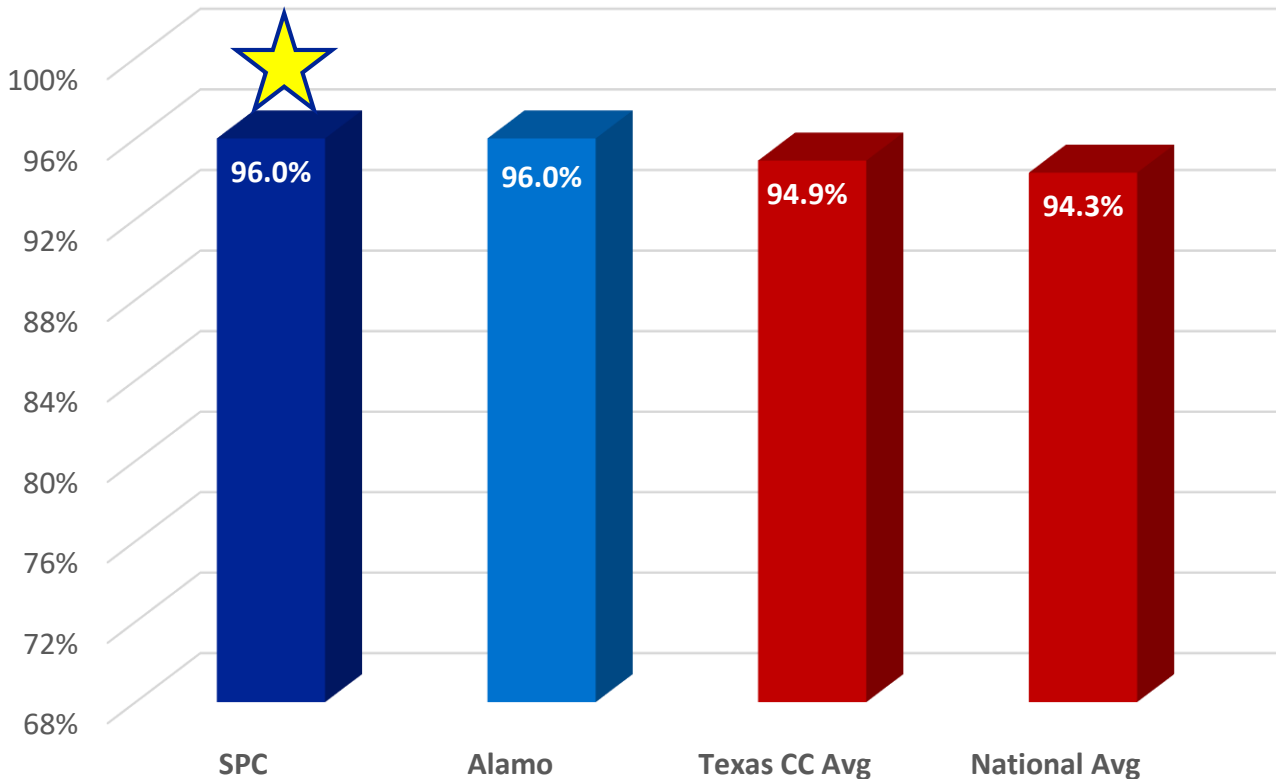

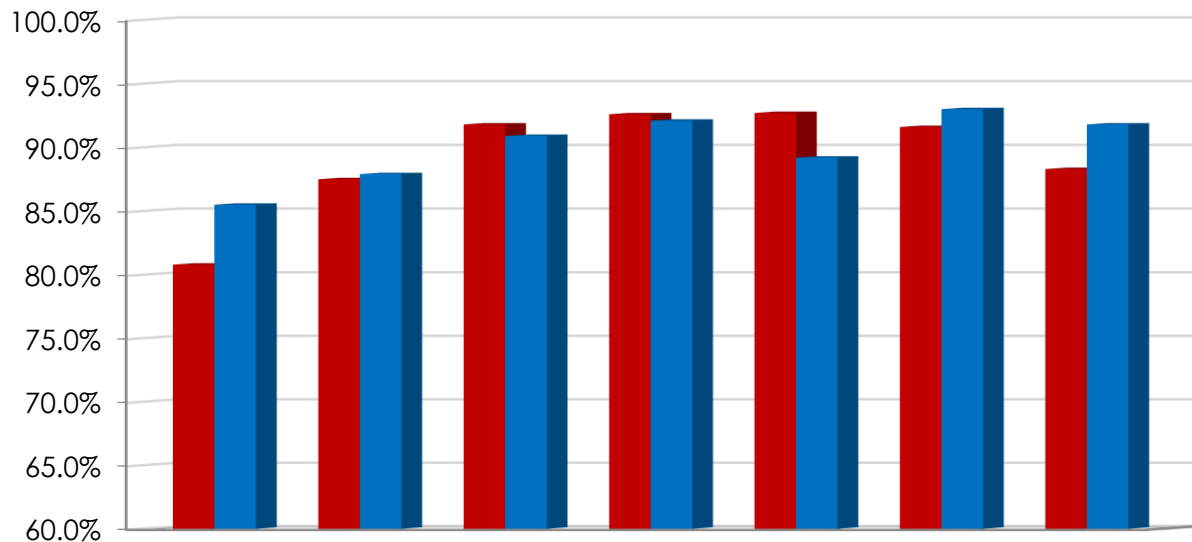

Students Employed and/or Enrolled Within 6 Months of Graduation

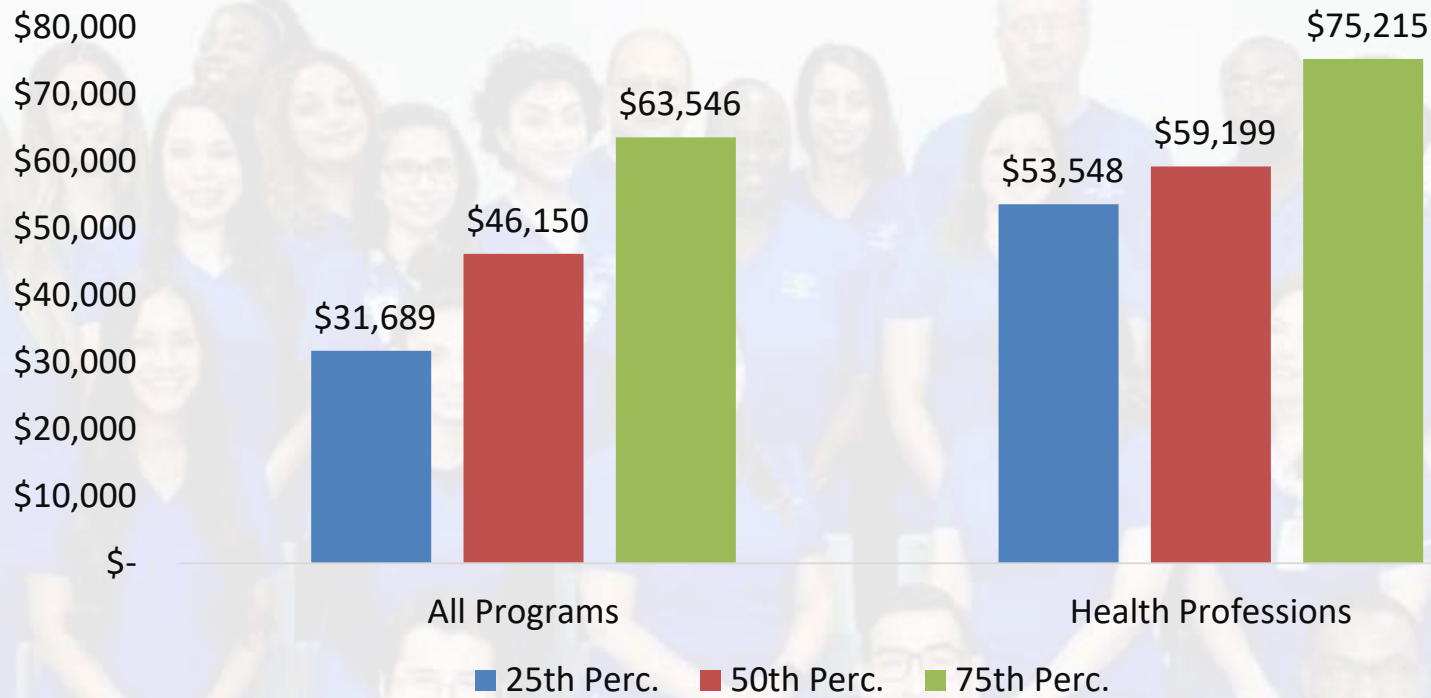

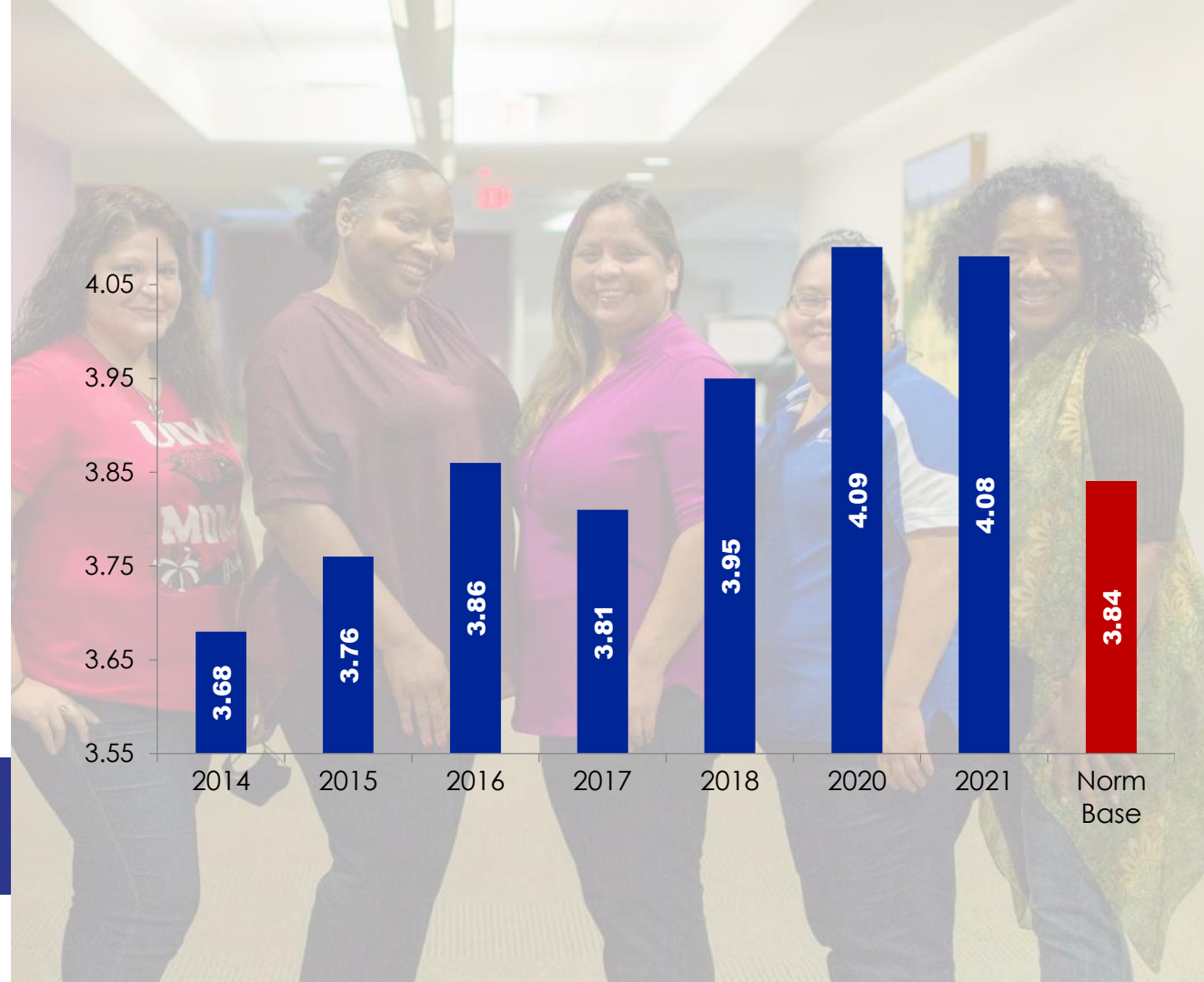

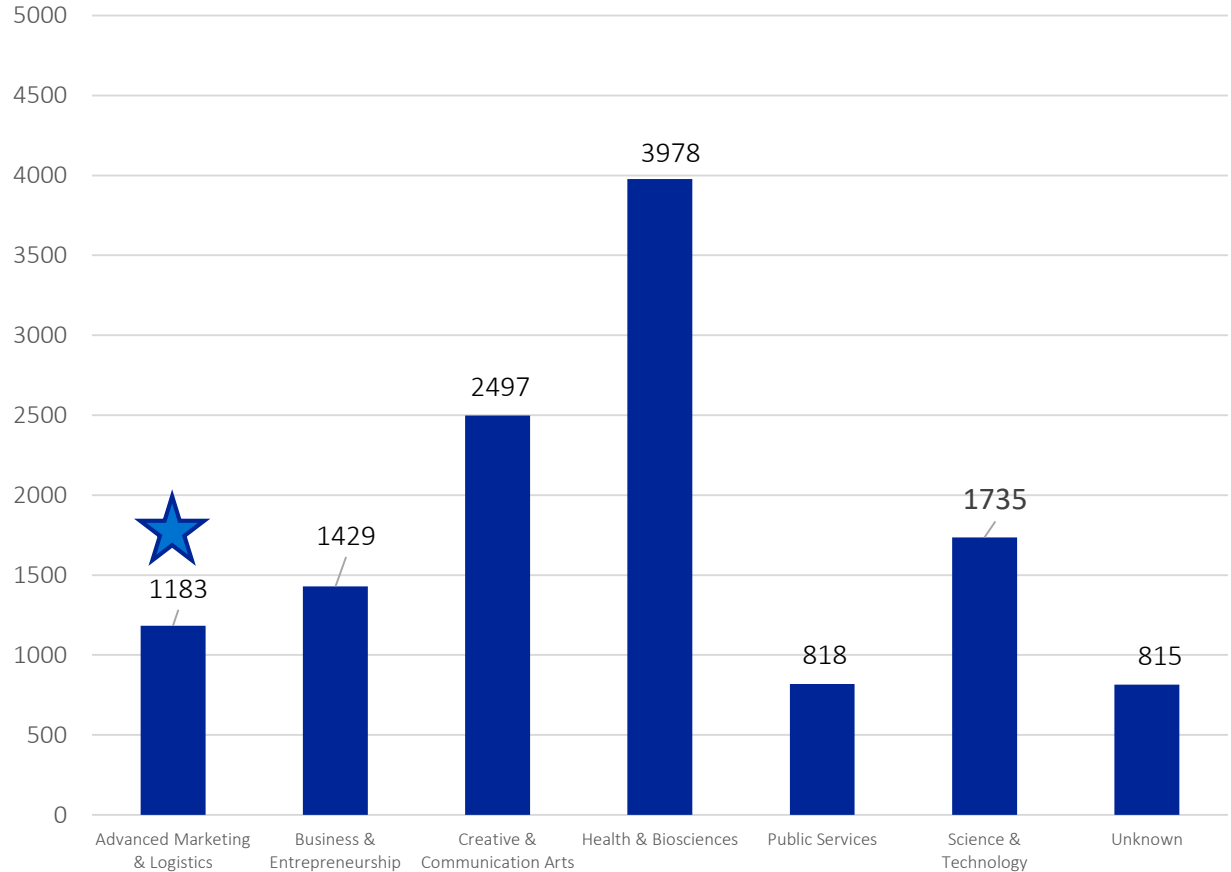

Fall 2021 Headcount by Institute

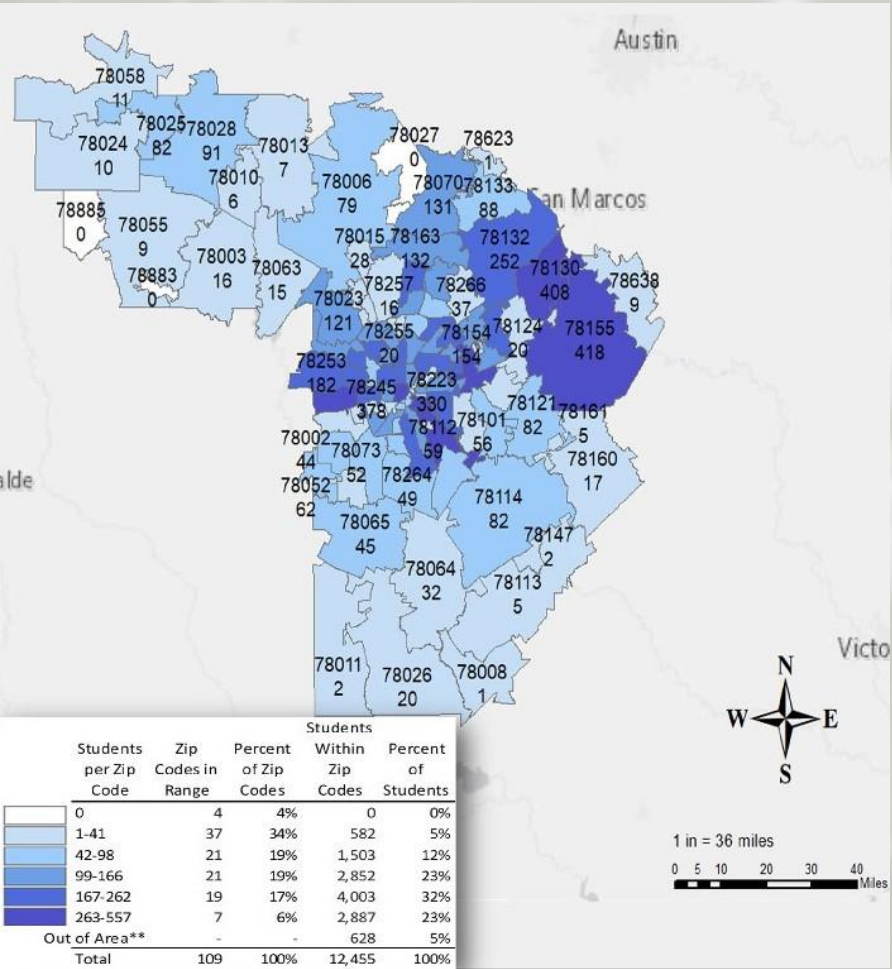

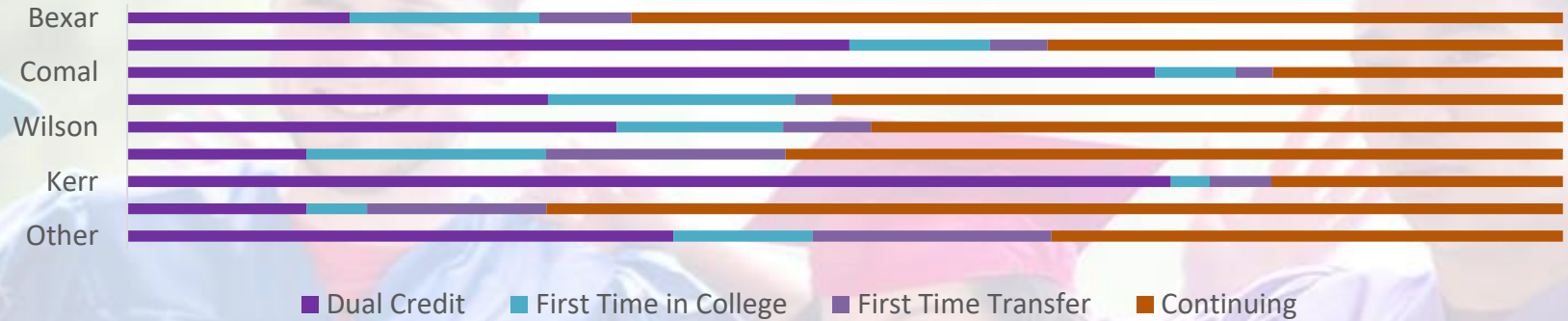

Fall 2020 Headcount by Zip Code



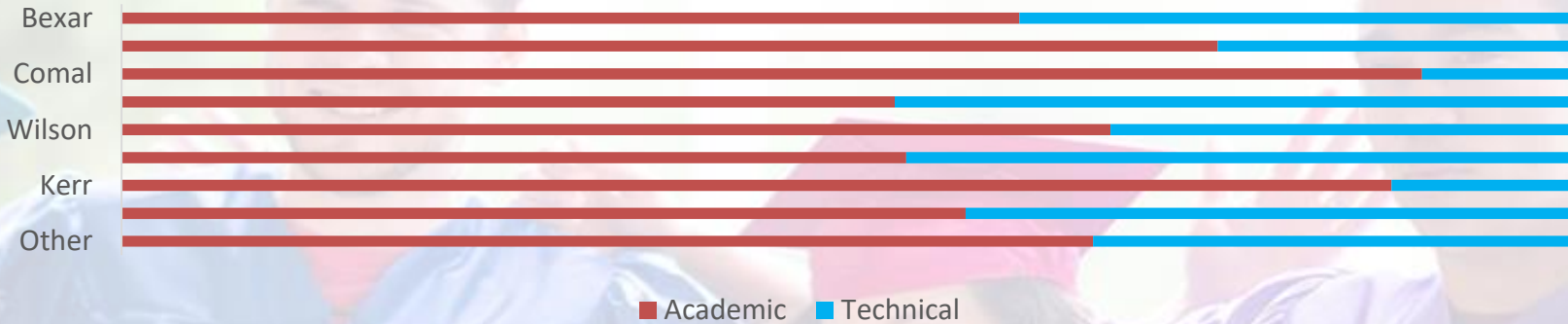

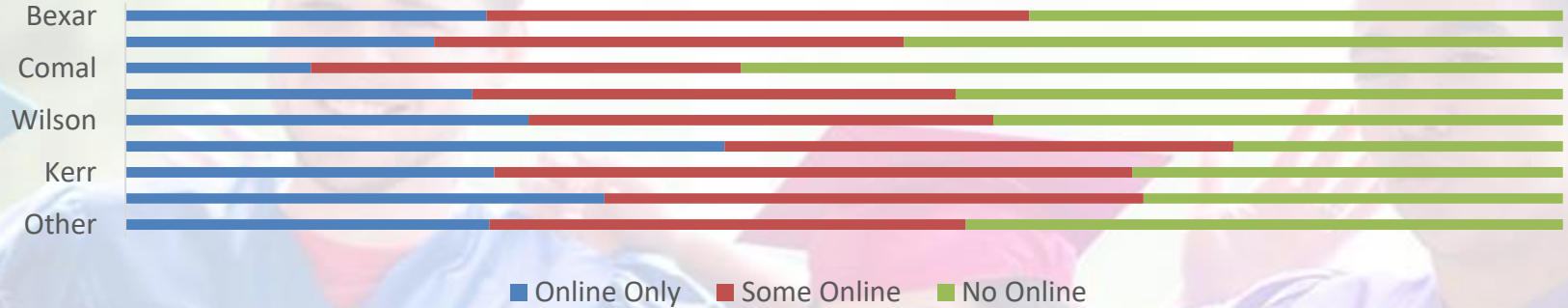

Fall 2021 Credit Enrollment County by Online Status

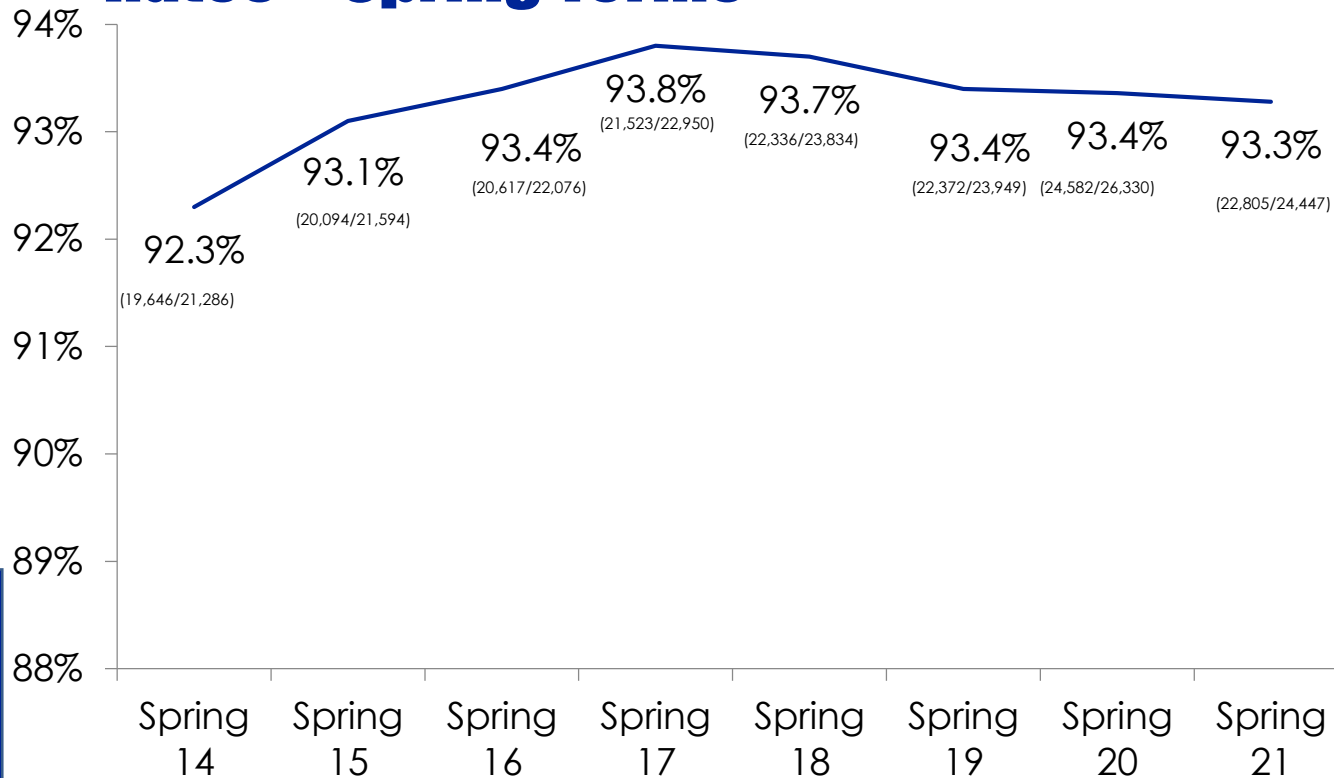

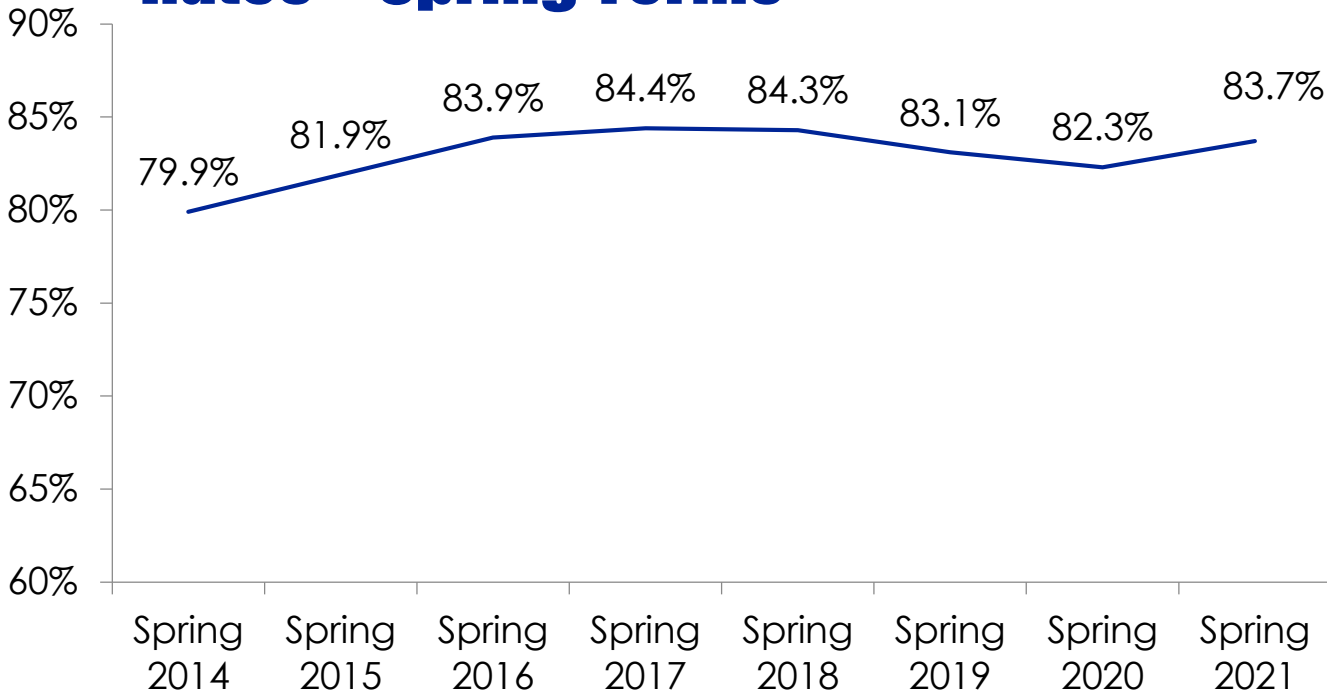

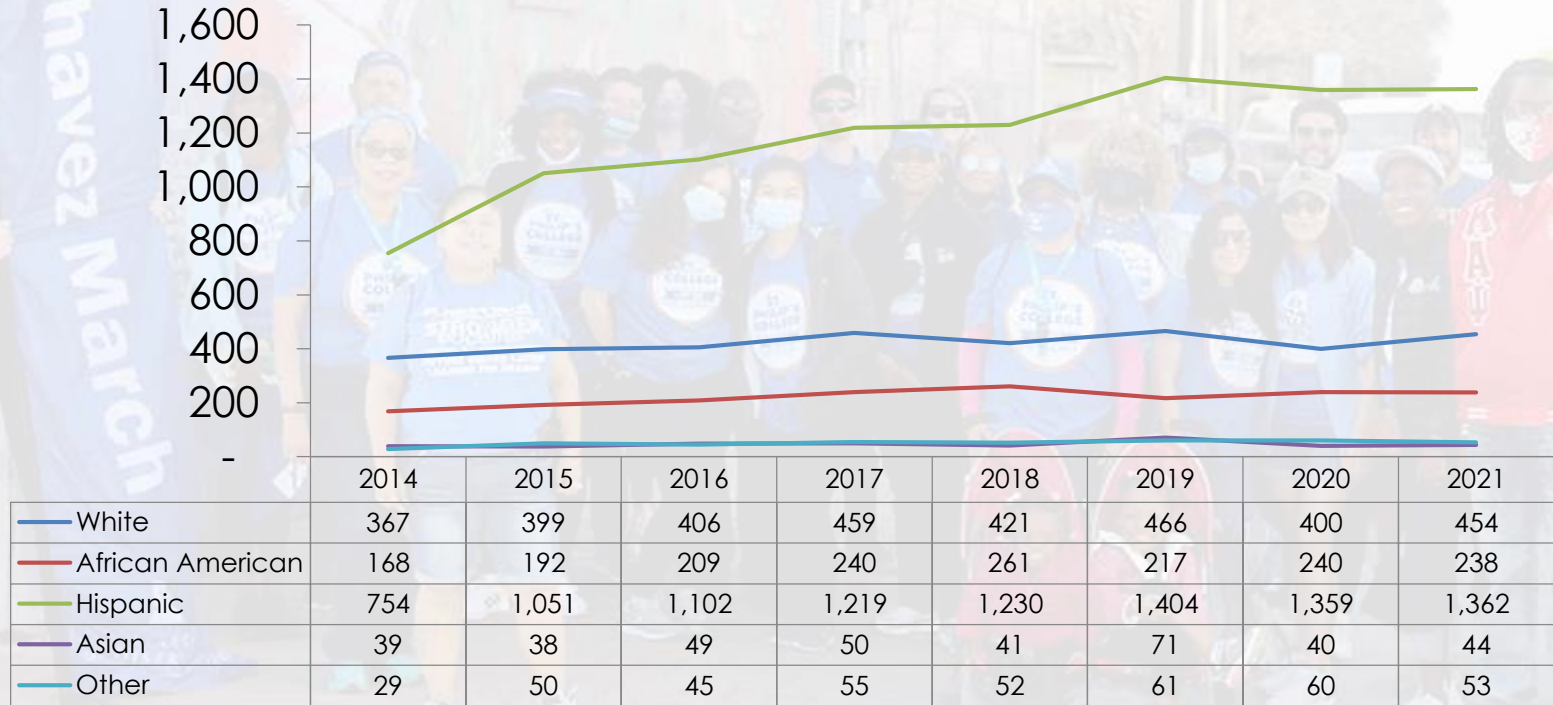

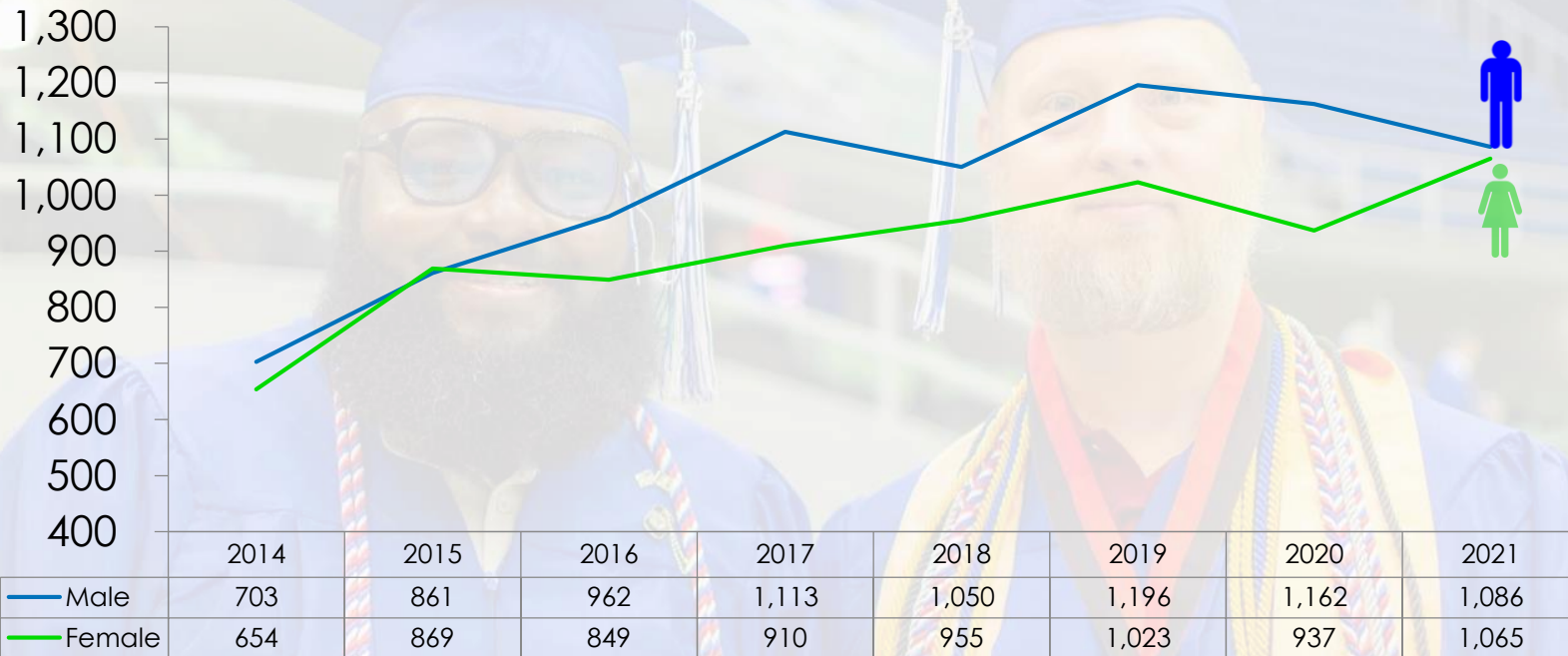

Degrees & Certificates Awarded by Gender

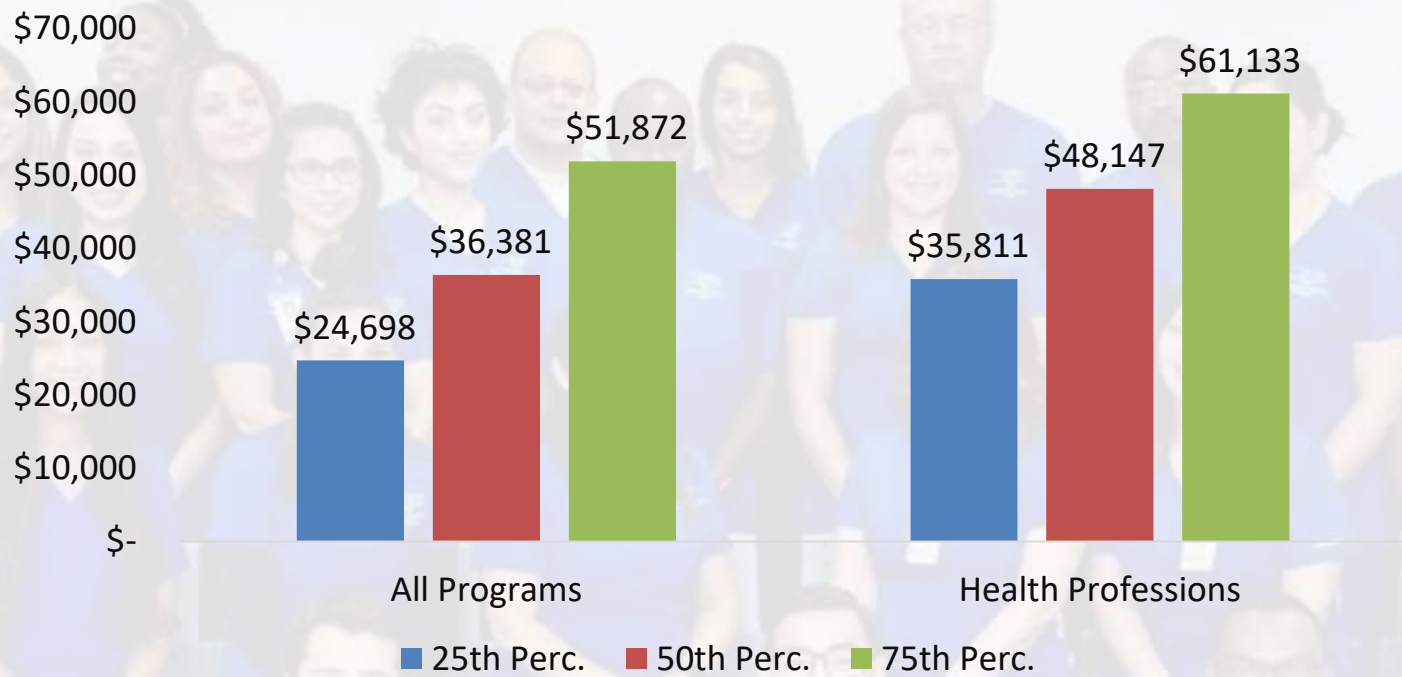
